Russia revokes accreditation of 6 UK diplomats for 'spying'

MOSCOW

Russia has revoked the accreditation of six British diplomats it has accused of spying. The country's security service, FSB, said in a statement it had received documents indicating Britain's involvement in inflicting "a strategic defeat" on Russia. The six diplomats have been named and pictured on Russian state TV. The UK Foreign Office has been approached for comment.

The move coincides with British Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer's arrival in Washington for talks with US President Joe Biden about the war in Ukraine, including whether to give Kyiv permission to fire their missiles at targets inside Russia. Former national security advisor Lord Peter Ricketts said the withdrawal of diplomatic accreditation was a retaliatory punishment for the upcoming meeting in Washington and the UK's continued military support of Ukraine.

"The timing is too coincidental," he told BBC Radio 4's Today programme, describing the allegations levelled at the six diplomats as "trumped up". Lord Ricketts said he was not surprised President Putin took the opportunity to "strike first" in a move to try and "intimidate western politicians". An-

nouncing the decision, the FSB said the diplomats had shown signs of conducting intelligence and were tasked with inflicting a "strategic defeat on our country".

In a Telegram post, Russian

foreign ministry spokeswoman Maria Zakharova said Moscow "fully share the assessments" made by the FSB on the activities of the diplomats. Lord Ricketts said he was not surprised President Putin took the opportunity to "strike first" in a move to try and "intimidate western politicians". Announcing the decision, the FSB said the diplomats had shown signs of conducting intelligence and were tasked with inflicting a "strategic defeat on our country".

In a Telegram post, Russian

foreign ministry spokeswoman Maria Zakharova said Moscow "fully share the assessments" made by the FSB on the activities of the diplomats. An FSB officer told Russian media "hints" to "stop this practice (of gathering intelligence)", were not heeded. The security service added that it would revoke accreditation from more British diplomats if they are found to be involved in similar activity.

'Russia can end war straightaway'

Britain's new Prime Minister Keir Starmer, who is on his first official visit to the White House in Washington, said on Friday that Russia can "end the conflict in Ukraine straightaway". He is in Washington for talks with US President Joe Biden on Friday, as allies of Kyiv discuss giving Ukraine permission to fire their missiles at targets inside Russia. Asked for his response to the remarks on his flight to Washington, the prime minister struck a robust tone repeatedly stating that Russia had started the war. "Russia started this conflict. Russia illegally invaded Ukraine. Russia can end this conflict straightaway," he said. He later added: "To reiterate, it was Russia who started this in the first place. They caused the conflict, they're the ones acting unlawfully."

Trump case denied move to federal court

Imran party lawmakers' remand null and void: CJ

The Islamabad High Court (IHC) on Friday struck down, as null and void, the eight-day remand of several Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) lawmakers. Chief Justice Aamer Farooq termed the FIRs in the incident a "good comedy" and even broke down in laughter, along with the entire court, at one of the charges.

The PTI party lawmakers were arrested following a clash between them and police during a rally

Several PTI leaders were arrested on September 9 after the party's protests in Islamabad after several cases were filed against them including a reported attack on police at Chungi No 26, where PTI workers and security personnel clashed after the former deviated from routes leading to Sangiani, venue of the party's public gathering. An anti-terrorism court on September 10 sent PTI leaders to eight days' custody in connection with the case. As the case came before the high court, Chief Justice Farooq said that whoever wrote the first information report (FIR) should be given credit for writing a good comedy. "Let the state reply to this as to what had happened that remand for eight days was given for each of them," the Chief Justice said.
