Congress state president Shaktisinh Gohil had expressed his desire to be freed from Gujarat about 15 days ago before the Delhi Mowdi Mandal. Along with this, political sources have expressed the possibility that Priyanka Gandhi will be entrusted with the charge of Gujarat in order to change the power in the upcoming assembly elections.

When the state Congress has stopped BJP's hat-trick of 26 seats in the Lok Sabha elections, the Congress has come to believe that there can be a change of power in Gujarat. Hence, Rahul Gandhi also said in the MP and then in Gujarat that the Congress alliance will defeat the BJP in

Gujarat in the 2027 assembly elections. Sources of the Congress say that with this mentality, the Congress is bringing massive changes in Gujarat.

In the Gujarat Lok Sabha elections, the Congress, under the leadership of state president Shaktisinh Gohil and in-charge Mukul Wasnik, won one seat but also managed to deprive the BJP of a lead of 5 lakhs. After this, the confidence that the next assembly election of Gujarat can also be won has been communicated in the Congress. In such circumstances, the National Congress is moving ahead to radically change the Gujarat Congress with the aim of 2027 assembly elections. State president Shaktisinh Gohil has now expressed his desire to be freed from Gujarat. Hence, there is a possibility that he will be made in charge of Haryana instead of Gujarat. It has been learned that Haryana Congress has demanded Shaktisinh Gohil as the in-

charge. In this regard, Shaktisinh Gohil said, "My wish does not work, I am a soldier of the party. Earlier, I was made in charge of Bihar, and if I was made in charge of Delhi, I also accepted that responsibility."

After this, I did not want to come as the state president of Gujarat, even though the party said so I came, I am a soldier of the party, I will carry out the orders given by the party, Gohil said in the end. He did not give any clear answer about being released from Gujarat, but earlier also he expressed his reluctance to go as the state president of Gujarat as he himself is from Gujarat.



PM Modi has time and again stressed the citizens to wash their hands regularly and do not touch their face, eyes or nose as the infection can spread in the human body via their face, therefore it becomes a very important step.

Explaining how the infection can spread from one person to another, PM Modi has given a message that the coronavirus is a respiratory disease that spread like the flu virus. It can be transferred from one person to another via droplets from coughs or sneezes, sometimes these droplets from one's mouth are not even visible. And that's why we all need to be very careful and need to wash

hands with soap regularly. India has one third of the world's poorest population and the Global Goals have a significant role to play especially at a time when 1.3 billion people are forced to live in poverty across the world. There is a need to increase awareness and understanding about the importance of hand washing with soap as an easy, effective, and affordable way to prevent diseases and save our lives. The habit of proper hand washing is directly linked to one's health especially among school going children. For hand washing to be more effective it must be accomplished consistently at key times, such as after using the toilet or before contact with food. Habit formation is currently a hot topic in behavior change and the water, sanitation, and hygiene sector.

Hand-washing is the No. 1 prevention against spread of infection, inside and outside the hospital setting. It is important in the home, in schools and in every workplace. It is the cornerstone of infection-control practice and education for everyone who works in health care. Every year worldwide, 8.8 million children younger than age 5

die of preventable illnesses. There are many children in the world who do not have access to safe water, or the habit or means to wash their hands properly. It is also observed that when students have access to clean water, soap, and toilet facilities, they are less likely to drop out or miss classes due to illness. We know that hand washing with soap is the most effective and inexpensive way to prevent diarrheal diseases - reducing incidence by up to 47% - and combined with improved sanitation, this is boosted to 68%.

Many diseases are transmitted when we don't wash our hands. Bacterial, viral and fungal infections can be prevented if the hands are washed properly every day. Worm infestation, anemia, malnutrition and diarrhea are the common health hazards caused by unhygienic hands. If there is no hygiene, there is no health.

