Myanmar fishermen rescued off T.N. coast after 3 weeks at sea

The fishermen had set out from Bogale, Myanmar, on November 7. Severe weather conditions had caused their anchor to break, pushing their raft over 1,000 nautical miles into the Indian waters

Four Myanmar fishermen, who were stranded at sea for nearly three weeks, were rescued by the Indian Coast Guard and brought to the Nagapattinam port in Tamil Nadu on Friday morning.

The fishermen, who only speak Burmese, had set out on a bamboo raft from Bogale, Myanmar, on November 7. Severe weather conditions, including rough seas and the aftermath of the recent floods in Myanmar, had caused their anchor to break,

pushing their raft over 1,000 nautical miles into the Indian waters. The fishermen - identified as Kyi Lucin, 58, Aung Sanaige, 23, Win Zaw, 48, and Than Soe, 43 - were found drifting on a 10-foot

long and 12-foot-wide bamboo raft without a motor. This traditional fishing method, common in Bogale, involves fishermen staying on the raft for days before returning to the shore.

This trip, however, turned perilous due to the disturbances at sea, leaving the fishermen stranded and without food.

Local fishermen from Akkaraipettai, Nagapattinam, noticed the raft while returning from a fishing trip and approached it. The Myanmar fishermen were found weak and starving, so they provided them with food and immediately alerted the Indian Coast Guard using a walkie-talkie. Responding swiftly, the Coast Guard dispatched a rescue vessel and brought the fishermen and their raft to the Nagapattinam port.

Shivakumar warns leaders against speaking on 'power-sharing formula'

Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar on Saturday said that no Congress leader should talk about any power-sharing agreement or formula involving him and Chief Minister Siddaramaiah as he has clarified that there was no such thing.

He appears to have issued an oblique warning to his party leaders after Food and Civil Supplies Minister K.H. Muniyappa on

Friday said it was true that there was a power-sharing agreement between the Chief Minister and the Deputy Chief Minister. Mr. Shivakumar had told a private news chan-

nel recently that there was a pact between him and Mr. Siddaramaiah before the party came to power in 2023. However, Mr. Siddaramaiah later said there was no such agreement, and that he would abide by the party's high command's decision.


Mr. Shivakumar on Saturday said, "No one needs to talk about any agreement. We are both working with some political understanding. I have never spoken about any formula. All that I told the channel was

that we have come to some understanding. The Chief Minister has been entrusted with some responsibility and I am entrusted with some." He further said, "I have already said that whatever the Chief Minister has said is final, and the matter is now closed."

Party sources said a compromise is believed to have been reached based on the understanding that Mr. Shivakumar would be considered for the top post after two-and-a-half years of the government's term.
