Trump kicks off 2024 prez bid with visits to key states

WASHINGTON

FORMER US President Donald Trump is set to kick off his 2024 White House bid on Saturday with visits to a pair of early voting states, his first campaign events since launching his bid more than two months ago.

Trump will be the keynote speaker at the New Hampshire GOP's annual meeting before travelling to Columbia, South Carolina, where he is set to unveil his leadership team at the Statehouse. The states hold two of the party's first three nominating contests, giving them enormous power in selecting its nominee.

Trump and his allies hope the events will offer a show of force behind the former president after a sluggish start to his campaign that left many questioning his commitment to running again. In recent weeks, his backers have been reaching out to political operatives and elected officials to secure support for Trump's reelection at a critical juncture when other Republicans are preparing their own expected challenges.

"The gun is fired, and the campaign season has started," said Stephen Stepanek, chair of the New Hampshire Republican Party and the co-chair of the state. While Trump remains the only declared 2024 presidential candidate, a host of potential challengers, including Florida Governor Ron DeSantis, former Vice President Mike Pence and former S Carolina Governor Nikki Haley, who

Cops struck down Nichols with fists, batons and boots

Video shows officers pummeling & leaving him on footpath propped against squad car

MEMPHIS

AUTHORITIES released video footage on Friday showing Tyre Nichols being beaten by five Memphis police officers who held the Black motorist down and repeatedly struck him with their fists, boots and batons as he screamed for his mother.

The video is filled with violent moments showing the officers, who are also Black, chas-Trump's 2016 campaign in ing and pummeling Nichols and leaving him on the pavement propped against a squad car as they fist-bump and celebrate their actions.

> Protesters gathered for mostly peaceful demonstrations in multiple cities, including Memphis, where several demonstrators blocked the Interstate 55 bridge that carries traffic over the Mississippi River toward Arkansas.

> In Washington, protestors gathered in Lafayette Park, across the street from the White House and near the Black Lives Matter Plaza.

from police body cameras shows a group of officers detaining Nichols, attempting to take him down with the use of a Taser, then giving chase as he evades them. After the first officer roughly pulls Nichols out of a car, Nichols can be heard saying, "I didn't do anything," as a group of officers begins to wrestle him to the ground.

Two officers hold Nichols to the ground as he moves about, and then the third appears to kick him in the head. Nichols slumps more fully onto the pavement with all three officers surrounding him. The same officer kicks him again.

The fourth officer then walks over, draws a baton and holds it up at shoulder level as two officers hold Nichols upright, as if he were sitting.

The video raised questions about the role and possible culpability of the other officers at the scene, in addition to the five who were charged.

Data compiled by the Ministry of Economic Affairs showed that foreign loan disbursements from July to December 2022 stood at a mere \$5.6 billion, the Express Tribune reported

The report added that the disbursements were not enough to finance the maturing foreign debt, making a severe dent in the foreign exchange reserves held by the central bank

WHY THE LOW DISBURSEMENTS?

The key reason for the low disbursements was the government's failure to ensure the timely completion of the ninth review of the IMF programme. As a consequence, the

receipt of \$5.6 billion was equal to only onefourth of the annual budget estimate of \$22.8 billion

INSUFFICIENT LOANS

Pakistan received just \$532 million in loans in December, which were not sufficient for making major repayments

In the past seven days, the country paid \$828 million to Chinese financial institutions. As a result, the official foreign exchange reserves slipped to \$3.1 billion

About 44% of the loans received in December came from the Asian Development Bank (ADB), which gave \$231 million. So far, the ADB has remained the largest lender with disbursement of \$1.9 billion

Against the annual estimate of \$7.5 billion, Pakistan has only received \$200 million in foreign commercial loans in the current fiscal year, the report said

The government now expects it will receive \$6.3 billion in commercial loans, which appears to be on the higher end

It had also hoped to get loans of \$1.6 billion under the most expensive Naya Pakistan Certificates. So far, \$190 million, or 11% of the annual estimate, has been received

Must help India find substitutes to Russian arms: Biden admin

WASHINGTON

AHEAD of her India visit for 'foreign office consultations' Under Secretary of State for Political Affairs, Victoria Nuland, has told lawmakers that the US needs to help India find alternatives to Russian military equipment and that is part of the "job we have to do." Nuland is travelling to India as part of a four-nation trip including Nepal, Sri Lanka and Qatar from January 28 to February 3. "I think they (India) find themselves after 60 years of entanglement having to find alternatives, and that's part of the job we have to do, is help them with alternatives," Nuland told members of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee during a Congressional hearing on Russia.

