

# Forest dept set to lay trap to catch elusive leopard

### Secures nod from chief wildlife warden to use cage to trap wild cat

MUCH to the relief of residents living near the forest areas in the district, the forest department has deployed a trap to capture the leopard that has been instilling fear in the community for the past few months. The forest department has secured permission from the Chief Wildlife Warden and is now prepared to use the cage as a trap to capture the leopard. The cage was brought from Wayanad and was inspected by a veterinarian.

A forest officer said, "We are all set to lay a trap to catch the leopard. For this purpose, a special committee has been formed. The cage will be kept in the place where the animal is spotted again. The leopard was sighted in one of the camera traps, and many residents have seen it."

The trap cage will undoubtedly bring relief to the residents of the area, as the presence of the leopard is giving sleepless nights to them. Although they have previously dealt with attacks from wild elephants and boars, the sighting of a leopard has heightened their concerns. Many people are also concerned that the leopard may soon target livestock and potentially humans. According to residents, there was a sharp decline in the number of dogs in these pan-

chayats, which also signals the presence of a leopard in the area. Leopard sightings have been reported in several grama panchayats in Kasaragod, including Muliya, Delampady, and Karadka, as they are located near the Karnataka forest, making them vulnerable to wild animal incursions.

A forest officer stated that they are actively searching for new sightings of the leopard to determine the best location to lay the trap. While they have received several reports of leopard sightings from different

areas, there is no conclusive evidence regarding its exact location.

The footprints found near the human settlement have been conclusively identified as those of a leopard, and several travelers have reported spotting the leopard in various locations within the panchayats on the forest fringes. All reported sightings and incidents involving the leopard have taken place at night, with no further evidence of the animal's presence in residential areas during the day.

Collector Arun K Vijayan has directed the authorities concerned to probe and submit a report on the complaint that alleged garbage is being brought in lorries and dumped in the red laterite stone quarries in the district. He gave the instructions to the joint director of the local self-government department at the meeting of the district-level executive committee of the Malinya Muktam Na-

vakeralam public campaign, which will begin on October 2.

A meeting will be convened under the chairmanship of the collector regarding the issue of waste management and stray cattle in the Kannur corporation. District panchayat president P P Divya, who presided over the meeting, suggested that the use of single-use glasses and plates should be completely avoided in the district.

# 'Fake cases and jails not new for Communist movement'

CPM state committee member P Jayarajan on Monday said fake cases were not new for the party. "Fake cases and jail are not new to the Communist movement. The Communist party has been accused of conspiracy since its inception," he said during the Azhikodeon Raghavan commemoration event.

"There is no room to believe that CPM can be intimidated through such cases of conspiracy. People will be mobilised and this move against the party will be defeated," said P Jayarajan, who is facing conspiracy charges in the 2012 Ariyil Shukoor murder case.

In her address, senior CPM leader P K Sreemathi criticised Nilambur MLA P V Anvar for "trying to weaken the party".

"The party should not be left to the enemies. CPM is the par-

ty of the poor and the common people. Steps that weaken it should not be taken by anyone," she said.

Meanwhile, CPM Kannur district secretary M V Jayarajan slammed retired DySP Sukumaran, who investigated several high-profile cases, including Shukoor's murder, for joining the BJP. He accused Sukumaran of framing CPM leaders in false cases, while serving in the force.

Taking a dig at the retired cop, M V Jayarajan said, "Retired DySP Sukumaran, notorious for using third-degree torture, has finally found his place in the most fitting party."

He has a criminal background, having tortured numerous DYFI workers and falsely implicated innocents. When he could not prove cases, he resorted to brutal torture. He misused his position to target political opponents."

The hospital authorities informed the Hosdurg police when they realised that the girl, whom they understood is a minor, was

sexually assaulted. Police said, "During questioning, the girl revealed that she was sexually assaulted by her boyfriend, and added that she had also been abused by her father when she was in Class VII. The girl has been living with her mother ever since her parents got separated." Based on the incident, the police charged Pocco cases against the girl's male friend and father.
