

# Under fire, Pune IAS probationer recalled, her training on hold

INDIAN ADMINISTRATIVE Service (IAS) probationer Puja Khedkar, who faces allegations of misusing the Other Backward Classes (OBC) and Persons With Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) quotas, has been "recalled" to the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA) and her "district training programme" has been put "on hold".

You are instructed to join the Academy at the earliest but not later than July 23, 2024.

The LBSNAA in Mussoorie is a training institution for civil servants.

Earlier this month, Khedkar (34) was transferred from Pune to Washim as "super numerary assistant collector", after questions were raised about her appointment under the OBC and PwBD categories. She also faces allegations of misconduct, including seeking special privileges that she is not entitled to as a probationer.

Khedkar secured a rank of 821 in the UPSC Civil Services Examination, and was reportedly allotted the IAS under the OBC and PwBD quotas. Last week, the Centre constituted a single-member committee under the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) to examine all documents submitted by Khedkar.

"It has been decided that district training of Puja Khedkar, IAS 2023 batch, be kept on hold and she be immediately recalled at the Academy for further necessary action. The state government is requested to relieve the probationer immediately and advise her to join the academy at the earliest, not later than July 23 under any circumstances," the DoPT said in a letter to the Maharashtra Chief Secretary on Tuesday.

Earlier, Khedkar had denied the charges and said she would speak before the committee set up by the Centre.

# UP woman set ablaze on police station campus dies, son held

A 42-YEAR-OLD woman died after she was set ablaze allegedly by her 21-year-old son on a police station campus in Aligarh district on Tuesday, officers said. The accused, identified as Gaurav, has been arrested, they added. Earlier, police personnel reached the spot and took the victim, Hemlata Singh, who had suffered 70 per cent burns, to hospital where she died.

The police said Hemlata and Gaurav reached the Khairi police station in Aligarh on Tuesday in a bid to settle a long-pending dispute with her in-laws over a family property in her late husband Raj Bahadur's native village of Darkan.

Her husband died five years ago. Before his death, the couple and their son were living in a house owned by Chandrabhan Singh, who is Raj Bahadur's uncle. After Bahadur's death, Chandrabhan Singh asked Hemlata and Gaurav to vacate the house but they refused, the police said.

"We had called both parties for a settlement at the police station today. The mother and son were demanding Rs 10 lakh from Chandrabhan for vacating the house but he made it clear that he could not pay more than Rs 5 lakh. Chandrabhan and his family members had a heated argument over the issue at the police station. Hemlata then stepped out and within seconds, Gaurav poured kerosene on his mother and used a lighter to set her on fire. Police personnel present there rushed to save her," said Aligarh Senior Superintendent of Police Sanjeev Suman.

Superintendent of Police (Rural) Palash Bansal said the motive of the accused was not yet clear. "We have arrested the suspect and are going through the available video footage of the incident," said Bansal.

# Teen girl 'raped', private tutor held

Saharanpur: A 15-year-old girl was allegedly raped several times by her private tutor here, police said on Tuesday. The 28-year-old accused was arrested on Tuesday.

Additional SP Abhimanyu Manglik said the tutor used to visit the girl's house for religious teaching. The girl's family alleged that the tutor raped the girl several times and they came to know about it only two days ago. PTI

# Woman 'abducted, killed' by grocery store owner

Meerut: A 23-year-old woman was allegedly abducted and killed by the owner of a grocery store in Bareilly on Sunday night, police said.

The police said family members of the victim lodged a police

complaint over her abduction on Sunday evening. On Monday, a body was found in a nullah that was later identified as that of hers. "We arrested the accused, Monu Gupta, 30, on Monday. His wife is also being interrogated,"

said SSP Anurag Arya. Her brother claimed in the FIR that his sister and a cousin were returning home around 7 pm on Sunday when Monu Gupta and his wife signalled them to stop and convinced the

woman to accompany them in their car.

"Our inquiry revealed that Monu had illicit relations with the deceased for more than one year," said Bareilly (North) SP Mukesh Chand Mishra. ENS

# Why convicts don't want to appeal: No hope, fear of tougher sentence, poverty

IN APRIL, while appearing for a convict from Chhattisgarh who had filed an appeal through legal aid, senior advocate Vijay Hansaria told the Supreme Court, "The petition filed on behalf of the accused is delayed by 2,461 days." Hansaria was referring to how his client, Kariman, who had spent 17 years in jail when the maximum sentence for his crime was seven years, had been denied something as fundamental as access to appeal against his conviction.

"He spent an extra 10 years in jail because he did not know that an appeal could have been filed. That's when I realised that there is a larger issue here," Hansaria told The Indian Express.

While directing Kariman's release, a Supreme Court bench of Justices B R Gavai and Sandeep Mehta appointed Hansaria as an amicus curiae (friend of the court) to evaluate if over 1.5 lakh convicts

lodged in prisons across the country have legal representation.

