

## Woman booked for derogatory post against Police Department

The police have registered a case against a 44-year-old woman from Coimbatore on charges of making derogatory remarks against the Tamil Nadu Police Department.

The accused was identified as M. Vishwadharsini, a resident of West Pon-nuram Street in R.S. Puram.

The police said that a person, namely Vishnu Prakash, sent a video to

S.Raja, sub-inspector attached to the Selvapuram police station, on WhatsApp late on Saturday. In the video, Vishwadharsini had made derogatory remarks with an intention to prevent the police from discharging their duty.

The police registered a case against the woman under Sections 153, 153 A (1)(a), 353, 294 (b), 504, 506 (i) of the Indian Penal Code and 67 of the Information Technology Act. The Selvapuram police are investigating.

## Renovated flower market likely to open post-election

The market, which was inaugurated nine months ago, has a total of 172 stalls, toilets, large sheds for temperature regulation, and parking space for 60 two-wheelers

The allotment process for the renovated wholesale flower market at R.S. Puram in Coimbatore, which was inaugurated nine months ago, is expected to begin post the Lok Sabha election results.

The market was embroiled in a dispute in the Madras High Court over parking space, for which the civic body intended to charge a fee. Now the issue has been sorted out and the allotment process would likely begin after June 4.

According to Corporation Commissioner M. Sivaguru Prabhakaran, the 172 stalls could also be leased to vendors currently operating in the markets opposite the old one on East Ramalingam Road. "However, lessees will have to adhere to by-laws prohibiting sub-leasing by renters. Additionally, each

stall cannot be rented by more than one vendor," he added.

The renovated market has both enclosed and open spaces, toilets, large sheds for temperature regulation, and parking space for 60 two-wheelers.

The Coimbatore District All Flower Traders Welfare Association, which contributed ₹40 lakhs towards the renovation works under the 'Namakku Naame' scheme, had requested the civic body to allocate a specific number of stalls in

return for their contribution.

In response, Mr. Prabhakaran said the scheme was designed for welfare purposes rather than profit-making, and cannot be used to recoup the contributed funds.

"We have no plans to allocate stalls to any association as yet, because no one party can be favoured over the other. A fair allotment of stalls will be done soon," he said.

According to a senior official of the civic body, the

stalls were earlier expected to generate up to ₹17 lakhs per month in revenue, with each stall's monthly rent planned at ₹16,000. "As of now, the rent has not been finalised as the premises was under dispute. But we will be revising the earlier estimates," the official said.

At present, the wholesale vendors do business out of a new market that has 75 stalls and they occupied it in 2020 to make way for the renovation works at the old market.

Yet, another concern arises regarding the occupancy of the stalls at the renovated market by street vendors, who can be seen encroaching pavements rather than renting out stalls. Addressing this issue, Mr. Prabhakaran said, "We will engage in discussions with them to establish a suitable rate and encourage them to relocate to these stalls."

The civic body also plans to have discussions with the district administration after the election to finalise the allotments.

### Woman dies as lorry rams 4 on Annur - Coimbatore road

A 42-year-old woman died and her husband and daughter suffered injuries after a lorry rammed them while they were waiting at Kunnathur bus stop on Annur - Coimbatore road late on May 10, 2024. The deceased was identified as S. Indrani, a resident of Kunnathur in Annur. Her husband M. Subramani, 45, and daughter S. Saranya, 24, and another person, namely Ranjith Kumar, 36, of Kunnathur were injured. The police said that the accident occurred around 10 p.m. A lorry, which was heading from Coimbatore to Annur, first rammed the three persons and then hit a house before overturning. Ranjith Kumar, who was standing near the house, was also hit by the lorry. All the four were rushed to the Government Hospital at Annur. Indrani was later shifted to a private hospital on Avinashi Road. However, she died without responding to treatment. The Annur police arrested the lorry driver, L. Venkataraman, 42, a native of Dharmapuri district. He was released on bail.

## Air India to operate non-stop flight between Coimbatore and Delhi from June 2

Air India is scheduled to operate non-stop flight on the Delhi - Coimbatore - Delhi sector from June 2.

The flight AI 547 from Delhi will depart at 3 p.m. and reach Coimbatore at 6 p.m.

The return flight AI 548 from Coimbatore will depart at 6.45 p.m. and reach T-3 terminal in Delhi at

9.50 p.m. The flight is scheduled to operate six days a week, excluding Saturday.

"The new non-stop flight will serve as a good international connector," said aviation enthusiast and frequent traveller N. Mugunda Kumar.

#### Daily flight

At present, Air India is operating a daily flight to Coimbatore via Chennai, which has a longer travel

duration.

The flight to Coimbatore, AI 429 departs Delhi at 9.55 a.m. and reaches Coimbatore at 2.30 p.m. The return flight, AI 539 departs Coimbatore at 3.10 p.m. and reaches Delhi at 7.50 p.m.

#### Easy connectivity

Various organisations were demanding Air India to operate a non-stop flight to Delhi, for easy connectivity

to various airports in the U.S., Canada, and Europe.

"The non-stop flight is suitable for passengers to travel to various international destinations as its arrival time in Delhi is convenient to board flights to these places. The flight to Coimbatore is also suitable for passengers who arrive from international destinations," J. Sathish, director of the Kongu Global Forum.
