

# Stabbing spree on Chalukya Express: Man kills railway staff, injures three

Attack started when TTE asked for ticket; suspect escaped near Khanapur station in K'taka

A passenger travelling without a ticket stabbed a railway coach attendant to death and injured three others, including a travelling ticket examiner (TTE), on board Chalukya Express near Londa railway station in Belagavi district of Karnataka on Thursday evening.

After the attack, the uniden-

tified passenger jumped off the train near Khanapur railway station and escaped.

According to a police officer, the coach attendant died on the train. The ticket examiner and two others, who were seriously injured in the knife attack, were rushed to a hospital in Belagavi. They are out of danger, he added.



Police sources said the passenger went on a stabbing spree when the ticket examiner asked him to show his ticket.

Belagavi Police Commissioner Lada Martin Marbaniang said the passenger started arguing when the ticket examiner asked him for the ticket. He suddenly pulled out a knife and attacked the ticket exam-

iner. When the coach attendant rushed to the rescue of the ticket examiner, the passenger stabbed him to death. He then attacked the ticket examiner and two others who intervened, Martin added. The police have launched a search operation to nab the assailant.

Martin later visited the hospital where the ticket examiner and two others are being treated.

ANOTHER government bus from Musiri bound for Kilambakkam bus terminus, which was trailing the bus, crashed into the rear end of the truck.

"Four passengers in the front upper and lower berths on the left side of the private bus were killed on the spot in the impact of the collision," the police officer said. At least 20 others suffered minor injuries and were shifted to the Chengalpattu government hospital for treatment.

The bus driver was booked under Section 304(A) (causing death by negligence), the police official said.

Chief Minister MK Stalin condoned the death of four victims and assured the state government's relief assistance to the bereaved families.

Just 24 hours ago, a mother, her two sons, and the driver of their car died in a road accident on the same highway near Madurantakam in the early hours of Wednesday.

# Woman, daughter hit by train killed in Sivakasi

A 54-year-old G Tamilselvi and her daughter Dhanakshmi (28) were killed after being hit by a running train at a track near Satchiyarpuram in Sivakasi on Thursday morning. Noticing a hearing and speech impaired Tamilselvi walking on the track, Dhanakshmi attempted to alert her, but in vain. The bodies were shifted to Sivakasi General Hospital, and the Srivilliputhur railway police have begun an inquiry into the incident, sources said.

# IT'S A RAINY WEEK DOWN SOUTH, FARMERS REJOICE

TELANGANA experienced light rains and decreased mercury levels on Thursday.

Light rains and thunder-showers with surface winds of around 40 kmph were experienced at isolated places in the districts of Jogulamba Gadwal, Kamareddy, Mahbubnagar, Medchal-Malkajgiri, Nalgonda, Narayanpet, Nizamabad, Siddipet and Vikarabad as per IMD reports.

The IMD said that a cyclonic circulation lies over east Vidarbha and surrounding regions at 0.9 km above mean sea level, and under its influence, the state will experience light to moderate rains or thunder-showers with gusty winds at

isolated places. A yellow alert has been issued for the same for most of the districts till May 19.

Heavy rainfall lashed Thiruvananthapuram on Thursday afternoon marooned many residential areas and triggered waterlogging on all major roads. The SS Kovil Road near Thampanoor was the worst hit as the extreme showers that lasted for more than two hours caused waterlogging, disrupted and Vikarabad as per IMD reports.

Meanwhile, heavy rains that lashed Thanjavur and Tiruvarur districts since Wednesday afternoon have come as respite for farmers who, despite concerns over lack of quality power supply, have cultivated early kuruvai paddy using pump sets.

CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1: Heavy rain is likely at isolated places over Virudhunagar, Madurai, Pudukkottai, Tiruvarur, Thanjavur, Nagapattinam, Mayiladuthurai, Tiruppur, Erode, Karaikal, Sivaganga, Ramanathapuram, Dindigul, Coimbatore, and Nilgiris on Friday; Tiruchy, Karur, Namakkal, Salem, Dharmapuri, Krishnagiri, Tirupattur, Thoothukudi, Ramanathapuram, Sivaganga, Dindigul on Saturday; and Dharmapuri, Krishnagiri, Salem, Tiruchy, Namakkal and Karur districts on Sunday. Light to moderate rain at many places with thunderstorms, lightning and gusty winds with speeds reaching 40-50 kmph at one or two places is likely to occur over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and Karaikal till May 20. In Chennai, the maximum temperature is likely to be around 29°C and the minimum temperature is likely to be 26-27°C on Friday. While sky conditions will be cloudy, moderate rain with thunderstorms and lightning is likely to occur in some areas.

Dindigul: The 61st Kodai festival and flower exhibition will commence at Kodaikanal Bryant Park on Friday. Organised by the department of horticulture and tourism development, the flower exhibition will be inaugurated by Principal Secretary to the Agricultural Production Commissioner S Apoorva. Senior officials from the horticulture and tourism department will partake in the event, which is set to conclude on May 26. In view of the festival, floral sculptures in the shapes of Thiruvallur, bear, cock, peacock, and others will be put on display. For the first time, the laser show will be open to visitors. Entry fee for adults is fixed at ₹75, while that of children is ₹35. ENS

# CWRC says no to release of backlog deficit water

THE Cauvery Water Regulation Committee (CWRC) on Thursday rejected the demand of Tamil Nadu to direct Karnataka to release backlog deficit water in environmental flow and ensure no further deficit in environmental flow of Cauvery river to the state. The committee ordered both states to give priority to their drinking water requirement. Heavy rainfall in Cauvery basin due to pre-monsoon showers over the last few days has helped ease the water stress in the riparian states. The interstate point at Biligundulu, which has been receiving barely 150 cusecs of water per day, has been receiving around 1,100 cusecs of water per day over the past five days.

# Top court relists Senthil Balaji's bail plea to July 10

NO relief to former Tamil Nadu minister Senthil Balaji soon, as the Supreme Court on Thursday relisted his bail plea to July 10. The MLA had challenged his bail rejection by the Madras High Court in the cash-for-jobs money laundering case on Wednesday. It is to be noted that the Madras HC had ordered that the trial should be conducted on a day-to-day basis in accordance with the guidelines given by the top court. The SC, in April first week, had issued a notice to the Enforcement Directorate (ED) asking the agency to file a detailed reply on the petition filed by Balaji against the HC order.

### Two held for murder of elderly woman

Virudhunagar: The Virudhunagar district police arrested B Manikandan (25) of Thirupuvanam and M Silambarasan (37) of Aavarankulam, and are on the lookout for M Dinesh of Madurai in connection with the murder of an elderly woman, Muthammal (65) of Kanakaneendal village, on Thursday. According to sources, the accused persons, who are construction site workers, killed Muthammal and stole a five sovereign gold ornament from her. Two of them were nabbed by the deceased's relatives, while they were attempting to catch a bus from Kariyapatti bus depot. Meanwhile, a search is under way by the Mallankinaru police to trace Dinesh, who is on the run.

### Two held with elephant tusks weighing 3.2 kg

Virudhunagar: Forest department detained two persons for possessing two elephant tusks weighing 3.2 kilograms in Rajapalayam. According to the police, one A Ram Alagu (40) of Ganapathi Sundaranachiyarpuram was detained with tusks based on a tip-off during a vehicle inspection on the Madurai-Kollam national highway near Seithur. Later, the police handed over Alagu to forest department officials, who later detained one Chellai of Rajapalayam in connection with the case. ENS
