

# Ramadoss slams delay in probe into Vengaivayal issue

PMK founder Dr S Ramados on Thursday criticised the lack of progress in the Vengaivayal incident in Pudukottai district, where human excreta were found in a drinking water tank in a Dalit settlement two years ago.

Addressing the press Ramados said, "The police have not identified the culprits even after two years. Though the case was handed over to the CB-CID, and DNA tests were conducted on 31 people along with voice sample analyses of three others, the culprits remain at large. The Madras High Court has also questioned the delay in filing a chargesheet, but the police have yet to respond," he said.

He further urged the state to reintroduce the 10.5% internal reservation for Vanniyaars. He highlighted that the Backward Classes Commission, formed two years ago, has not yet submitted its recommendations.

"The state government should table a bill reinstating the reservation during the Tamil Nadu Assembly session

on January 6," he added. Highlighting Union Home Minister Amit Shah's recent remarks on BR Ambedkar, Ramados said, "PMK is the only party in India to uphold Ambedkar's principles. The DMK, which claims to honour Ambedkar, has done nothing significant for." He demanded that the government name prominent infrastructure projects, such as the Guindy Hospital and Koyambedu Bus Terminal, after Ambedkar.

Commenting on the recent sexual harassment incident at Anna University, he said, "The Tamil Nadu government should be ashamed of the lack of safety for female students. While one suspect has been arrested, authorities must investigate others involved and take action against those responsible for security lapses at the university. The government must ensure the safety of female students in all universities across the state."

Ramados pointed out that Tamil Nadu's capital expenditure for the first six months of the 2024-25 financial year dropped by 8.4% compared to the previous year.

# Pallava-era Vinayagar sculpture found in V'puram

A Vinayagar stone sculpture with inscriptions, believed to date back to the Pallava era, was discovered in Edhanemili near Tindivanam on Wednesday.

Based on information provided by local resident Sibi Chakravarthy, a team comprising assistant professor D Ramesh from the History Department of Aringar Anna Government Arts College in Villupuram, members of Villupuram History Research Centre, Tamil teacher Kamalakkannan and students found the sculpture in a spinney along the village's tank bund.

## 'No improvement in fishermen's life since Tsunami'

PUDUCHERRY: ON the 20th Tsunami Memorial Day, AIADMK Puducherry State Secretary A Anbalagan voiced strong criticism of successive governments for their failure to improve the quality of life for the fishing community. Addressing reporters, he said that even after two decades since the tsunami, fishermen's livelihoods remain in jeopardy. "There has been no dedicated budget allocation or relief plans tailored for their welfare," he said. The AIADMK leader reiterated the demand for a 7% reservation for the fishing community in education and employment, expressing disappointment over the current 2% internal reservation. ENS

The sculpture, carved in relief method, measures 89 cm in height and 85 cm in width. Ramesh said, "The deity is depicted seated in the padmasana posture with both legs folded. However, the identity of the weapons held in the four arms remains unclear. The sculpture features an ornate crown, a third eye on the forehead, and is depicted as Mukkan Vinayagar with a broken tusk on the left side. The trunk curves to the left, portraying Idampuri Vinayagar. A waistband is also



visible." Further, he said the inscription, engraved vertically

on the right side of the sculpture, read, "Ullgalam Kallar Uzhuthira Saiyaaru kottivicha padimam," (this Vinayagar sculpture was created by Kallat Uzhuthira Saiyaaru of the Ullgalam).

Based on the style of the inscriptions, senior epigraphist S Rajagopal has dated the sculpture to the 7th century CE (Common Era).

"Besides, a broken pedestal of a nandi (bull) was also found, suggesting that a Shiva temple might have existed in the area during the Pallava period but was later destroyed," added Ramesh.

# PERIYAKUPPAM Trio harasses two women, attacks family at beach, held

THREE men were arrested for allegedly harassing women at Periyakuppam beach near Chidambaram on Tuesday evening.

The Pudhuchathiram police said a family from Kurinjipadi, including children and women, had visited the beach. While they were at the beach, four men in an inebriated state misbehaved with them.

The family members, including the women, objected to their behaviour, which led to an altercation. The men allegedly assaulted both the women and other family members. The family then escaped the scene with the children. A video of the incident surfaced on social media on Wednesday.

"Based on a complaint of one of the victims, a case was registered under multiple sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) 2023 and the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act," said police source.

The suspects were identified as M Dinesh (21), Manikavel (25), and Saravanan (24) from Lenin Nagar, Thiyagavalli village.

"Efforts are being made to apprehend the fourth suspect," a police official said.

# Farmers stage protest seeking flood relief

A total of 175 farmers, including Tamil Nadu All Farmers Associations Coordination Committee Chairman PR Pandian, were detained on Thursday for staging a protest in Kattumannarkoil without prior police permission. The farmers had been demanding relief for those affected by the recent floods.

The protest was organised to urge the state government to utilise satellite imagery to identify flood-hit villages impacted by the heavy rainfall on December 12 and the overflow of Veeranam Lake. The protesters demanded disaster relief funds and sought ₹30,000 per acre as compensation. The farmers were detained in a private mar-
