JDS decides to suspend sex scandal accused MP Prajwal from party

Embarrassed by the scandal, JDS legislators demand that Prajwal be expelled from party

JANATA Dal (Secular) has decided to suspend its Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna, from the party. A Special Investigation Team (SIT) is probing allegations of his sexual abuse of several women, explicit videos of which have been making the rounds for the past few days. Prajwal, a JDS candidate from Hassan Lok Sabha constituency, and his father H D Revanna, a former minister have been named in the FIR.

Speaking to media persons in Shivamogga, former CM and JDS leader H D Kumaraswamy said a decision to suspend Prajwal was already made and it will be recommended at the party core committee meeting

Since Prajwal is a Member of Parliament, it has to be done from Delhi and he had requested JDS National President H D Deve Gowda. Neither he (Gowda) nor I were aware of this issue. If he (Prajwal) is guilty, he has to be punished - HD Kumaraswamy, JDS leader

In Hubballi on Tuesday. The former CM said since Prajwal is a Member of Parliament, it has to be done from Delhi and he had requested JDS National President H D Deve Gowda. "Neither he (Gowda) nor I were aware of this issue," the former CM said.

Kumaraswamy clarified that it was an individual issue and not a family issue. "Their (Revanna's) family is separate and our (his family and PM Deve Gowda's) family is separate. If he (Prajwal) is guilty, he has to be punished," the former CM said.

The JDS leader said the state government had already constituted an SIT to probe into the case, but hinted at some foul play surrounding the videos by stressing on the point that the videos on pen drives came out just three days before the elections.

Earlier on Monday in Bengaluru, the JDS leader said the development had caused embarrassment not just to him, but to the entire society. "Do not drag the entire Deve Gowda family into it. We do not live under the same roof," he said. Meanwhile, JDS legislators

are demanding action against the accused MP. JDS MLA from Mulbagal, Samruddhi Manjunath, demanded Prajwal's expulsion. "After the incident was aired over news channels, JDS workers were embarrassed to face questions from the media. As a JDS MLA, I am feeling so embarrassed, one can imagine the party worker's condition," he said in a series of tweets.

He said JDS supremo Deve Gowda and Kumaraswamy have to take suitable action now. He asked party leaders what is important for them - the political future of 19 JDS MLAs, or their family members, including H D Revanna and his son Prajwal Revanna? "It is high time, party leaders expelled him from the party," he said.

Probe on into death of man confronted by local people

PERINTHALMANNA police have launched an investigation into the death of a 30-year-old man who died after a confrontation with the local people in Karingalathani. The deceased is Nizamuddin, of Pilakkadan house, Ibrahimjadi, Perinthalmanna, an accused in several criminal cases.

According to local people, the incident leading to Nizamuddin's death occurred on Sunday. He attempted to kill his neighbour Saithalavi, 47, using a sword-like weapon while he was at Karingalathani.

Meanwhile, the residents

present there prevented the attack. They also shifted Saithalavi, who sustained multiple injuries, to a private hospital in the area. After the confrontation, Nizamuddin died.

"Nizamuddin fell on the ground when we were preventing him from attacking Saithalavi. His head collided with the ground. He was later shifted to a hospital by the police. The injury sustained on the head from the fall might have caused the death," a resident told reporters. Another resident said Nizamuddin was a distributor of drugs in the area. Perinthalmanna Rajeev N Ssaid a detailed investigation will be conducted into the incident.

Mercury in Ooty hits new high of 73 years

ONLY last December did the temperature in Ooty, a popular tourist destination in the state, drop to 0°C, leaving locals cooped up indoors, and now, on Sunday, less than six months later, the region recorded 29°C, the highest temperature in the last 73 years, according to S Balachandran from the Regional Meteorological Centre, Chennai. The region recorded 29°C for the second consecutive day on Monday, however, the situation has not deterred the inflow of tourists, as it only seems to be increasing.

"This temperature rise is not limited to Ooty, or even Tamil Nadu. Such an increase is being witnessed across the country," Balachandran told TNIE.



Balachandran said the temperature hike occurred right as the El Nino phase is coming to a close. He said they couldn't say if such temperatures will prevail next year too, stating that it is too early to predict. "The overall rise in temperature across Tamil Nadu clearly signals the importance of planting more trees and preventing deforestation," he said.

Most affected by the temperature hike in Ooty are the plantation workers and agricultural labourers. V Sivasadas from the Nilgiris Environment Social Trust, also an Ooty resident, said these days umbrellas are a common sight in the region, used by tourists and locals alike to escape the scorching heat. "Since tender coconut water is quite costly in Ooty and neigh-

bouring areas, we have been advising people to drink barley, sabja (basil seeds) or tulasi water instead, along with eating pear fruits," he said.

"Poovulagu" Sundararajan, founder of Poovulagu Nanbargal and a governing council member of the TN Climate Change Mission, told TNIE that it is time Ooty residents begin adapting to the new weather conditions by following the instructions issued by the health department carefully, in order to prevent sickness and death.

"We appeal to the state and Union government to examine human deaths in the summer months and declare the number of heat stroke deaths by examining autopsy reports, since cardiac arrest is also associated with a heat stroke," he said.

Siddharthan death accused seeks bail

ARUN alias Arun Keloth, the fourth accused in the death of J S Siddharthan, a student of College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences in Pookode, Wayanad, moved the Kerala High Court seeking bail.

In his plea, Arun, a final-year student and chairman of the college union, said since he was a prominent figure among students, he was falsely implicated.

Termining the prosecution's charges against him false, Arun submitted that he had not done anything to lead Siddharthan to end his life. He said he was busy making arrangements for the college's sports meet held on February 16 and 17.

He said also took part in a meet-up with Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on February 18 and was busy preparing the file to be submitted at the event.

In his plea, Arun said he is a bright student having a good record of academic excellence and is also a prominent figure in arts and cultural activities, and that his incarceration will jeopardise his future.
