

Traffic diversions at Khairatabad

Curbs are in view of the Khairatabad Ganesh festival, which begin today and end with the idol immersion on September 17; event likely to draw thousands of people daily; police advise devotees to take NTR Marg and park near IMAX Rotary and at new Ambedkar statue

In anticipation of the massive influx of devotees during the 10-day Khairatabad Ganesh festival, the Hyderabad Traffic Police have issued a traffic advisory notifying diversions and restrictions.

The festival, beginning on September 7 and culminating with the immersion of the idol on September 17, is expected to draw thousands daily. Diversions are in place to ensure smooth flow of traffic, said the Additional Commissioner (Traffic) P. Viswa Prasad. "For better parking of vehicles, commuters visiting Khairatabad Ganesh are advised to take the NTR Marg and park near IMAX Rotary and at the new Ambedkar statue," he said.

To manage the expected traffic congestion, the police have announced several traffic diversions and parking restrictions. Key traffic points, including Khairatabad Junction, Shadan College, Nirankari, Old PS Saifabad, Mint Compound and Necklace Rotary, are likely to experience heavy traffic.

Diversion to Iqbal Minar
"Vehicles approaching Mint Compound from V.V. Statue will be diverted at Rajiv Gandhi Statue towards Nirankari Junction. Traffic from Old PS Saifabad towards Bada Ganesh via Rajdoot Lane will be redirected towards Iqbal Minar. Vehicles from Iqbal

Ponds made ready for nimajjanam

The Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) has readied various kinds of immersion ponds in preparation for the final day of Ganesh Navaratri festivities. The ponds have been kept ready at 73 locations, according to a statement.

Of these, 27 are 'baby ponds' inside the lakes, 24 are portable ponds and 22 are excavated ponds, which will facilitate immersion of idols of two to five feet in size. The GHMC has also taken initiative to dis-

tribute 3.1 lakh clay Ganesh idols, which are environment friendly. Tree trimming and pothole filling were taken up ahead of the procession on the final day. GHMC Commissioner Amrapali Kata has issued instructions towards ensuring functioning of all streetlights and better management of sanitation.

One sanitation team has been deployed every kilometre to ensure sanitation and removal of garbage. Drinking water, mobile toilets and cranes have been organised at all sites of immersion, the note said.

Minar heading towards Mint Compound will be diverted at Mint Lane Entrance towards Telugu Talli junction. Traffic from NTR Marg/Khairatabad Flyover/Necklace Road towards Mint Compound will be diverted at Necklace Rotary towards Telugu Talli junction or Khairatabad flyover," reads the advisory.

Similarly, vehicles from Nirankari via Khairatabad Post Office Lane towards Khairatabad Railway gate will be diverted at Post Office towards Old PS Saifabad junction.

Visitors approaching Khairatabad Ganesh through Necklace Rotary

and NTR Garden should park their vehicles at Ambedkar Square parking place beside IMAX Theatre, NTR Garden parking places, opposite IMAX, Saraswathi Vidya Mandir High School premises, and Race course Road parking place. Visitors coming on their own vehicles for *darshan* should avoid Khairatabad Rajiv Gandhi Statue Road and Rajdoot Lane road.

Police seek cooperation
The police urged devotees to cooperate with the traffic police and follow the advisory. For any emergencies, commuters can

contact the traffic helpline at 9010203626. Meanwhile, the idol movements in the city will not be an issue for commuters from September 7, said a traffic official from South

Zone. "For the last 15 days, we deployed 100 policemen on night bandobast to ensure that the idols are moved overnight" said the officer, adding that traffic police personnel will be

deployed at all junctions to regulate the flow. Another officer from the Humayun Nagar traffic said that 80% sale of idols are done and the remaining are likely to be done by Saturday.

Water mixed with sewage being released into Kapra lake: residents

Officials from the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) are allegedly releasing rainwater mixed with sewage into Kapra Lake to facilitate Ganesh idol immersion, the rebby undoing a great deal of effort and investments towards sewage diversion.

Multiple residents of Sainikpuri and Kapra localities alleged that the municipal authorities are trying to ensure a sufficient amount of water in the lake by diverting rainwater mixed with untreated sewage into it. "The lake was nearly dry a couple of days ago, but now it is filled to the brim. It is not fresh water, as can be made out from the stench," said Ramana Reddy, a resident.

A number of residents alleged that sewage mixed flows have been diverted into the lake to facilitate the immersion of Ganesh idols. Kapra Lake was rejuvenated with the efforts

of a group of volunteers from Sainikpuri and other areas. Manognya Reddy, a volunteer from the Kapra Lake Revival Group, was witness to an inspection by GHMC officials, the area's legislator and Ganesh Utsav Committee members a few days ago. Within no time after the inspection, the lake was filled up from one-fourth of its capacity to three-fourths, she said.

Kapra Lake receives its inflows from the surplus

channel of the Nagireddy Kunta in Yapral, apart from the road run-off from Eshwaripur colony and other localities nearby.

The natural inflow channel of the lake was blocked by rampant construction activities, and owing to sewage flows, the lake had become a cesspool. Under the Strategic Nala Development Project, box drain works were taken up from Nagireddy Kunta a couple of years ago to revive the

lake. "The plan was to build a sedimentation dam, after which the water would undergo remediation process before entering the lake," Ms. Reddy explained.

While the box drain from Nagireddy Kunta is stuck midway due to issues of 'right of way' towards Yapral, construction of the sedimentation dam with a filter bed of rocks has been completed. Remediation process, however, is yet to begin. "To fill the lake, now the officials have got a temporary channel dug from the half-done box drain, to divert the flows directly into the lake without treatment," Ms. Reddy said. After the visit by GHMC officials, the filter bed, too, was removed.

"Sainikpuri area has a good network of stormwater drains. All they had to do was to connect it to the lake for it to be filled with fresh rainwater," alleged Ms. Reddy. GHMC officials could not be contacted for comments.

EAPCET, NEET, JEE coaching for govt. junior college students

The government on Friday accorded permission to the Department of Higher Education for conducting coaching classes to students of government junior colleges in the State.

According to the order issued by Principal Secretary (Education) Burra Venkatesham, coaching classes will be conducted

for Engineering Agricultural and Pharmacy Common Entrance Test (EAPCET), National Eligibility Common Entrance Test (NEET), and Joint Entrance Examination (JEE). The classes will begin in the current academic year.

Meanwhile, as per an order issued last week, the government decided to form an Academic Guidance, Training and Placement Cell with specific

roles and job chart and work allocation for each wing. Under academic guidance, officials will prepare the academic calendar and conduct the annual academic audit. The roles also include maintaining college-wise database of staff, students and courses; and monitoring of introduction of new courses, combinations, curriculum and content preparation.
