



Bus operators oppose NHA's plan to decongest Edakkad rail gate

Association reiterates demand for the construction of an underpass at the Nadal railway gate as it is essential for smoother and efficient operations

THE private bus association has strongly opposed a new traffic management plan introduced by National Highway Authority of India (NHA) to address congestion at the Edakkad Nadal railway gate in Kannur.

Earlier, private bus operators running on the Kannur-Thalassery route launched an indefinite strike, protesting delays caused by existing traffic restrictions imposed by the NH authorities.

The association has reiterated its demand for the construction of an underpass at the Nadal railway gate, arguing that it is essential for smoother and more efficient operations.

Under the current NH construction plan, buses and large vehicles crossing the Nadal railway gate via Kannur-Thot-

'Arrangement not feasible'

Under the current NH plan, buses and large vehicles crossing the Nadal railway gate via Kannur-Thottada toward Thalassery must take a 3.5-km detour. They are required to loop back toward Kannur, use the Chalampalam underpass, and then re-enter the service road leading to Thalassery.



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The private bus association has said that the new arrangement is not feasible. Instead, they are pressing for an underpass near the OK UP School, which is located immediately after the Nadal

railway gate.

Following the strike, a high-level meeting led by minister Kadannappalli Ramachandran discussed possible adjustments to the NH authorities' plan and demanded an alternative solution. However, both the public and private bus operators remain skeptical about the revised traffic improvement measures proposed by the NH authorities.

According to the latest updates, buses approaching the Nadal railway gate will need to

take the Kannur-side service road up to the Edakkad underpass before switching to the Thalassery service road. Return journeys will involve entering the highway at Muzhappilangad panchayat office and rejoining the service road near the Edakkad petrol pump.

Residents have raised safety concerns about diverting traffic onto the expressway, particularly regarding potential risks of accidents.

Another significant issue is passenger inconvenience. For example, if buses travelling to-

ward Kannur are diverted onto the elevated highway, passengers from Edakkad town heading to Kannur would find it difficult to board the bus.

Although an underpass near the Nadal railway gate provides access to the Thalassery service road via the Urpazhassikkav Temple Road, its limited size only accommodates mini-buses and small vehicles. Kannur Private Bus Owners Association representative Raj Kumar told TNE that they would never approve NH's plan, and would go for extensive protests.

Miscreants steal, damage ₹25,000 flagpole ahead of CPM meet

THE theft of the flagpole, CPM had readied for its three-day Kasaragod area conference, on the day of the event's inauguration on Monday took the party by surprise. Adding insult to injury, the flagpole was found damaged on a vacant plot in the evening.

The theft is believed to have occurred post lam, after the workers gave final touches to the flagpole, covered it with a tarpaulin and left. Made of wood, the flagpole cost around ₹25,000. The workers had written the entire history of the party congress on the flagpole.

"After finishing the work, we had kept the flagpole at a party member's house in Kudulu on Sunday night. The theft came to light around 6am. We had been working on the flagpole for two weeks. We have filed a complaint with the police," said CPM Kudulu local secretary Bhujangu Shetty.

Elephant herd terrorising Kallapalli residents

DESPITE various measures adopted by the forest department, wild elephants continue to wreak havoc on farms of Kallapalli residents in the Panathady grama panchayat. A herd of six wild elephants has been terrorising Kallapalli for the past three days. The elephants have ventured into human set-

tlements causing widespread damage to crops, thereby affecting the livelihood of residents.

Radhakrishna Gowda, a member of Panathady grama panchayat, said, "For the past three days the herd of elephants has been camping near the human habitat. On the first day, they destroyed crops belonging to three farmers. A solar fence is constructed near

the border, but the elephant enters through it. Elephants destroyed crops, including rubber trees, coconut palms, black pepper, teak, and cashew seedlings."

The village's proximity to reserve forest, which seamlessly merges with the Karnataka forest, creates an ideal sanctuary for elephants. The presence of a calf in the herd makes it more

dangerous. These elephants typically approach the village at night and retreat before dawn.

Radhakrishna expressed concern that the wild elephant herd could return to the village as it is camping in the reserve forest close to human habitations. The presence of elephant corridors near the forest border is a primary factor contributing to their incursion into human settlements.
