

# Protests in V'puram against Shah's remarks

Protesters highlighted the need to safeguard Ambedkar's ideals and urged the union government to issue clarification

MEMBERS of the DMK, and various civil society organisations staged a protest on Thursday, condemning Union Home Minister Amit Shah's recent remarks on Dr B R Ambedkar in the parliament. The protesters voiced their displeasure, accusing Shah of distorting Ambedkar's legacy.

Villupuram MLA Dr R Lakshmanan along with former Kallakurichi MP and DMK District Secretary Gautham Sigamani washed and garlanded the statue of Ambedkar near Kalaingar Arivalayam, followed by a protest, raising slogans against Amit Shah.

Subsequently, in the evening, MAP study circle members

held a protest, highlighting Ambedkar's contributions to India's democracy and social justice. The DMK leaders and

civil rights activists who led the protest asserted that Shah's remarks were an attempt to misinterpret Ambedkar's ide-

ology for political gains.

Addressing the gathering, MAP study circle secretary M Ramamoorthy said, "Dr Ambedkar dedicated his life ensuring social equality and justice. Any attempt to manipulate his legacy will not be tolerated. This is an insult to the values he upheld." Speakers highlighted the importance of safeguarding Ambedkar's ideals and called for the union government to issue a clarification on the minister's statement. They urged political leaders to refrain from politicising historical figures for narrow agendas. The peaceful demonstration concluded with a call for unity among those fighting for social justice. The protest was monitored by local police to prevent any untoward incidents.

## Demonstration leads to roadblocks in Puducherry

Puducherry: Members of the DMK and VCK staged protests in Puducherry on Thursday condemning Union Home Minister Amit Shah's alleged derogatory remarks on Dr B R Ambedkar in the Parliament. DMK state organiser and opposition leader R Siva led the protest held in front of the Ambedkar Memorial on Beach Road. DMK MLAs Annibal Kennedy, L Sambath, R Senthil Kumar, and other party functionaries participated. Protesters held portraits of Ambedkar and raised slogans against the central government and Amit Shah. At Indira Gandhi Square, VCK members, led by the party's principal secretary Deva Pozhilan, blocked roads connecting Cuddalore, ENS



## Narayanasamy says Pondy government may fall soon

CITING the alleged retraction of support for the ruling alliance by three BJP MLAs and a few independents, former chief minister and senior Congress leader V Narayanasamy claimed the Ranganasamy-led Puducherry government has lost its majority and may collapse soon.

Speaking at a press briefing at his residence on Thursday, Narayanasamy said, "Only 13 MLAs - 10 AINRC MLAs and three BJP MLAs - support the ruling alliance, including the ministers and the Speaker." He claimed that the government lost its majority and that the chief minister, taking responsibility, should resign, otherwise it might collapse.

When asked about an independent MLA's petition for a no-confidence motion against Assembly Speaker R Selvam, Narayanasamy said, "Speaker Selvam acts like a BJP member and participates in their activities. He is unfit to hold the position of the Speaker."

On the 'One Nation, One Election' Bill, he said the BJP lacks the required number of parliamentarians to pass it, as a two-thirds support is needed. "They are introducing the Bill to divert attention from Adani-related issues," he alleged. Criticising the government's handling of distributing cyclone relief, Narayanasamy said many people had not yet received the ₹5,000 relief, which he termed "inadequate".

He said, "The government also failed to provide relief to farmers, fishermen, and the people whose houses were damaged."

He accused the government of not pressurising the centre to allocate funds for relief, saying the CM and the ministers have "failed in their responsibilities".

## Send all-party team to Delhi for Fengal relief: Ramadoss

PMK founder Dr S Ramadoss urged Tamil Nadu Chief Minister to lead an all-party delegation to Delhi to meet the Prime Minister and Union Home Minister to demand cyclone relief for areas affected by Cyclone Fengal. Speaking at a presser at his house in Thailapuram near Tindivanam in Villupuram on Thursday, Ramadoss highlighted the lack of action by the central government.

"Even 10 days after the cyclone-affected areas in districts, no report has been submitted to the union government, and funds have not been allocated," he said. He pointed out that the ₹945 crore, granted to Tamil Nadu so far, was drawn

from the state disaster relief fund. Ramadoss emphasised the plight of farmers, stating that the current allocation of ₹ 6,800 per acre for paddy farmers was insufficient, as cultivation costs approximately ₹30,000 per acre. "The Tamil Nadu government must provide ₹40,000 per acre as relief from its funds," he demanded.

Ramadoss criticised the DMK government, saying, "The DMK came to power promising to make Tamil Nadu a premier state but has now become a leading state in debt. Tamil Nadu has borrowed ₹8.34 lakh crore as of March 2024, making it the top debtor state in India. It also pays ₹54,676 crore annually in interest, the highest in the country."

## CBI probe sought into Uppanar drainage work

THE AIADMK organised a protest near the Uppanar drainage canal on Thursday demanding a CBI investigation into the alleged corruption pertaining to the canal's construction and urging the Puducherry government to expedite the construction of a flyover project over the main drainage canal.

The protest, which was staged following a directive from the party's general secretary, Edappadi K Palaniswami, was presided over by AIADMK Puducherry State Secretary A Anbalagan. Addressing the gathering, Anbalagan said, "In 2006, the then-government made an ill-advised decision to construct a flyover over the main drainage canal to alleviate traffic congestion in Puducherry city. The foundation stone was laid on November 9, 2006, at a cost of ₹27 crore without

obtaining the finance department. The work was abandoned halfway through after spending ₹8.92 crore."

He alleged that tenders were repeatedly floated during subsequent regimes, and construction was stopped midway for various reasons. Contractors often sought arbitration, resulting in multiple compensation payouts. "The project, which began with a budget of ₹27 crore, has now escalated to nearly ₹95 crore. Of this, ₹68 crore has been disbursed as com-

ensation to contractors over time. This systemic corruption has resulted in significant financial losses to the public," he said.

Anbalagan blamed the 2017 Congress-DMK coalition government led by former Chief Minister Narayanasamy for the corruption. "This scandal involves officials from the Public Works Department and corrupt politicians. Despite being aware of these irregularities, the then Lieutenant Governor did not take any action," he added.
