

MEETING OVER WAQF BILL

No injustice will be done, JPC chairman tells scholars

JAGDAMBIKA PAL, the chairman of the Joint Parliamentary Committee on the Waqf (Amendment) Bill 2024, on Tuesday met representatives of the Islamic Centre of India, religious leaders and intellectuals here and assured them that no injustice will be done to waqf. Islamic Centre of India President Maulana Khalid Rashid Farangi Mahali, also a senior executive member of All India Muslim Personal Law Board (AIMPLB), said Pal held a meeting with ulemas, lawyers and intellectuals and sought their suggestions on the Waqf Act (Amendment) Bill. A 20-point memorandum was submitted to Pal on behalf of various organisations, Mahali said. Through the memorandum, they have expressed their opposition to the proposal of giving more powers to district magistrates in the matters of waqf, the inclusion of non-Muslim members in the Waqf Board and the selection of members through nomination instead of election. It was also said that these points are a blatant violation of Articles 14 (equality rights), 25 (rights related to free profession,

practice and propagation of religion), 26 (right of religious institution to manage its own affairs in matters of religion) and 29 of the Constitution.

According to Mahali, JPC Chairman Pal said that he had a discussion with an AIMPLB delegation and he wanted to assure the entire Muslim community that no injustice will be allowed to happen to Waqf.

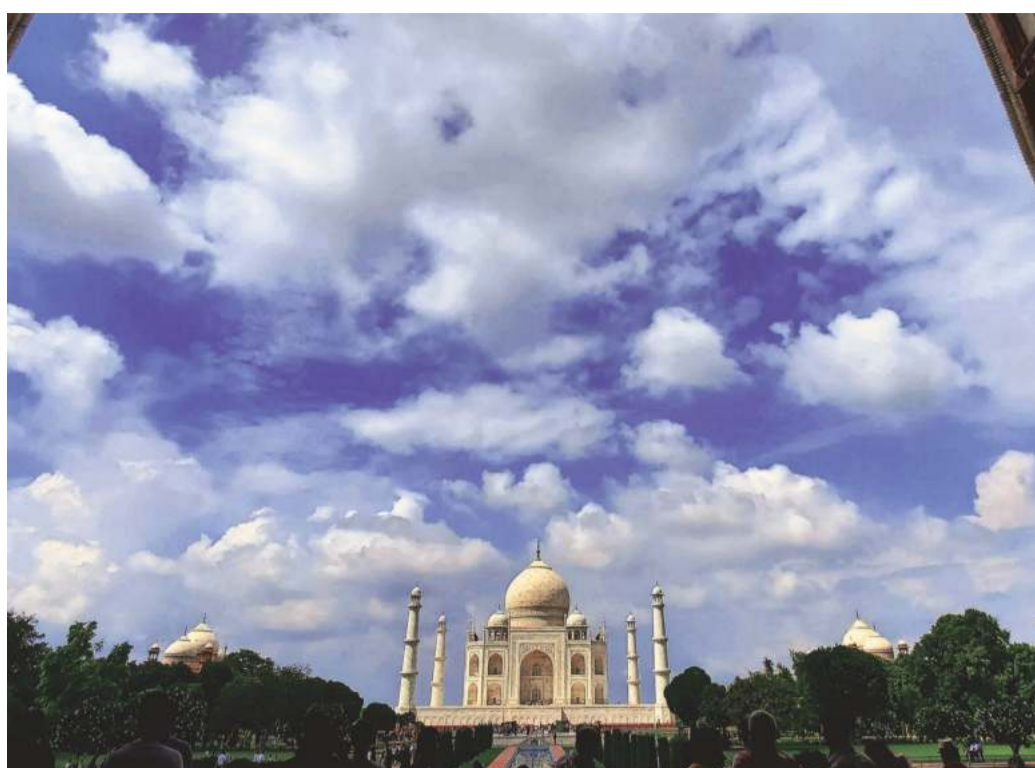
Pal said that through the Bill, efforts will be made to protect Waqf properties, their construction and development, and provide maximum benefit to orphan Muslim children, widowed Muslim women and unemployed, according to Mahali.

Pal said that the suggestions and proposals given during the meeting will be considered by the JPC.

The Waqf amendment Bill seeks to give a bigger say to the government in regulating Waqf properties and seeks to change the composition of Waqf Boards proposing to include non-Muslim members too.

The Opposition strongly opposed the Bill and BJP allies also privately conveyed their unease over the legislation, prompting the government to send it to the JPC.

The JPC will submit its report by the next session of parliament.

Family receives TISS student's body, reason of death still unclear

THE FAMILY of the 29-year-old Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) student Anurag Jaiswal, who died on Sunday morning, received his body after a post-mortem on Monday.

The post-mortem report reserved the cause of death following which the Chembur police will send viscera samples to the Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) for further probe. In the absence of any formal complaint, no FIR has been registered.

According to Chembur senior inspector Pandirath Sawant,

"The post-mortem report was submitted Monday evening. The opinion on the cause of death has been reserved by the doctors. We will have to wait for the FSL report to get clarity."

Jaiswal, a native of Lucknow, was pursuing a postgraduate degree in Human Resources at TISS. After completing his graduation, he was employed for a few years, following which he went for Masters. He had attended a party with friends in Vashi on Friday.

They later returned to a rented apartment. When he didn't wake up the next morning, his roommates took him to a hospital in Chembur, where he was declared dead.

Wolves kill child, injure three others in Bahraich: Forest dept

IN A fresh attack by wolves in Bahraich district, one child was killed and three others were injured, a senior forest department official said on Tuesday.

This incident adds to a series of recent attacks, with five children having fallen victim to wolves in the past month and a half, the official said.

Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) Ajit Pratap Singh said the wolves attacked three children in a village on the intervening night of Monday and Tuesday and by the time the response teams arrived, the wolves had already moved on to another village, where they killed a five-year-old child.

"Our teams have been patrolling over two dozen villages in the Mahsi tehsil of Hardi police station area continuously day and night. Last night, we received inputs

that wolves had attacked three children aged three, six and nine in the Chhattarpur gram panchayat under the Kherighat police station," Singh told PTI.

Singh said before the teams could reach the scene, the wolves had already moved to the nearby village of Raipur, where they attacked and carried away Ayansh, a five-year-old child, from his parents' home.

The child's partially devoured body was found in a nearby field in the early hours of Tuesday, he said, adding that, "the body has been taken into custody for post-mortem examination". He said six children have now died in similar attacks over the past month and a half in the region.

Experts including IFS Akashdeep Badhawan from Barabanki and B Shivshankar from the Katarnighat wildlife division are leading the ongoing efforts to control the situation.

The district magistrate, superintendent of police and senior forest officials are actively patrolling the area.