She was responding to a question from Senator Jeff Merkley when she told lawmakers that she is travelling to India.

"I'm glad to hear that you're going to India. I would think that after the performance of Russian weapons on the battlefield has been demonstrated, they might be somewhat less interested," Merkley said.

India has faced flak from US lawmakers, both Republicans and Democrats, for choosing to abstain from a UN vote to rebuke Russia's invasion of Ukraine. US officials have also expressed concern over India's purchase of the S-400 missile systems by

Ministry stops departure of 87 migrant workers INDONESIA: In a sudden inspection at Juanda Airport in East Java, Indonesia, by nation's

Manpower Ministry on Saturday, departure of 87 migrant workers was prevented who were about to be dispatched illegally to the Middle East. "The team immediately moved... and prevented the departure of more or less 87 prospective migrant workers who were about to fly at around 8:30 am local time...to Malaysia and Singapore, which were allegedly to be followed up with a flight to the Middle East," said Haiyani Rumondang, director general of manpower occupational safety and health supervision at the ministry.

13-year-old Palestinian opens fire, two injured

A 13-year-old Palestinian opened fire in east Jerusalem on Saturday, wounding two Israelis, officials said, a day after another attacker killed seven outside a synagogue in the deadliest attack in the city since 2008.

The shooting in the Palestinian neighbourhood of Silwan in east Jerusalem, wounded a father and son, ages 47 and 23, paramedics said. Both were fully conscious and in moderate to serious condition in the hospital, the medics added.

As police rushed to the scene, two passers-by with licensed weapons shot and overpowered the 13-yearold attacker, police said. Police confiscated his handgun and took the wounded teen to a hospital. Video showed police escorting a wounded teen away from the scene and cuffed behind his back. Authorities taped off the street, emergency vehicles and security forces swarmed the area and helicopters whirled overhead.

"He waited to ambush civilians on the holy Sabbath day," Israeli police spokesman Dean Elsdunne said, adding that the teenager opened fire on a group of five civilians. Security footage showed the victims to be observant Jews, wearing skullcaps and tzitzit, or knotted ritual tassels.

The Israeli army said it had deployed another battalion to the West Bank on Saturday, adding hundreds more troops to a presence already on alert in the occupied territory.

Meanwhile, Russia's foreign ministry on Saturday

called for "maximum restraint" following violence in Israel and the West Bank that marked another escalation in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

"We perceive this development of events with deep concern. We call on all parties to exercise maximum restraint and prevent further escalation of tension," the ministry said in a statement.

"Recent events clearly confirm the need to urgently relaunch a constructive Palestinian-Israeli dialogue and to renounce unilateral actions," it added.

Second time in 3 years; UK airline Flybe collapses, all flights cancelled

STRUGGLING United Kingdom regional airline Flybe collapsed for the second time in three years on Saturday, putting jobs on the line and leaving passengers stranded. The airline initially slumped into bankruptcy in March 2020, shedding 2,400 jobs, as coronavirus restrictions decimated the travel industry.

However, it relaunched in April last year, flying many of the same routes out of Belfast, Birmingham and London Hea-

throw. In a statement, the grounded flyer said it had called in bankruptcy accountants again, and warned passengers not to travel to airports as all flights were now cancelled, including its international routes from Switzerland and the Netherlands. The UK's Civil Aviation Authority said

passengers should "make their own alternative travel arrangements via other airlines, rail or coach operators," leaving customers with lengthy and potentially expensive trips to get home.
