

Women panel chief calls for success of 'Poshan Mah'

Importance of pregnant women availing the take-home ration from Anganwadi centres stressed at 7th Rashtriya Poshan Mah-2024 awareness programme; district officials attend

State Women's Commission Chairperson Gajjela Venkata Lakshmi emphasised the importance of pregnant women availing the take-home ration from Anganwadi centres during the '7th Rashtriya Poshan Mah-2024' awareness programme held at the Collector's Sunayana Auditorium here on Thursday.

The event, attended by various officials including Joint Collector B. Navya, aimed to raise awareness about addressing anaemia among women, children and pregnant women.

The National Commission for Women conducts annual meetings to raise awareness about anaemia in women and growth defects in children, highlighting the importance of preg-

nant women receiving TT injections, feeding infants with breast milk, and ensuring children attend Anganwadi schools.

The discussions also highlighted the efforts to ensure the well-being of children at Anganwadi centres and the enactment of various laws by the State and Central governments to support women, espe-

cially in the workplace. The State Women's Commission members thanked the Collector for the support provided to the Women's Commission and the Women's Child Welfare Department.

B. Navya, Joint Collector outlined the efforts made to prevent malnutrition by providing nutritious food through midday meals in schools and distributing iron folic acid tablets to women suffering from anaemia, particularly in project areas with higher prevalence.

Child Welfare Committee Chairman Zubeida Begum highlighted the health risks associated with child marriages and stressed the importance of delaying marriage to ensure the well-being of pregnant women and newborns, as well as the significance of breast milk and nutritious

food provided by Anganwadi centres.

Venkata Lakshmi, an officer of the Women and Child Welfare Department, informed about the upcoming 'Posha Mahotsavam' mandated by the State government to prevent anaemia and nutritional deficiencies in children and women. The programme will feature various awareness programs at the mandal and district levels.

Nutrition kit

A total of 1,886 Anganwadi centres in the district serve approximately 40,000 pregnant women and lactating mothers, and 1,07,000 children, out of which 45,000 are in preschool.

It was also mentioned that pregnant women and lactating mothers would receive a nutrition kit.

Ex-MP flays State govt. for not releasing Tungabhadra water

Former MP and YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) Anantapur district president Anantha Venkatarami Reddy expressed discontent at the State government's inability to supply water to farmers despite having ample water in the Tungabhadra dam.

Following his first visit to Anantapur district after assuming charge as the YSRCP district president, Mr. Reddy was warmly received by the party leaders who gathered at his residence to extend their greetings.

Speaking to the media, Mr. Reddy expressed gratitude to party chief Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy for appointing him as district president and emphasised his commitment to standing with the underprivileged, weaker sections and farmers regardless of being in power or the opposition.

Mr. Reddy criticised the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) government, highlighting a lack of significant action in the three months since assuming office apart from pension disbursements. He pointed out the failure to deliver on election promises and accused the government of engaging in diversion politics, leading to unrest within the YSRCP ranks. He expressed concern over the deteriorating law and order in rural areas.

Mr. Reddy highlighted the dire situation in the agricultural sector, citing an inability to plant seeds on over 5 lakh acres for the current Kharif season in the combined Anantapur district. He stressed on the need for immediate attention to the irrigation issues, pressing for the prompt scheduling of the Irrigation Advisory Board (IAB) meeting to address water allocation and other related matters.

Truck rams into car, kills three at Bhakarapeta ghat

A tomato-laden truck rammed into a car at the Bhakarapeta ghat on the Tirupati-Anantapur national highway, killing three persons on the spot and injuring two. The truck was going from Kalakada to Chennai. The car was reduced to a mangled heap following the accident. Ramesh Murthy (34), Manjunatha (38) and Muni Venkata Reddy (55), who were inside the car perished in the mishap. All of them hailed from Chikkaballapura town in Karnataka. Meanwhile, two others were rescued by onlookers, even as the police reached there.

Pavitrotsavam to begin tomorrow

The major temples under the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) are all set to witness the annual purificatory ritual 'Pavitrotsavam' this week.

Sri Govindaraja Swamy temple in Tirupati will observe the ritual from September 14 to 16, with the initiatory ritual 'Ankurarpanam' on September 13. On the three days, a celestial bath 'Snapanam Tirumanjanam' will be performed to the deities. 'Pavitra Pratishta' will be performed on the first day, 'Pavitra Samarpanam' on the second day and

'Poornahuthi' on the third day.

Similarly, the annual event will be conducted at Sri Padmavati Ammavari temple in Tiruchanur from September 16 to 18, for which the 'Ankurarpanam' will be performed on September 15.

As part of the cleansing ritual, 'Koil Alwar Tirumanjanam' was performed on September 10, where the entire temple precincts were washed and a mixture of aromatic substances smeared on the inner walls. On this occasion, a Hyderabad-based devotee Swarna Kumar Reddy donated 11 curtains to Padmavati Ammavari temple.

Collector urges Housing officials to speed up construction

District Collector T.S. Chetan on Thursday highlighted the need for committed efforts by the authorities in achieving the objectives outlined in the 100-day plan for construction of homes for the underprivileged in Sri Sathya Sai (SSS) district.

Stressing on the State government's prioritisation of this initiative, he urged housing officials, as well as counterparts from other concerned departments, to proactively contribute to this endeavor.

During a review meeting with officials of the Housing Department here, the Collector said that a total of 72,353 houses have been built throughout the district, with approximately 22,756 of these already completed. The remaining houses are expected to be finished by March 2025. Mr. Chetan urged housing officials to conduct regular site visits and put addition-

al efforts to speed up the construction process.

Mr. Chetan sought the officials to engage with the beneficiaries to address any concerns they may have regarding the completion of their homes. The Collector also instructed Housing Department officials to collaborate with their counterparts in other departments to prioritise infrastructure development in the residential areas where construction is under way.

Highlighting the need for cooperation, Mr. Che-

tan emphasised the importance of involvement from departments such as Roads, Panchayat Raj, Rural Water Supply, Municipal, and Electricity to support the construction activities for these houses. He set September 20th as deadline day for the completion of 3,190 houses and called for 100 percent completion of the specified target. The Collector recommended that the concerned officials oversee fieldwork and take necessary measures to ensure the target is attained.
