**Healthcare services across State hit as doctors join nationwide protest against Kolkata incident**

**HYDERABAD**  
**3 held with hashish oil**

The Rachakonda SOT, along with the Adibatla police, caught three persons who were allegedly transporting hashish oil. The police seized 3.8 kg of hashish oil and three mobile phones from their possession. The arrested were identified as T Sudheer (23), T Demullu (26) and K Shankar Rao (26), of Ankapally in Andhra Pradesh. "The trio planned to sell it in the city to consumers and earn huge profits," said Rachakonda CP, G Sudheer Babu. The trio was remanded.

Outpatient services and elective procedures at all private and government hospitals in Telangana came to a halt on Saturday due to the Indian Medical Association's call for a one-day strike in protest against the rape and murder of a resident doctor in Kolkata. However, the emergency/casualty services ran normally.

With multiple associations, spearheaded by the Indian Medical Association (IMA) Headquarters, deciding to withdraw OP services and elective duties, the nationwide boycott of medical services in hospitals was complete.

For the first time in the State, all major corporate hospitals, including Yashoda Hospitals, Apollo Hospitals, Basavarakam Indo-American Cancer Hospital, Star Hospitals, KIMS-Sunshine Hospitals, AIG Hospitals and even smaller clinics and nursing homes with limited bed-strength, joined the

protests by cancelling OPs and postponing elective surgeries for 24 hours starting 6 am on Saturday. "Today, our doors are closed in honour of a doctor lost to violence. We stand with her and demand justice for her. The emergency medical services are continuing without any hindrance," said senior surgical oncologist, Yashoda Hospital, Dr K Sreekanth. In addition to senior doctors, medicos and senior residents, staff nurses and non-clinical personnel from the Health Department also joined the protests at various government teaching hospitals.

From early Saturday, doctors, nurses and other caregivers at major government teaching hospitals, including Gandhi Hospital, NIMS, Osmania General Hospital, Niloufer Hospital, Chest Hospital, District Hospital in Koti, Maternity Hospitals in Petlaburj and Sultan Bazaar participated in a series of protests and rallies.

The protests and boycott of medical duties in OPs and elective duties are being spear-

headed by the local units of IMA following the nationwide one-day medical strike given by IMA headquarters.

**IDA backs IMA's call**  
Indian Dental Association (IDA) on Saturday extended its support to the Indian Medical Association's nationwide call for a one-day strike in protest against the rape and murder of a resident doctor in Kolkata.

In a statement, the IDA announced the withdrawal of dental services for 24 hours from August 17 to August 18. It said, "It is imperative that the entire nation recognises the gravity of this situation and the pressing need for enhanced protection and respect for all healthcare workers."

IDA Deccan Branch president, Dr KV Ramana Reddy, said, "We are deeply concerned by the inadequate handling of the situation by the college authorities and the state police, as well as the subsequent vandalism and attacks on medical students who were protesting this grave injustice."