Since May, armed with a proforma drafted by Hansaria, legal aid lawyers under the supervision of National Legal Services Authority (NALSA), the premier legal aid body, have met over 15,000 convicts across 18 states, all of them punished with sentences ranging from 7-10-year jail terms to life imprisonment and death. The proforma collects details to ensure every convict is aware of the constitutional right to appeal against the verdict against her/him and is not in jail for lack of representation.

According to submissions filed by NALSA in the Supreme Court for the hearing on July 15, in response to its drive, 870 convicts across these 18 states agreed to file an appeal with assistance from legal aid. The court directed that the appeals be filed in these cases.

However, nearly 675 convicts chose to not file appeals. In the affidavit filed before the court, advocate Rashmi Nandakumar, appearing for NALSA, said most of

the 675 convicts who said no to filing appeals simply said they were "not willing/interested in preferring an appeal". Others said they had already undergone the maximum sentence or had almost completed their terms and saw no reason to clear their names by going in for an appeal. The third highest reason among these 675 convicts was that their appeal had been rejected by the High Court and they weren't hopeful of a favourable verdict. The affidavit

mentioned "poverty" as the fourth biggest reason for inmates preferring not to appeal against their sentences. Besides, several of these 675 convicts outlined "fear that sentence may be enhanced in the Appellate court," and a belief that "nothing favourable will happen to them in Appellate Court", besides mental health issues, as reasons for not exercising their right to appeal.

Nearly half of the 675 convicts (384) who refused to file appeals were from West Bengal.

In at least four states - West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya and Puducherry - the number of convicts who refused to file an appeal was higher than the convicts who decided to appeal their sentences.

In Arunachal Pradesh, for example, only five convicts agreed to file an appeal while 30 said no. The NALSA affidavit noted that several of these 30 convicts "were involved in multiple cases."

Several convicts also cited a preference to hire a private lawyer as reason to refuse legal aid.

# Allies in, Centre reconstitutes NITI Aayog

THE GOVERNMENT on Tuesday reconstituted the NITI Aayog, increasing the number of special invitees from five to 11, including five ministers from the BJP's allies - H D Kumaraswamy (JD-S), Jitan Ram Manjhi (HAM), Rajiv Ranjan Singh (JD-U), K R Naidu (TDP) and Chirag Paswan (JLP-Ram Vilas).

Prime Minister Narendra Modi remains the Chairperson and economist Suman K Bery will continue to be the Vice Chairperson of NITI Aayog, according to the notification. Scientist V K Saraswat, agricultural economist Ramesh Chand,

paediatrician V K Paul and macro-economist Arvind Virmani will also continue to be full-time members of the government think-tank. BVR Subrahmanyam will also remain the CEO.

Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chauhan has replaced his predecessor Narendra Singh Tomar as an ex-officio member. The other ex-officio members include Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, Home Minister Amit Shah and Defence Minister Rajnath Singh.

Among the other special invitees are Union Ministers Nitin Gadkari (Road Transport and Highways), J P Nadda (Health), Virendra Kumar (Social Justice and Empowerment), Jugal Oram (Tribal Affairs), Annapurna Devi (Women and Child

Development) and Rao Inderjit Singh (Statistics and Programme Implementation).

Union Ministers Piyush Goyal and Ashwini Vaishnaw, who were special invitees earlier, are not on the list this time. Gadkari, Virendra Kumar and Rao Inderjit Singh were special invitees earlier too.

Among the allies who have been included, Kumaraswamy has the Heavy Industries and Steel portfolio, Manjhi has Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Rajiv Ranjan Singh alias Lalan Singh has Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Naidu has Civil Aviation, and Chirag Paswan has Food Processing Industries.

# Excise policy case: SC notice to CBI, ED on Sisodia's bail plea

THE SUPREME COURT Tuesday issued notice on former Delhi deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia's plea for bail in cases registered under the Prevention of Corruption Act and Prevention of Money Laundering Act in connection with the excise policy 'scam'.

A bench of Justices B R Gavai, Sanjay Karol, and K V Viswanathan sought a response from the Central Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement Directorate which have registered the cases against him. The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader was arrested last year.

Appearing for the leader, Advocate Vivek Jain told the bench that Sisodia has been in jail for the past 16 months and that the trial had not progressed beyond the stage at which it was in October 2023 when the SC rejected his bail plea, giving him liberty to approach it once again if there is no progress in trial.

The SC had denied bail to Sisodia on October 10, 2023. Though it raised doubts on some of the charges levelled against him by the ED, the court, however, said there is "material and evidence" which "tentatively" supports one of the charges under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002. Subsequently, the court also dismissed petitions seeking review of its October 10 order.

The court will now hear the matter on July 29.
