Demolition| BJYM leader shot to death

Illegal portions of accused's house razed

Kin stage protest to seek complete demolition of house and gallows for the killers

Two days after the murder of Minister Kailash Vijayvargiya's aide and BJYM vice president Monu Kalyane, illegal portions of the two accused's house were bulldozed by Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) on Tuesday.

Armed with pochain and JCB machines, the removal gang accompanied with heavy police force reached Usha Phatak area in the evening where the house was situated and began the demolition drive.

There was uproar as huge crowd gathered in front of the illegal structure during the demolition. Accused Arjun and Piyush (uncle and nephew) Pathrod lived with their family in a three-storied building. The entire house has been deserted since the killing. Also, both the accused were arrested on Monday

from Mandep in Bhopal and brought to the city. A notice was pasted on the house stating that the illegally built portion will be demolished on Tuesday. When the demolition was underway, family members and relatives of deceased Monu Kalyane reached Chickmangloor Square where the murder occurred and staged a demonstration demanding complete demolition of the house. The IMC informed the protesters that they had right to demolish only the illegally built portion of the house. However, the protesters

pressed for their demand saying that they would not give up protest until the house is flattened. Minor dispute also took place between the protesters and passers-by who had hard time to pass through the road where demonstration was going on. Apart from complete demolition of the house, the protesters were also seeking death penalty to killers of Monu Kalyane. ACP Vinod Dixit pacified the protesters saying that a strong case will be put up before the court seeking capital punishment for the accused.

What was the incident

BJYM vice president Monu Kalyane was shot dead by two youths near Chimb-anbagh on Jail Road in the intervening night of Saturday and Sunday. The incident occurred while Kalyane was hanging up posters for Bhagwa Vahan Rally, which was scheduled to begin on Sunday afternoon. The two accused came near the deceased saying they were interested in the rally.

Police crack robbery case, 3 arrested

The Chhatarpur police three days ago cracked the case of robbery on the Sathya Ghati on the Sagar-Kanpur highway under the jurisdiction of Bada Malhera police station. It has been reported that all three accused involved in the incident were apprehended for the motorcycle used in the crime and the stolen amount. Two of the apprehended robbers already have prior criminal records. After presenting the arrested robbers in court, they were sent to jail.

Kamal Singh Thakur, the in-charge inspector of Bada Malhera police station, informed that on June 21, Balram Yadav, a resident of Bhojpur police station in the district, complained that unknown bandits had stopped him near Sathya Ghati on the Sagar-Kanpur National Highway and stolen Rs 12,000 from him.

After this, a team was formed at the station level, which exposed the case in just 48 hours on the basis of a physical inspection of the inci-

dent site, information on the movement in the area, and other evidence.

The sub-divisional team had taken three suspects into custody, who had admitted to being involved in the incident during questioning. The arrested bandits were identified as Pappu Yadav, Gangaram Yadav, and Akram Khan. Apart from the motorcycle used in the incident, Rs 1,000 was also seized from the accused.

Another accused of the incident, Puspender Yadav, a resident of gram Batawa police station Shahgarh, is still absconding, whose search is on-

11-month-old girl drowns in bucket

An eleven-month-old girl drowned in a bucket while playing at her place in Rau police station circle on Tuesday.

Her mother had bathed her and gone to bring a towel to dry her when she went towards the bucket filled with water and drowned into it while playing.

According to the police, the deceased was identified as

Joe, daughter of Sandeep Jogeshwar, a resident of Pulak City.

Rau police station in-charge Rajpal Singh Rathore said that they received information from the hospital that a toddler died after drowning in a bucket.

Her father is an employee in a private company at Pithampur. Police initiated a probe into the case to ascertain the circumstances surrounding the incident and sent the body for autopsy.
