BREAKING his silence on the sexual abuse charges against his grandson and Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna, JDS supremo and former PM H D Deve Gowda on Saturday clarified that he has no objection to the legal action initiated against Prajwal. However, he alleged that the ruling Congress has "created" a case against his son and MLA H D Revanna. The JDS supremo made his last public appearance on April 26 when he cast his vote at Paduvalahippe village in Hassan district along with his wife Channamma and family members. He did not step out of his Padmanabha Nagar house in

Arrest warrant against MP
Bengaluru: An arrest warrant against absconding Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna was issued on Saturday in connection with the alleged sexual abuse cases registered against him. The warrant was issued by the special magistrate court on an application by SIT, which is probing the cases.

Bengaluru after the scandal came to light. He did not even campaign in the third phase of Lok Sabha elections in Karnataka. On Saturday, he turned 92 and visited Sri Tirumalagiri Venkataramanaswamy Temple at JP Nagar as he does on his birthday every year and chose to speak to the media on the occasion. "We have no objection to the



action being taken against Prajwal. But people of the state have realised how a case has been created against Revanna," he said. taken against all of them, including Prajwal, as per law. It is the government's responsibility," he said. Replying to a query, Gowda said "it's true" that his detractors are trying to tarnish the image of his family. On BJP leader and lawyer Devaraje Gowda's allegation that Deputy CM DK Shivakumar is behind the "conspiracy", the former PM clarified that Kumaraswamy has spoken about all matters related to it. "As JDS state chief, Kumaraswamy has been handling various issues related to the party. He has even clarified that action should be taken against all those, including Prajwal, involved in the circulation of obscene pen drives," he said.

Pinarayi returns to state after 11-day foreign trip

CHIEF Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, accompanied by his family, has returned to the state after an 11-day private foreign trip. They landed at Thiruvananthapuram airport at 3 am on Saturday. Pinarayi was accompanied by his wife Kamalam and grandson, while his son-in-law and Minister P A Mohamed Riyas and wife Veena T are expected to return later.

The CM and his family embarked on a private tour to Indonesia, UAE, and Singapore on May 6. The details of his foreign trip were kept confidential, with cabinet ministers informed at the last moment after securing approval from the Central government. In his final online cabinet meeting before departing, the CM informed ministers of his return date to be May 18 or 19.

First Indian civilian astronaut all set to launch into space today

CAPTAIN Gopichand Thotakura, the second Indian who will travel to space after then Sqn Ldr Rakesh Sharma in April 1984, is set to make history on Sunday with the Blue Origin's NS-25 mission, as the company announces dates. He will be India's first civilian astronaut to go into space, and will be wearing a badge bearing the Indian flag as he takes flight on Sunday. Along with six other crew members, the seventh human

flight of the New Shepard, Thotakura will go beyond the Karman Line — the boundary that separates Earth's atmosphere and outer space and return to the planet. This mission not only signifies an Indian's re-entry into the space race, but will also make history with its crew of distinguished astronauts. Thotakura's flight will be the first Indian astronaut's foray into space exploration in four decades, following Wing Commander Rakesh Sharma's iconic journey aboard Soyuz

MP denies role in withdrawal of 2013 Secretariat siege

Defending the efforts of the CPM leadership to stop the Secretariat siege, Premachandran maintained that it was quite natural of them to end the protest. He further said that this was the first time someone came forward claiming that there was some sort of a give and take on the siege.

MSF secy protests at meet chaired by edu min, arrested

T'Puram: MSF state secretary Noufal Kulappada, who staged a protest at the meeting chaired by Education Minister V Sivankutty, was arrested by the police on Saturday. The minister had convened a meeting of youth organisations to discuss the arrangements for school reopening. Noufal waved a t-shirt at the minister, alleging a shortage of Plus-I seats in northern districts. The t-shirt bore the writings '45,530 seats are Malabar's right' and 'Malabar is in Kerala'. As the minister criticised his act, members of organisations owing allegiance to the LDF forcefully took Noufal out of the hall.

HC to rule on Jisha murder case death sentence appeal tomorrow

Kochi: The High Court will pronounce the judgment on an appeal filed by Muhammed Ameer-Ul-Islam, who was sentenced to death for raping and murdering LLB student Jisha in Perumbavoor, challenging the conviction on Monday. The court will also decide whether to confirm the death sentence or impose another lawful sentence on him. According to the convict, the sessions court arrived at a conviction and awarded the sentence by taking into consideration society's demand for stringent punishment rather than relying on evidence. Hence it was illegal, the appeal stated. The prosecution submitted that the brutal crime shocked the conscience of the judiciary and society.
