

Sanatana Dharma remark: Udhayanidhi appears before B'luru court, gets bail

TAMIL Nadu minister Udhayanidhi Stalin, who appeared before a Special Court in Bengaluru on Tuesday in connection with a case filed against him for his alleged controversial remarks on Sanatana Dharma, was granted bail.

Udhayanidhi, son of Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin, appeared before the 42nd Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (ACMM) court, also the special court for trial of cases against sitting and former MLAs/MPs, after he was issued assumption.

Udhayanidhi is the Minister for Sports and Youth Welfare in the Tamil Nadu Cabinet. The advocate representing Udhayanidhi argued that seven cases were registered against his cli-

ent across the country and an appeal was pending before the Supreme Court praying to club all the cases. Meanwhile, a bail petition was also moved before the court.

Observing that the case can't be exempted as the trial is still on in the Supreme Court, Judge KN Shivakumar granted bail to Udhayanidhi. The bail condi-

tions included furnishing surety of ₹1 lakh. The case has been adjourned to August 8.

The court had issued a summons against Stalin based on a private complaint filed by social activist Paramesh, who had filed a complaint against four persons, including the DMK leader, who missed the first notice. He was booked under Sec-

tions 500 (punishment for defamation), 153 (wantonly giving provocation with intent to cause riot) and 298 (uttering words with deliberate intent to wound religious feelings) of the IPC.

Speaking at a conference organised in Chennai by the Tamil Nadu Progressive Writers Artists' Association on the theme of 'Eradication of Sanatana' on September 4, 2023, Udhayanidhi had allegedly said that Sanatana Dharma is against social justice and equality and should be eradicated. "A few things cannot be opposed, they should be abolished only. We can't oppose dengue, mosquitoes, malaria, or corona. We have to eradicate this, that's how we have to eradicate Sanatana. Rather than opposing Sanatana, it should be eradicated," Udhayanidhi Stalin had allegedly said.

PFI wanted Islamic rule in India by 2047, claims NIA

RSS leader Sreenivasan's murder in 2022 was part of outfit's agenda

BANNED outfit Popular Front of India (PFI) had been on a mission to establish Islamic rule in India by 2047, the National Investigation Agency (NIA) has claimed. The NIA said the murder of RSS leader Sreenivasan in Palakkad in 2022 was committed as part of PFI's agenda - "India 2047".

"The accused committed a terrorist act of the murder of Sreenivasan on April 16, 2022, as a part of a larger conspiracy hatched by PFI and its office bearers and cadre to enact their India 2047 agenda of establishing Islamic rule in India," the NIA said in the report it submitted to the Kerala High Court while opposing the bail pleas of PFI/SDPI workers accused in

the RSS leader's murder.

The NIA also recovered a voice clip substantiating the mission from the phone of Mohammed Mubarak, the 15th accused in the murder case. The agency said the accused persons, all former state and districts leaders of the PFI, became part of a terrorist gang formed by the outfit, which recruited the outfit's cadre to terrorist gangs, collected details of leaders of other religions and communities and members of organisations such as Arya Samajam, and arranged and supervised arms training for the PFI cadre at its offices in Thiruvananthapuram Education and Service Trust and Periyar Valley Trust in Aluva on various occa-

sions. The gang also planned to stock weapons and explosives to commit terrorist acts, the NIA said.

The NIA said the accused persons knowingly took part in the conspiracy to commit the terrorist act of murdering any prominent leader of the Hindu community or its organisation to create terror in the minds of the community and the public, which resulted in the murder of Sreenivasan by the PFI cadre. The NIA also seized documents that said Hindus are "Kuffirs", and social media posts related to Islamic rule in India, and confiscated the 'India 2047' post forwarded to another accused C T Sulaiman from his WhatsApp profile.

SC asks TN to allow all-India permit buses

SUPREME Court's vacation bench on Tuesday directed the Tamil Nadu government to allow All India Tourist Permit (AITP) vehicles to pass through the state without any hindrance.

The apex court's two-judge vacation bench, led by Justice B V Nagarathna and Justice Ujjal Bhuyan, passed the order after hearing a plea filed by K R Suresh Kumar and other interstate bus operators who possess the AITP. While issuing a notice to the Tamil Nadu government and state transport authorities on the plea, the apex court asked these respondents to file their responses by August 12. The petitioners have moved the top court seeking to quash and set aside the state government's directives issued on November 6, 2023, and June 18, calling for compulsory registration of all buses registered in other states with the TN transport authorities to ply within the state.

