

Faecal contamination found in drinking water in Taliparamba

Health department is planning to extend jaundice source inspections to entire district

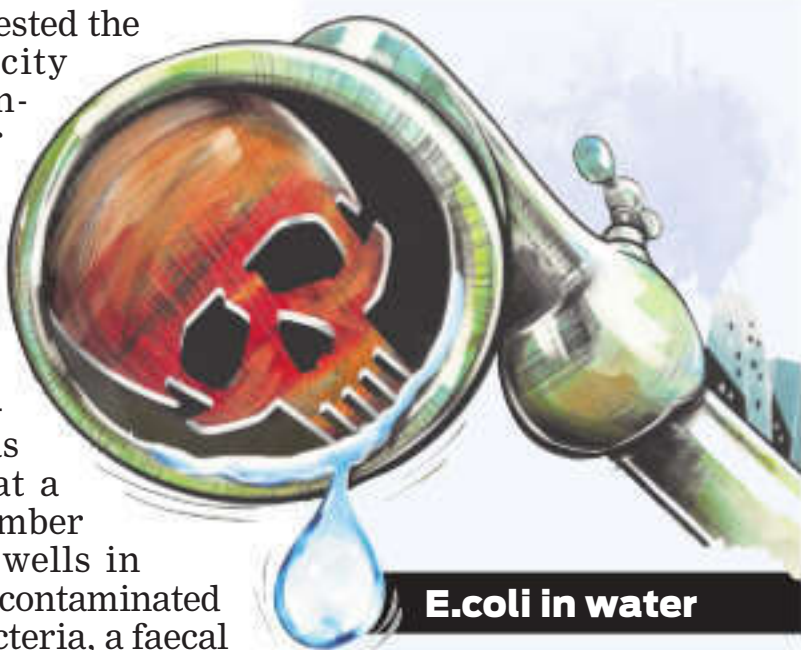
AN investigation by the Taliparamba municipality health department and the district health authorities has revealed the presence of faecal contamination in seized drinking water supplies in Taliparamba. The health department is now planning to extend its jaundice source inspections to the entire district. In the wake of the ongoing jaundice outbreak, health officials have intensified efforts with inspections and awareness campaigns to curb the spread of the disease.

Health inspectors, junior public health nurses, and ASHA workers conducted home visits to approximately 400 residences across nine wards where jaundice cases were reported. Preventive measures were communicated to households with confirmed cases. In addition, the health depart-

ment has requested the Taliparamba city council to inspect the water supplied by five other agencies within its jurisdiction.

The ongoing jaundice investigation has uncovered that a significant number of household wells in the district are contaminated with E. coli bacteria, a faecal indicator.

The contamination is largely due to poorly planned water and septic tank systems in many homes, with wells often located too close to septic tanks. The health department has stressed that this situation poses a major public health risk, particularly in the spread of liver diseases such as jaundice.

Alarmingly, even wells situated as far as 20 metres from septic tanks showed E. coli contamination.

To address the issue, the health department will observe chlorination week from January 1 to 7, 2025, with a focus on chlorinating drinking water sources. The department urges residents to participate in purifying their household and public wells.

In a related development, drinking water from a supplier named Jafar, distributed in Taliparamba municipality, was tested on December 19 at the Kerala Water Authority's lab, revealing the presence of E. coli.

Jafar supplies water to many hotels, restaurants, and food vendors in Taliparamba, as well as a private school at 7th Mile, where a jaundice outbreak was reported a month later.

Mission anganwadi rolling in rapid phase

MISSION Anganwadi, the current initiative undertaken by the Kasaragod development package (KDP), is actively engaged in a comprehensive search to identify suitable land for the establishment of anganwadi, which have been working in rental buildings. Currently, 1,201 anganwadis in the district have the advantage of operating on their own lands and in their own buildings, out of a total of 1,348 anganwadis. Apart from that, 21 anganwadis have successfully acquired the land and resources needed for construction and are fully prepared to begin building their own dedicated premises soon.

Chandran V, special officer of KDP, said, "The main challenge we face is the unavailability of lands in urban areas. A

minimum of three cents of land is needed to construct an anganwadi. KDP has made it its mission to provide its own buildings to anganwadis and has allocated around 15 crores for anganwadis. We are planning to complete the mission by next year."

A detailed project report (DPR) for 33 anganwadis is yet to be prepared. Additionally, 24 Anganwadis are in various stages of obtaining construction approval from the Women & Child Development Department, while 10 anganwadis are currently under construction with support from local self-

government departments. The inauguration of new buildings for 5 anganwadis is scheduled for December 26. 54 anganwadis are still in need of land.

Chandran V indicated that 10 of the 54 anganwadis currently without land have successfully overcome their land-related obstacles. He expressed confidence in the swift resolution of the remaining 10 land-related challenges. Once the land issues for the remaining 34 anganwadis are resolved, Kasaragod will become the first district in the country, where all anganwadis have their own land and buildings. A substantial number of anganwadis requiring land falls under the jurisdiction of the Kasaragod Municipality. The acquisition of land within these areas presents considerable challenges due to high land prices and limited availability.

THE Kasaragod Additional District Sessions Court has found six individuals guilty of the brutal murder of Abdul Salam (27), a resident of Peral. The victim was killed and decapitated in a field near Maliyankara Port in Kumbia, within the jurisdiction of the Kumbia police station. The court will announce the sentence for the convicted individuals on Monday.

The incident happened on April 30, 2017. Naushad (28), who was with Abdul Salam, was stabbed and injured in the attack. Salam's head was discovered some distance away from the location where his body and Naushad were found stabbed and lying on the ground. There was a distance of around 30 metres between the severed head



and the body. The accused were identified as Siddique, alias Mangamudi Siddique (39), of Badria Nagar, Kumbia, Umar Farooq (29) of Badria Nagar, Saheer (32) of Pervadu, Niaz (31) of Peral, Latif (36) of Pervadu and Harish (29) of Bombrana, Arikkadi. The investigation was led by the then Kumbia Inspector and current Bekal DYSP V V Manoj and SI Jayashankar. Special Squad members Balakrishnan and Narayan were also in the investigation team. The charge sheet was submitted within 90

days, and the accused were arrested from their hiding. G Chandramohan and Chitrakala appeared for the prosecution. V V Manoj said, "The murder happened based on the incident in which police seized the lorry of Siddique, which was carrying sand, suspecting Salam of being the informant. Siddique later gave a statement to the police that he killed Salam in revenge of him entering his house and threatening him and his mother. The enmity over this led to the murder of Abdul Salam. Salam and the injured

Naushad were tactfully summoned to the Maliyankara Fort by the six accused and murdered him."

The accused tried to burn their bloodstained clothes and weapons after the murder near a cremation ground in Kundankaradka. But the police were successful in recovering both weapons and clothes, which helped them strengthen the evidence. The results of their scientific examination were also against the accused. Naushad's statement also was crucial in the investigation.



Hemant Soren leaves Bekal after 4-day stay

Kasaragod: Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren left for his home state after visiting Bekal on Saturday. Originally planned as a three-day trip, Soren's stay was extended by a day. He stayed at the Taj Hotel, which is part of the Bekal Resorts Development Corporation (BRDC) project. He also had a houseboat ride on Vallyaparamba lake. Soren praised the beauty of Kerala and the peaceful co-existence of people here. BRDC managing director Shijin Parambath presented a traditional Kerala gift to Soren. The Jharkhand chief minister also held talks with Tourism Minister Mohamed Riyas and invited him to his state.

Haj house to be set up near Knr airport
