

Naidu promises white paper soon on capital city construction status

CM says he's confused after assessing projects, lauds farmers who helped revive capital status

A MARAVATI: ANDHRA Pradesh Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on Thursday said he is in a dilemma over Amaravati, after taking stock of the stalled projects in the greenfield capital he had championed. He promised to soon release a white paper on the status of Amaravati and elicit suggestions from people on the way forward.

Amaravati capital city project came to a standstill from 2019 to 2024 under the previous YSRCP regime.

However, the change in government breathed new life into the project as Naidu categorically declared that Amaravati would be the sole capital of Andhra Pradesh. This is the first time the CM is visiting Amaravati after assuming the office for the fourth term.

"After going around Amaravati, I am confused as to what to do. Today, I came for the first time to see where we are and what to do in the future. We will take suggestions and everyone should deliberate on this issue," he told reporters.

The Chief Minister inspected construction projects, such as residential quarters for officials, legislators, judges and the stalled high court, secretariat and other sites.

"We will release a white paper on Amaravati with all the details," said Naidu, accompanied by Municipal Minister P Narayana and senior officials.

The CM noted that up to 80 per cent work on these projects was completed.

According to the CM, had the Amaravati city project gone ahead as planned, the road infrastructure would have come up by now.

Naidu asserted that Amaravati is the address of five crore people of the state and termed it as people's capital which can

show direction to all.

Noting that nearly 55,000 acres of land bank is available in Amaravati from all sources, he thanked the farmers for giving up their lands for the state capital.

He praised farmers of Amaravati region who protested for 1,631 days to restore its capital status and assured that port city Visakhapatnam will be developed as the financial capital and Kurnool as a modern city.

Replying to a question from a video on the ₹500-crore palatial mansion built atop Rushikonda in Visakhapatnam during the YSRCP regime, Naidu castigated the previous regime for indulging in such extravagance when there were no financial resources in the state.

The sea-view mansion, built with ultra-luxury amenities such as Italian marble, 200 chandeliers, 12 bedrooms, and others was purportedly meant to be the residence of the former chief minister. Without elaborating, Naidu said he will discuss it later.

Docs say birth control, vaccine must for dogs

LOCAL bodies and the animal husbandry department too play an important role in preventing deaths, he said.

"There should be an effective Animal Birth Control (ABC) programme and all dogs must be vaccinated. People also should come forward to get vaccinated after dog bite. We have adequate doses of vaccines in the state. It is available even at PHCs," said Dr Selvavinayagam.

A village health nurse said though all the PHCs have anti-rabies vaccine, some don't administer it to patients when there is a dog bite because once the vial is opened it must be used within that day. One vial would have a minimum of five doses and they don't want to waste them, she said, adding that they instead direct the patient to the nearest taluk, headquarters, or medical college hospitals.

When asked, Dr Selvavinayagam said, clear instructions have been given to all the village health nurses to administer vaccinations at all times. "We have clearly told them that

they will not be questioned irrespective of the number of vials wasted. Whoever comes, whatever may be the time, they don't have to worry about vaccine wastage," he said.

If people face any such issues, they can contact 104 helpline and it will be immediately addressed. Vaccinating people is important and that is the sole aim, Dr Selvavinayagam said.

According to doctors, four doses of intradermal regimen must be followed. The vaccine should be given on days zero, three, seven and 28 of dog bite. If the bite is severe, the wound should be locally infiltrated with antibodies immunoglobulin, as it will take some time for production of antibodies after vaccination. The site of the bite should be washed thoroughly with water and soap before coming for vaccination. Dr R Muthuselvan, Dean, Government Kilpauk Medical College Hospital, said, "People don't complete the vaccination and skip a few doses. Some decide not to get vaccinated if bitten by pet dogs and some others come for vaccinations days after the dog bite."



Ex-Indian pacer David Johnson falls to death

FORMER Indian cricketer David Jude Johnson died after he allegedly fell off the balcony of his fourth floor apartment in Kothanur on Thursday around 10.30 am. He was 52, living with his family at SLV Paradise Apartment in Kanakashri Layout. His wife is said to have told police that Johnson slipped and fell off the balcony. However, police suspect it to be a case of suicide.

According to police, Johnson was dealing with alcoholism and had joined a de-addiction centre a few months ago. He was admitted to a private hospital in Ashoknagar last week for a stomach-related illness and was discharged three days ago. He is suspected to have slipped into depression due to prolonged illness.

Varsity teachers' assn wants TN govt to pay CAS salary, stages stir