THORAPALLI

Two kumkis brought to chase away wild elephants

TWO kumki elephants were brought to Thorapalli from the Theppakkadu camp on Monday evening to chase away wild elephants that intruded into residential areas in the surroundings of Srimadurai Panchayat. After four hours, the operation was called off as the road turned slippery due to rain.

Based on requests from the residents and farmers, two kumki elephants, Shankar and Srinivasan, were engaged in a driving-away operation starting at 11am at Makka Moola, where two wild elephants have been camping for weeks.

Gudalur Forest Range Officer P Radha Krishnan said, "Usually, kumki elephants would be engaged to drive away wild elephants after analysing the situation and climate of the area carefully once they reach the area. However, considering the urgency of demand of the locals, we engaged the kumkis on Tuesday morning. Seeing

the kumkis, the wild elephants stepped back. We drove away the wild elephants for one km from the residential area. We have also engaged more than 30 staff and prevented the animal from coming from MTR using vehicles horns. The operation continued on Tuesday night as well," he said.

The official said that they have been forced to cancel the operation after four hours due to rain as the road became slippery, and the operation will continue again on Wednesday.

SL navy seized 28 Indian trawlers, arrested 214 fishermen this year

"THE fishers were handed over to the officials of the Sri Lankan Department of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources in Myliddy for legal proceedings.

Meanwhile, the injured sailor or rushed to the shore and admitted to Teaching Hospital in Jaffna. He succumbed to his injuries a few hours later.

According to the Sri Lankan Navy, it has seized a total of 28 Indian trawlers and 214 Indian fishermen in Sri Lankan waters in 2024.

"The navy remains steadfast in its mission to safeguard its waters from illegal poaching activities," said the statement.

'CONVENE WORKING GROUP'

Chennai: Chief Minister MK Stalin on Tuesday urged Union External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar to convene the joint working group to prevent further arrests of Tamil Nadu fishermen and to secure the release of all the fishermen and their fishing boats under the custody of Sri Lankan authorities. The CM, in his letter, said, "I request your immediate intervention to convene the joint working group to prevent further arrests."

ACCORDING to the data of the union labour and employment ministry, as many as 77.79 lakh youths got job opportunities, Stalin said.

Through the Naam Mudhalvan Scheme, 3,06,459 youths have been placed in private sector jobs. Apart from these, through special job fairs conducted by the labour welfare department, 2,01,596 youths have got jobs in the private sector, he said.

In total, 5.08 lakh youth in Tamil Nadu got jobs through various government initiatives, Stalin added.

2 from KL with tampered passports arrested in Kovai

THE city police booked a case against two from Kerala for allegedly producing tampered passports at the Coimbatore International Airport on Monday.

The suspects were identified as Thahira (61) and A Ajmal (44), na-

tives of Malappuram in Kerala.

Police said as per the complainant filed by Likhi, Immigration Officer of Coimbatore airport, on duty on Sunday that when Thahira's husband Umer submitted her passport for verification to go to Singapore through Scoot Airlines, they found that the front

and last pages of her passport were fabricated and it did not consist Thahira's original bio. Following that when the immigration officials held an investigation, it was found that the bio-pages attached to her passport belonged to Ajmal's passport and it is suspected that as Thahira's passport va-

lidity expired in 2016, they would have interchanged the pages from Ajmal's passport.

The Peelamedu police registered a case under Sections 465 (forgery) and 471 (using forged documents) of the IPC and Sections 12(1)(b)(d) of the Passport Act.

TvmCH doctor booked for attacking security guard

Tirunelveli: A case was registered against an anaesthesiologist of the Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital (TvmCH) for attacking hospital security, allegedly while inebriated, on Monday. The accused was identified as Dr Mohankumar. "The accused doctor was on night duty. As he neared the hospital, only one gate was open. He called the security guard and picked up an argument on why the latter had not opened both gates. The guard explained that he was instructed not to keep both gates open during the night. Angered by the guard's reply, Mohankumar allegedly attacked him."

Excavation at Uthangarai unearths neolithic axe

THE remains of a stone axe, believed to belong to 2000 BCE, was found in the Chennanoor archaeological excavation site near Uthangarai. Minister for Archaeology Thangam Thennarasu on Monday shared the images of the tool on social media and stated that neolithic tool is 6 cm length and 4 cm width. It was found 53 cm deep in the site.
