

Indian Army's wait for AH-64E Apache attack aircraft from US gets longer amid crashes



INDIA Army's wait for a fleet of highly advanced attack helicopters, AH-64E Apache, developed by American defence and aerospace major Boeing, is likely to get longer in the wake of a few crashes involving the Apache helicopters of the US Army.

The Indian Air Force (IAF) has a fleet of 22 AH-64E Apache attack helicopters, famed for their "unparalleled lethality and survivability". In 2020, Boeing signed an agreement with India to supply six more Apache helicopters for the Army. These were to be delivered in May 2024. The production had begun in 2023.

In March, an AH-64E attack chopper belonging to the 16th Combat Aviation Brigade of the US Army crashed during a routine training exercise. This was the third crash involving the Apache helicopter in just two months. It has to be noted that in 2023, a US Army aviation official had flagged con-

cerns of AH-64E Apaches experiencing electrical power generator failures, leading to "potentially hazardous" conditions as the cockpit would be filled with smoke when such a failure happens.

The Apache helicopters were intended to replace the older Russian Mi-35 attack helicopters in the Indian Army's arsenal. "The advanced technology and proven performance of the AH-64 will enhance the Indian Army's operational readiness and strengthen its defence capabilities," president of Boeing India, Salil Gupte, had said earlier.

Nonetheless, in the wake of these incidents, Boeing has reportedly put on hold new deliveries of AH-64E Apache multi-role combat helicopters until the issues faced by it are completely addressed and validated after tests.

IDRW reports that Boeing is likely to deliver the helicopters only by the end of the year.

Manipur: One dead as ex-CM's house comes under bomb attack, militant links suspected

IN another bomb attack in Manipur on Friday, an elderly man was killed and five others, including a 13-year-old girl, got injured. According to officials, the suspected militants launched the bomb attack on a residential area of Moirang in Bishnupur district.

The rocket struck former chief minister Maibam Koireng's residential compound. According to officials, the rocket seemed to be an improvised one. The bomb fell at a spot just about two kilometres from the INA headquarters.

The officials said that the man, belonging to the Meitei community, died on the spot. "He was preparing for some religious rituals in the compound when the attack took place," said an official.

It was the second rocket that was fired on Friday. Earlier in the day, a rocket was fired at the residential



locality of Tronglaobi, located around 45km from the state capital Imphal.

In the wake of the recent rising drone and gun attacks, hundreds of people across the five districts of the Imphal Valley took out a protest march in Manipur. The

recent drone attacks have resulted in the death of two civilians and around 12 people injured. The protesters criticised the Biren Singh-led government for not properly handling the ongoing conflict in the state. The protest was organised by the


Coordinating Committee on Manipur Integrity (COCOMI). College, and school students, and women of various localities took part in the protest raising slogans condemning the recent attacks in the Koutruk and Senjam Chirang regions.

"The drone and gun attacks on Koutruk and Senjam Chirang were unprovoked and targeted local villagers. Everyone in the country should strongly condemn these acts, and the central government should take appropriate action against the perpetrators," P. Herojit Singh, a youth leader from

Khurai in Imphal East district, told reporters.

The use of the remote-controlled small flying device as a weapon was first noticed in Manipur on September 1 in Koutruk village in the Imphal West district. The recent attacks have created fear and concern among the people in Manipur.

Can't CM Arvind Kejriwal sign remission files from jail?, asks Supreme Court



NEW DELHI : The Supreme Court on Friday asked whether there was any restriction on jailed Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal from signing files for the remission of prisoners.

A bench of Justice Abhay S Oka and Justice Augustine G Masih query came when it came to know the file



of a convict seeking early release is getting delayed due to a signature from the Chief Minister Kejriwal.

The top court sought to know whether there is any restraint order against Arvind Kejriwal for not signing remission files from jail. The top court also noted that

the top court made it clear that they have to place the rule related to it else it can exercise its power under Article 142 of the Constitution of India as it doesn't want to stall such issues. Thereafter the court adjourned the matter.

The top court also said that it will examine whether there is any restraint order on the Chief Minister performing his duties from jail because this will affect hundreds of cases. The Court was hearing the plea by one convict seeking remission.

On May 10, the Delhi Government counsel told the top court that the concerned Board is considering the case of the petitioner for grant of permanent remission.

On July 19 the top court accepted the Delhi Government prayer seeking more time and extended the time granted to the State to take decision by a period of one month. However

Chennai school holds 'spiritual awakening classes' on rebirth; government transfers principal

A government school in Chennai's Ashok Nagar triggered a row after it came to light that a "spiritual awakening" class was held at the school for students on Thursday as part of the Teachers' Day celebration. The session, reportedly organised by the Paramporul Foundation (NGO), had a speaker conduct sessions on "past sins" and "rebirth".

The video of the session, which went viral on social media, shows the speaker, identified as Mahavishnu, making controversial remarks about rebirth and life struggles, though he was reportedly instructed to deliver a lecture on "self-confidence" to the students. The speaker reportedly made remarks suggesting that the students' current lives were shaped by divine forces as a consequence of sins committed in their past lives. One of the teachers objected to the content, which led to a heated argument between the staff member and the speaker. The video of the incident soon went viral, triggering widespread protests from various quarters. Many questioned the Education Department over holding such a session at a government school. SFI and DYFI activists held a protest march against the Education Department. The DMK government immediately embarked on a damage control mode and transferred the principal R. Thamilarasi.

PM Modi interacts with teachers honoured with National Awards

NEW DELHI : Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday interacted with teachers who were conferred with the National Teachers Awards on Teachers' Day.

During his interaction, PM Modi discussed the impact of New Education Policy (NEP) and spoke about teacher's responsibility to prepare today's youth for Viksit Bharat.

According to the press release, PM Modi said that the responsibility of preparing today's youth for Viksit Bharat rests in the hands of teachers. PM discussed the significance of attaining education in one's mother tongue. PM also suggested teachers teach local folklore to students in different languages to help them get introduced to different lan-

guages, the press release stated. PM encouraged teachers to take students on educational tours to explore India's diversity.

Teachers also shared their experience with PM Modi and innovative techniques adopted by them to make learning more interesting, a press release stated.

82 teachers from across the country were conferred with the award by President Droupadi Murmu on September 5. Addressing the gathering, the President said that teachers have to prepare such citizens who are not only educated but also sensitive, honest and enterprising. She stated that moving ahead in life is success, but the meaning of life lies in working for the welfare of others.

Gujarat CM Bhupendra Patel introduces planning regulations for gaming zones prioritising public safety

GANDHINAGAR : Following the growing trend of gaming activities as venues for recreation and leisure, Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel has introduced planning regulation of gaming activity areas in the Comprehensive General Development Control Regulations (CGDCR) as large crowds that often gather at game zones, said an official statement from CMO. Considering public safety, security, and welfare, the CM has made a significant decision to incorporate crucial provisions, and separate planning regulations have been established for gaming activity areas within commercial constructions and dedicated gaming zones, added the statement.

CM Bhupendra Patel has introduced provisions in the CGDCR that include detailed regulations for the construction of gaming activity areas. These regulations address road width, minimum area, building height, parking, safety measures, and the various types of required NOCs (No Objection Certificates), as mentioned in the statement. Additionally, for independent gaming activity plots, specific provisions have been made to prioritise public safety, such as separate entry and exit points, emergency exits, and designated refuge areas. It has been specifically stated that at gaming activity sites, the BU (Building Use) certificate, fire NOC, and all other required licenses, certificates, NOCs, and permits must be prominently displayed, read the statement further. The new regulation mandates that revised permission, in line with the updated guidelines, must be acquired before commencing.
