

SIO urges Rahul to address attacks against Muslims

Asks him to take effective steps to stop violence against community

ACTIVISTS of the Students Islamic Organisation (SIO) have written to leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, **Rahul Gandhi**, urging him to intervene in the continuing attacks against Muslims in various parts of North India. The organisation asked Rahul to take "effective steps to stop violence against Muslims that not only tarnish our international reputation but also threaten the very essence of our nation."



heinous acts are not only a gross violation of human rights but also a threat to the secular and democratic fabric of our nation."

"On June 4, a Muslim man was lynched during a cricket match in Gujarat due to dissatisfaction with his performance. This was the sixth lynching incident in a span of just a few weeks. Such incidents reflect a disturbing trend of increasing mob violence fuelled by hate speech and religious intolerance," the letter said.

It added that incidents of mob violence were reported from states like Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Odisha, and Telangana. "The prevalence of such acts is fostering an environment of fear and insecurity among the Muslim community, undermining their sense of belonging and safety in their own country," SIO said.

The organisation asked Ra-

hul to advocate for strict enforcement of laws against hate speech and violence and push for rigorous enforcement of existing laws against hate speech, violence, and discrimination. It also called for the establishment of special fast-track courts to handle cases of mob violence and lynching.

SIO said that the arbitrary bulldozing of houses should be stopped and property rights should be respected. SIO asked Rahul to initiate and support programmes aimed at fostering interfaith dialogue and understanding. Educational campaigns should be launched to promote communal harmony and highlight the dangers of hate speech and violence.

EXPRESS READ AKG Centre attack: Former Youth Congress leader arrested

T'Puram: A former Youth Congress district secretary, who was arraigned as one of the key accused in the crude bomb attack on AKG Centre, was arrested from New Delhi airport on Tuesday morning. Suhail Shajahan, who is considered close to KPCC chief K Sudhakaran, was detained when he arrived from a Gulf country. The police had issued a lookout notice against Suhail. The crime branch had claimed that Suhail was the key conspirator in the case as it was on his insistence that another Youth Congress worker named Jithin hurled crude bombs at the AKG Centre on July 1, 2022. The case was first probed by the local police, which failed to arrest the culprits. It was then that the State Crime Branch was entrusted with the probe.

Don't interfere in Muslim girls' education, MES tells Samastha

THE Muslim Educational Society (MES) on Tuesday slammed Samastha Kerala Jem-Iyyathul Ulama and president Syed Muhammad Jifri Muthukoya Thangal, saying they should refrain from interfering in the education of Muslim girls.

MES president Fazal Gafoor made the remark during a press meet in Malappuram, as a counter to Thangal's recent statement that the education of girls from the community should be within the stipulated limits of the religion.

"A majority of Muslim girls are not under the influence of religious organisations. They are going abroad to pursue higher education. They are not bothered by the advice of the religious organisations. So, it would be pointless for Samastha to interfere in their education," Gafoor said.

Referring to the recent Lok Sabha elections, Gafoor said Samastha was incapable of influencing voters. "One of our opinion polls proved it. We took the opinion of 5,000 students. Of them, just 4.5% said religious organisations are influencing them to take political decisions. Both the LDF and UDF should understand this," Gafoor said.

Gafoor also demanded that the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) be scrapped and the state government conduct an entrance test equivalent to NEET, considering the question paper leak and other misappropriations related to the earlier test.

"The state government should take the same stand as Tamil Nadu CM M K Stalin, and should initiate immediate steps to conduct a medical entrance examination for students in Kerala," Gafoor said. He also urged the government to conduct a caste census, and said the survey should assess the financial status of people. "If any caste gets more than it deserves, it should be revoked," he said.

Aditya-L1 completes 1st 'halo' orbit around L1

ADITYA-L1 - India's maiden mission to the Sun launched on September 2, 2023, has completed its first 'halo' orbit around the Sun-Earth Lagrange 1 point, ISRO announced on Tuesday.

The observatory satellite was inserted into its targeted halo orbit on January 6, 2024. The spacecraft has taken 178 days to complete a revolution around the L1 point, which is 1.5 km from Earth towards the Sun. The orbital plane of the halo orbit is perpendicular to the Earth-Sun axis.

This extraordinary feat and crucial manoeuvre was possible due to the state-of-the-art flight dynamics soft-

ware developed in-house at UR Rao Satellite Centre (URSC) in Bengaluru. This has made the software fully reliable and validated the capability of Aditya-L1 missions.

The spacecraft took a precise three-dimensional trajectory. The final firing of the thrusters on July 2 placed the spacecraft back in the required orbit.

"It underwent two station-keeping manoeuvres on February 22 and June 7, respectively to maintain this orbit. Today's third station-keeping manoeuvre has ensured that its travel continued into the second revolution around the L1 point second halo orbit path around L1," said ISRO in a statement.

Organ harvesting racket did not pay promised compensation to donors

THE donors who fell prey to the recently busted global organ trafficking racket were not paid the promised compensation despite the recipients paying the amounts demanded by the racket, police investigation has revealed.

Kalamassery resident Sajith Shyam, 43 - the third accused in the case - made these startling revelations during the interrogation. He admitted to transferring the funds collected to a medical tourism firm operated by the prime suspect, Madhu Jayakumar, in Kochi. This firm, which posed as a medical tourism enterprise, was a cover for illegal organ transplants, sources with the police confirmed.

Sajith is learnt to have told investigators that donors were



promised up to Rs 6 lakh per organ, but the police found that the racket charged recipients up to Rs 50 lakh in some cases.

While four persons have been arrested so far, Madhu Jayakumar remains at large, according to the police. The investigators have found a broad criminal conspiracy behind the

organ trafficking. Charges of criminal conspiracy have been invoked against the accused.

The police found that Sajith had witnessed the rent agreement for the medical tourism firm, indicating he had prior knowledge of the criminal activities, a source said.

The racket was uncovered with the arrest of Valappad resident Sabith Nasar from Kochi airport on May 19. Sabith confessed to facilitating the travel of 20 Indians to Iran for organ harvesting. His confession led to Sajith's implication in the case. Sajith admitted to acting as an interlink between Madhu and the organ donors. The police found evidence of significant financial transac-

tions, illegally collected from the recipients, and frequent phone calls between Sajith and Madhu.

Sajith and Madhu are childhood friends, with Sajith claiming that Madhu told him he was running a medical business in India and Iran. Some clients could not transfer money directly to Madhu's account, so they transferred it to Sajith who then forwarded it to Madhu. However, the police believe Sajith had prior knowledge of the criminal activities.

It was also discovered that none of the donors received the necessary post-operative care.

The donors were taken to a private hospital in Iran, where they donated organs to matched recipients. They received three days of treatment at the hospital, followed by a 20-day stay in a flat before returning to India.
