

High alert in AP as Godavari in spate, 4 lakh cusecs being discharged into sea

The water level at the Sir Arthur Cotton Barrage reached 10.8 ft on Saturday with about 4.09 lakhs cusecs water being discharged into the sea.

the heavy rains continue in the upper catchment areas. In Alluri Sitarama Raju district, Collector AS Dinesh Kumar has warned of potential flooding in the Chintur division due to the incessant downpour and surge in inflows from upstream river catchment areas.

Officials have been instructed to remain vigilant in flood-affected regions and implement relief and rehabilitation measures. Additionally, Kumar has issued orders banning the movement of heavy vehicles, buses, and private jeeps on five key ghat roads in the state.

Officials said the first warning will be issued at the barrage, once it receives inflows at the rate of 10 lakh cusecs. They added that it will take four to five days for the inflows to touch 10 lakh cusecs, if

WIFE ABSCONDING

Man held for stealing ₹10 lakh from neighbour's house

THE Annathanampatty police here arrested 44-year-old man, T Mohandas, for stealing ₹10 lakh cash from his neighbour's house.



The theft, which occurred on May 29, was reported by neighbour N Mani (67), who found the money missing upon returning home from Pethanaickenpalayam.

Police sources say the couple took advantage of Mani's absence to steal the money. An FIR was filed at the Annathan-

ampatty police station, prompting an investigation. Initially, the investigation faced delays due to Sharmila's advanced stage of pregnancy.

The investigation revealed the couple's involvement, leading to Mohandas's arrest on Friday. The police have recovered 5 sovereigns of gold worth ₹3 lakh and ₹2.9 lakh in cash from them.

A police official told TNIE that Sharmila is currently absconding and efforts are on to apprehend her and recover the balance amount.

ANOTHER female worker said, "The power supply was cut immediately, drowning the premises in darkness. Workers started running helter-skelter, leading to injuries caused by bumping into one another or running into walls."

According to Dr Porselvan, deputy director (rural health), "About 30 women, including 16 from Odisha, were shifted to three private hospitals in an ambulance to receive immediate medical attention. Among them, five have been admitted to the Intensive Care

Unit (ICU). Five other women have been discharged following treatment." "The women are healthy and safe, however they will be under observation for one more day," said a senior doctor of the Thoothukudi Medical College Hospital.
