G7 demands China play by rules

The Group of Seven countries call on Beijing to end its market distorting trade practices and support for Russia's war in Ukraine

G7 leaders meeting in Italy on Friday hardened their tone against China, warning Beijing to stop sending weapons components to Russia and play by the rules on trade, according to a draft summit statement.

China has been a key focus of the Group of Seven talks in Puglia, amid souring trade relations between Beijing and the West and concerns that its supplies of equipment to Moscow are fuelling Russia's war in Ukraine.

"We call on China to cease the transfer of dual-use materials, including weapons components and equipment, that are inputs for Russia's defence sector," according to a draft statement seen by AFP.

The Group of Seven also took aim at what it called "dangerous" incursions by China in the contested South China Sea, where worries of a military escalation between Beijing and its neighbours are rising.

"We oppose China's militarisation, and coercive and intimidation activities in the South China Sea," the statement read, using stronger language than at last year's summit in Japan.

After a first day dominated by Ukraine, US President Joe Biden and the leaders of Japan, France, Germany, Canada, Britain and host country Italy turned their focus to the world's second-largest economy, a superpower whose oversized influence on geopolitics and global trade cannot be underestimated.

"G7 countries are on the same page vis-a-vis China," a Japanese government source told AFP. Thursday's talks, attended by Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky, were marked by a strong show of G7 support for Kyiv, with an agreement to use profits from frozen Russian assets to provide a new \$50-billion loan to Ukraine.

With the war in its third year, the G7 summit said the deal sent an "unmistakable signal" to Russian President Vladimir Putin that they would back Kyiv for "as long as it takes".

Deteriorating global trade relations have been a backdrop to the summit, however, exemplified by the European Union's announcement this week of plans to impose new tariffs on Chinese electric vehicles.

Beijing denounced what it called "naked protectionist behaviour" and said it reserved the right to file a suit with the World Trade Organization (WTO).

The US, Japan and the EU—which attends G7 summits as an unofficial eighth partner—have all voiced concern over China's so-called "industrial overcapacity".

They say generous subsidies by Beijing, particularly in green energy and technology sectors such as solar panels and electric vehicles, result in unfairly cheap goods flooding the global market.

That excess capacity threatens Western companies struggling to compete, particularly in the growing green tech sector. "We express our concerns about China's persistent industrial targeting and comprehensive non-market policies," the G7 summit draft said.

It warned against "practices that are leading to global spillovers, market distortions and harmful overcapacity in a growing range of sectors".

Security and defence concerns were front and centre Friday, particularly accusations that Beijing has helped expand Russia's armed forces.

Washington has accused Beijing of helping Russia's defence industry—and therefore its invasion of Ukraine—through joint production of drones and exports of machine tools needed for ballistic missiles. AFP

Pope raises alarm about artificial intel

POPE Francis challenged leaders of the world's wealthy democracies on Friday to keep human dignity foremost in developing and using artificial intelligence, warning that such powerful technology risks turning human relations themselves into mere algorithms.

Francis brought his moral authority to bear on the Group of Seven, invited by host Italy to address a special session at their annual summit on the perils and promises of AI. In doing so, he became the first pope to attend the G7.

Francis said politicians must take the lead in making AI human-centric, so that human decisions always remain made by humans and not machines.

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No ceasefire till Ukraine pulls back its troops completely, says Putin

MOSCOW

RUSSIAN President Vladimir Putin on Friday demanded Ukraine effectively surrender to Moscow if it wants to open peace talks, drawing rebukes from Kyiv and the West.

In a combative speech in Moscow on the eve of a major Ukraine peace summit in Switzerland, Putin said Russia would halt its offensive only if Ukraine fully withdraws its troops from the east and south and drops its bid for NATO membership.

The countries have been locked in bloody conflict for more than two years, and no direct peace talks have

been held since the first weeks of Russia's campaign, when it was advancing on the Ukrainian capital.

Kyiv has called for Russia's full withdrawal from its internationally recognised territory, including the annexed Crimean peninsula, as part of any peace deal.

President Volodymyr Zelensky, who hopes to marshal international support for that position this week-end, slammed Putin's demands as a territorial "ultimatum" reminiscent of Adolf Hitler.

"Ukrainian troops must be completely withdrawn from the Donetsk People's Republic, the Lugansk Peo-

ple's Republic, Kherson and Zaporizhzhia regions," Putin said in a televised address to Russian diplomats in Moscow.

Russia claimed to have annexed the four regions in 2022, despite not having full control over any of them.

The regional capitals of Kherson and Zaporizhzhia are still in Ukrainian hands — meaning Putin is demanding Ukraine cede swathes of territory under its control as a precondition for negotiations.

"As soon as Kyiv says it is ready to do this and begins really withdrawing troops and officially renounces plans to join NATO, we will immediately, literally that very minute, cease fire and begin talks," the Russian president said. AFP
