FARM STIR Students suffer as Net remains suspended in nearby areas

PATIALA, MARCH 3

Mechanic Satwant Singh (64) is a worried man as it has been over three weeks since he has earned enough to pay his helper at his small dhaba his February wages.

Another dhaba near Shambhu has been closed for the past two weeks as there are hardly any customers due to the blockade by farmers and traffic diversions. Many others did not have a customer for the past over three weeks and were suffering losses.

"I have to pay for my family's food and other household expenditures, but I have earned nothing since February 12. The last customer I had was on Sunday, two days before the farmers

gave a call for the protest march. I am a small mechanic and earn daily by repairing vehicles," says Satwant Singh, who owns a small kiosk on the national highway near Shambhu. "I know the farmers are fighting for a cause, but my request to them and the government is to ensure a resolution soon, so that the common man does not suffer," he stated. Industrialists from Ludhiana and Mandi Gobindgarh

claim that on an average, goods worth Rs 2,000-2,500 crore were sent daily to various parts of the country, but now the supplies are getting delayed.

"Even the raw material arriving into Punjab is hit, thus pushing up prices. The transportation cost of goods has increased and it is high time that farmer unions and the Centre thought about the industry as well. Even the Punjab Government should start thinking about the industry and ensure that farmers do not continue to block the highway," says Sachin Sood, a Mandi Gobindgarh-based steel manufacturer.

Meanwhile, traders on both sides of the highway continue to suffer financial losses amid fears of a repeat of 2020.

Farm leaders mislead youth, says Jakhar

CHANDIGARH, MARCH 3

Pointing out that since all wheat and paddy is being lifted at the MSP by the Centre, Punjab BJP president Sunil Jakhar today asked farmer leaders about whose battle they were fighting.

Addressing mediapersons here, Jakhar said the leaders should stop using the youth as sacrificing pawns in their games. "Let no other Shubhkarani die now.

"A guarantee of the MSP will not resolve the problem as none of the 21 crops is as remunerative as paddy and wheat, Jakhar said, underlining the need for a genuine discussion with all stakeholders. Our water table is depleting at an alarming rate and we need to consider moving away from water-guzzling crops, Jakhar said.

"Farmers are getting the MSP and that is what irks other states," Jakhar said, warning those trying to incite the youth from using them for their motives, he asked. —TNS

Int'l drug cartel busted, 3 arrested with 5 kg opium

The Commissionerate of Police here has busted an international drug trafficking syndicate involved in the illicit trade of narcotics across four countries using courier services. The operation led to the arrest of three persons Aman, Sunny and Shejal and the seizure of 5 kg of opium.

Addressing the media, Commissioner of Police (CP) Swapn Sharma said they had got a tip-off that multiple players were involved in this

racket for the last three years and had sent nearly two quintals of opium abroad. He said Manish, alias Mani Thakur, of Jalandhar was the kingpin of this cartel and was based in the UK. Investigations revealed a modus operandi in which opium was being sourced from Jharkhand and routed through courier operators in Hoshiarpur and Jalandhar before sending abroad.

Aman, operating two mobile showrooms in Hoshiarpur, emerged as a key figure responsible for receiving opium shipments from Jharkhand. He owns a lavish house in one of the posh colony in Hoshiarpur. Similarly, Sunny, a resident of Jalandhar and owner of a courier service, used to package it for distribution. Shejal, hailing from Tanda, Hoshiarpur, who is also operating a courier service, facilitated the logistics by providing recipient details.

Sharma said the seizure of 5 kg of opium underscores the magnitude of the syndicate's operations, with shipments destined for countries like the UK, Canada, Australia and the US through an international courier service.

13 Schools of Eminence opened across state

Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Sunday dedicated 13 Schools of Eminence to people of the state.

Inaugurating the School of Eminence at Indrapuri here, Mann said after Delhi, now Punjab was witnessing a major revolution in the field of education and these schools were a reflection of it.

Mann said that this was a momentous occasion and the day was not far when Punjab would be a top-ranking state.

At the same time, Kejriwal took a dig at the Governor. He said despite the Centre and Governor Banwarilal Purohit were harassing Mann government, the party was on a development spree in the state.

Kejriwal said the Central Government was sitting on the Rs 8,000 crore state's funds. The funds belonged to the people of Punjab, he said. Meanwhile, Mann said the initiative would ensure the access of students, especially poor and underprivileged sections, to the quality education. The day was not far when stu-

dents from these schools would excel in every field. The Chief Minister said the credit of bringing people to the centrestage of polity went to Kejriwal, who had forced the parties to change their agendas as per need of people. He said instead of Sankalp Pattars or election manifestos, the political parties are now giving guarantees of welfare to the people.

The Delhi Chief Minister said it was heartening to be among the people on the occasion. He said on the first glance of the school, no one could even imagine that this was a government school, adding that if private schools would have come up on this level, then they would have charged huge fees.
