

States join to curb man-animal conflict 'Bid to help hide maladministration'

KL, K'taka to map areas prone to wildlife attacks, ensure speedy exchange of information

In the wake of an increasing number of human-wildlife conflicts being reported from both the states, Kerala and Karnataka signed an agreement on Sunday to tackle the menace jointly.

As per the agreement, Kerala and Karnataka will jointly map areas prone to wildlife attacks, examine the reasons, avoid delay in tackling the issue and ensure speedy exchange of information between the two sides. The agreement was reached at a meeting of the forest ministers of both states at Bandipur Tiger Reserve in Karnataka. The meeting was also attended by senior forest officials from Tamil Nadu.

During the meeting, attended by Kerala Forest Minister A K Saseendran and his Karnataka counterpart Eshwar Khandre,

a joint Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for managing man-animal conflict was adopted. An interstate coordination committee charter was also unveiled during the meeting that marked a commitment for collaborative efforts in conflict mitigation in affected areas.

During discussions, Saseendran stressed need for amendments to the 'outdated' provisions in the Wildlife (Protection) Act to effectively deal with wildlife attacks. "It is high time that the Wildlife Act of 1972 is amended in a timely manner."

tion was enacted," Saseendran told the meeting.

The meeting focused on the Nilgiri Biosphere reserve covering Kerala, Karnataka and TN and highlighted need for joint efforts in estimating the population of elephants and vultures. Discussions centred on sharing the best practices in forest and wildlife conservation among states. Addressing challenges such as invasive weeds and exploring collaboration in employment generation were also discussed.

At a time when the state government is facing criticism for not taking sufficient steps to prevent wild animals from entering residential areas and attacking people, MLA P V Anvar, belonging to the ruling front, has approached the Supreme Court seeking a direction to the Union government to prepare an action plan to reduce human-wildlife conflict.

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HE claimed the decision to eliminate physical verification of stocks aligns with practices followed by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG). He stressed that auditors should not engage in administrative roles, which would be both ineffective and pose unnecessary interference in departmental administration. "We have rectified the incorrect practice that had been in place for years," he said.

A section of activists in the dairy industry, however, have alleged that the move is an attempt to help Avvin and other departments conceal maladministration. Some auditors from the milk cooperative department too have said this decision lacks legislative backing and is aimed at preventing the

mismismanagement of dairy stocks, such as butter, milk powder, and ice cream, at dairy plants from becoming public knowledge.

"During annual stock verification on March 31, auditors have previously highlighted several irregularities. Now, auditors will have to rely only on the data provided by the departments," said an audit inspector on the condition of anonymity. Although physical verification was previously conducted for selected samples, it served as a wake-up call for the administration to address management gaps at all levels, he added.

"Exempting physical verification of stocks from audit department roles requires amendments in accordance with the TN Cooperative Act, rules, and bylaws. The directive indeed

raises huge suspicion over the alleged mismanagement in dairy development and Avvin over the last few years," said a retired Avvin employee.

However, official sources from Avvin said the department, in light of the DGA directive, has taken steps to hire internal auditors for stock verification and financial assessment.

"Tenders have been issued to appoint internal auditors for a few dairy plants. We will submit our records to the audit department," a senior official from Avvin said.

The audit functions of departments like milk cooperative, HR&CE and local fund audit were headed by the respective department's head until a few years ago. In 2020, the audit operations were transferred to the finance department to improve audit efficiency and transparency in administration.

When asked about it, another official acknowledged the pending tasks and assured that Tangedco would strive to complete them as soon as possible.

Sources claimed that the state government had pushed for the plant to be inaugurated before the model code of conduct for the upcoming Lok Sabha polls came into force, although Electricity Minister Thangam Thennarasu had nursed doubts.

Asked about the minister's views, the senior official claimed ignorance but acknowledged the pending tasks and assured that Tangedco would strive to complete them as soon as possible.

Initiated by former Chief Minister M Karunanidhi in 2010, the North Chennai Stage III project was originally scheduled to be completed by 2015. However, the project faced delays when the government changed in 2011.

Though former Chief Minister

Edapaddi K Palaniswami urged expedition of the project in 2019, COVID-19 lockdowns disrupted the timeline. Despite incomplete technical work, the previous AIADMK government organised a ceremony to open the plant's boiler light-up -- a precursor to power generation -- on March 11, 2021, ahead of the Assembly elections that year.

However, the plant did not generate a single unit of electricity for the grid in the next three years.

ED books former DMK leader Jaffer Sadiq

THE Enforcement Directorate has registered a case under PMLA against Jaffer Sadiq, who was arrested a day ago by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) for his alleged involvement in an international drug trafficking case.

According to the official sources, the financial fraud probe agency registered the case against former DMK functionary of the DMK after the NCB found Sadiq's links with

some "high profile" people.

The Narcotics Control Bureau is expected to soon summon a senior DMK party functionary in connection with two transactions of ₹7 lakh made by Sadiq last year.

The drug probe agency had last month unearthed a major drug cartel and arrested three people, all natives of Tamil Nadu.

In multiple raids the law enforcement agencies had seized 50 kg of the narcotics-manufacturing chemical - Pseudoephedrine -- that was being sent to

Australia and New Zealand by concealing it in food powder and desiccated coconut.

According to NCB, Sadiq spearheaded the network that sourced Pseudoephedrine in India and trafficked it to Australia, New Zealand and Malaysia in the guise of food grade cargo.

"It is believed that the drug syndicate operated by him has sent 45 consignments over the past three years to various countries, containing approximately 3500 kilograms of pseudoephedrine," a senior NCB officer said.

DEVOTEE BUYS POOJA LEMON FOR ₹20,000