The introduction of water, sanitation and hygiene interventions in schools, including hand washing with soap, is an entry point for children to understand and then take these good hygiene practices back into their homes and communities. Hand washing is a small action that can have big benefits. Let us progress towards the goal of maintaining a global profile on the importance of hand hygiene in health care and to 'bring people together' in support of hand hygiene improvement globally. It is a need of the hour to spread the word about hand washing, build sinks and tippy taps, and demonstrate the simplicity and value of clean hands. We need to emphasize the importance of hand washing as a way to prevent disease, the necessity of using soap instead of only water, how everyone's health can benefit from washing their hands, and the key times for hand washing, including before and after eating. A sign of cabinet expansion within weeks

Central leader barring ministers from taking policy and key decisions

Only when the Lok Sabha elections were announced, one thing was decided that the MLAs who had joined the BJP from the Congress would be included in the cabinet by giving tickets again. There are indications that this hour will come in the next week or so. State ministers have been urged not to take any policy decisions. However, the two newly

electd Congress MLAs in the new cabinet are certain, but there is a consensus on how many MLAs from the original BJP will get ministerial posts. According to sources, the state cabinet currently has a cabinet of 17 ministers including Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel. This Cabinet consists of 9 Cabinet Ministers, 2 State Level Ministers with Independent Charge and 6 State Level Ministers.

Among these ministers, the chief minister has the largest number of accounts. Also Cabinet Ministers like Rishikesh Patel, Balwantsinh Rajput, Mooloo Bera, Kunwarji Bavaliya, Kuber Dindor, Bhanuben Babria have more than one account. In such a case, there is a possibility that the cabinet will be expanded in a week or so if there is no need to take a policy decision from the centre.

Ahmedabad jewellers' scam

Gathia shows screenshot of 1.27 lakh payment after buying jewellery; Complaint threatening a trader

People who cheat traders in Ahmedabad have become more active. Complaints of fraudsters with merchants by sending screenshots of online payments and messages are on the rise. The merchant has lodged a complaint at the Ghatlodia police station against a customer who took jewellery worth Rs 1.24 lakh from a gold dealer in the city and blackmailed him into paying him. The police have registered a complaint and are conducting further investigation.

Prateek Shah, a jeweler in the city's Memnagar area, asked to make an online payment while filing a complaint, said that a person named Rushil Shah came to our shop and bought three pieces of jewellery worth Rs 1.47 lakh. This Rushil Shah processed the payment by telling the complainant that he will pay online. He then asked the complainant for the bank account number saying that the limit was over and asked him to make payment in it. So the complainant gave him the account number. Then Rushil Shah sent him the screenshot and message of the payment. Rushil Shah again went to the complainant's shop and talked about buying gold bars of ten

grams. This time also he sent the screen shot of the payment.

On checking the screenshot, the pot exploded and

the money was not deposited in the complainant's account, so he was not released. The complainant made him sit in the shop until payment was received. But the merchant let him go as he gave a blank cheque. After examining the screen shot sent by Rushil Shah, the prosecutor found that it was false. After that, Rushil Shah stopped picking up the phone. When the complainant went to his house, Rushil Shah's parents returned one VT to him and the rest of the jewellery is with Rushil's friend, the complainant left his house assuring that they will give it to him when he comes.

After the businessman threatened on the phone, no one was found at home after checking again and Rushil Shah threatened on the phone that you will not get your money, do whatever it takes. After that, when he contacted the house again, he locked the house and left. So the complainant has filed a complaint in the police station.

Suicide due to love affair

Sitting on divider killed: 6 killed, 8 injured in Anand truck-bus accident

Ahmedabad, A fatal accident took place between a luxury bus and a truck going from Maharashtra to Rajasthan on the Ahmedabad-Vadodara Express Highway near Anand early this morning. In which 6 people have died. While 8 people have been injured. Mortality is still likely to rise. According to the information received in this regard, the bus was standing on its side due to burst tire. Then the driver, cleaner and some passengers also got off the bus and sat on the divider. At that time suddenly the truck coming at full speed

rammed the bus from behind and turned on the people sitting on the bus divider. In this incident, 6 people died as they were crushed. While 8 other people have been injured. Local police, fire brigade and 108 team reached the spot after getting information about the accident and the injured were shifted to the hospital for treatment. The injured have been shifted to Anand General Hospital as well as Karamsad Medical Hospital and Hospital in Vadodara, the luxury bus was traveling from Maharashtra to Rajasthan. Ahmedabad-Vadodara Express Highway

crimes including robbery, theft, murder are serving the sentence. But a special diamond unit is run by them inside the jail. What is special about this unit is that people who once committed crimes like theft after falling prey to temptation are now cutting and polishing the most precious diamonds with their own hands. Around 100 inmates are cutting and polishing diamonds daily. In the same way gem artists shape diamonds in the Diamond Unit, these inmates are cutting and polishing diamonds in the unit inside the prison.
