District braces for heavy rain and related calamities

Monsoon intensifies, orange alert till July 6

THE disaster management department is prepared to deal with any calamities related to the rains as orange alert has been issued in the district till July 6. District Collector A Geetha has instructed the Tahsildars to make preparations to evacuate people from water-logged areas and landslide-prone areas to safe places due to the possibility of heavy rains in the district. The Collector called an emergency meeting of the Disaster Management Authority and has given instructions. The village officer has been directed to immediately take steps to evacuate people from the houses that are likely to be flooded due to sea inundation in Kaaplengadi in Kadalundi and Godeeswaram in Bepore.

Fisheries Department has been asked to be alert in the coastal areas and prepare boats to deal with emergency situations. The secretaries of the local self-government bodies have been instructed to be alert and make preparations in hilly areas prone to landslides. Relief camps should be set up in village centres. The Collector has also asked the fire, health

100 bridges across the state will be illuminated by 2024: Minister Riyas

PUBLIC Works and Tourism Department Minister P A Mohamed Riyas announced a plan to illuminate 100 bridges across the state by 2024, transforming them into captivating landmarks and tourist attractions. Minister Riyas made this announcement during the inauguration ceremony of the recently completed Thechipalam bridge in the Balussery constituency.

Highlighting the positive impact of illuminated bridges, the minister drew parallels with international landmarks and expressed the hope that lit bridges in Kerala would also draw tourists. Citing the examples of the Kayamkulam and Bepore bridges, which attracted a significant number of visitors after being adorned with lights, the minister emphasized that bridges serve a more profound purpose than merely connecting roads. Their illuminated presence offers comfort and delight to the people.

In a remarkable endeavour, the government plans to construct and dedicate one hundred bridges to the nation within a span of five years. The

minister proudly announced that the construction of 50 bridges had been completed two years ago. With the recent inauguration of Thechipalam Bridge, the tally of completed bridges now stands at 61, encompassing both small and large structures. MLA K M Sachindev MLA presided over the inauguration ceremony, underscoring the significance of the occasion.

The new bridge was constructed on the Ekarul-Kakkayam road, connecting the state highway with Kakkayam Dam in the Balussery constituency. Due to the age and narrowness of the previous bridge, funds were allocated in the 2020-21 budget for its reconstruction. The new bridge, built by demolishing the old one, spans a length of 12 metres and features a single span atop sturdy concrete piers with piling and foundation.

The inauguration ceremony witnessed the presence and participation of esteemed individuals, including Indira Erady, President of Unnikulam Gram Panchayat, V M Kuttikrishnan, President of Panangad Gram Panchayat, Nijin Raj, Vice President of Unnikulam Gram Panchayat; as well as Razina Narikuni, Nassar.
