A man was hanged upside down, beaten up on suspicion of motorbike theft in Narsinghpur, police said on Tuesday.

A video showing a man hung upside down and being thrashed surfaced on social media following which five persons were arrested. Additional Superintendent of Police, Nagendra Pateria said that the incident took place under Chichali police station area and a case of kidnapping and assault has been registered.
