PM criticises AAP, promises BJP will continue welfare schemes if voted in

● They are lying that we will stop schemes: Modi

WITH HIS FOCUS firmly on the upcoming Assembly elections, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday said all ongoing welfare schemes such as free electricity, free travel for women in public buses, and healthcare schemes, among others, will continue if the BJP forms the government in Delhi.

Addressing a Parivartan Rally at the Japanese Park in Rohini, Modi attacked AAP, continuing to call it the "AAPda (disaster) government" and said, "Ye log apni haar samne dekh kar bhaukla gaye hain (These people are flustered as they see their defeat in front of them). That is why they are lying that all the ongoing welfare schemes will be stopped if the BJP comes to power... But I promise and assure you all that the schemes will continue in Delhi. Parbaimanon kaj theka hai usse hataya jayega (But we will remove dishonest people)... We will remove these AAPda people, bring honest leaders, and take forward all the welfare schemes."

The PM said that the people of Delhi have realised that the state government over the last 10 years has been nothing less than "AAP-da" (disaster). "Isiliye sirf ek hi awaz goonj rahi hai, Aapda nahi sahenge, badlav hum layenge (that is why now only one voice is echoing in Delhi, 'we will not tolerate Aap-da, we will bring change)," said the PM while attacking the AAP on alleged corruption.

It has been learnt that the PM also accused AAP of only focussing on 'Sheesh Mahal'

LAUNCHES A RAFT OF PROJECTS

RAPID RAIL corridor between Ashok Nagar and Sahibabad. The 13-km stretch is part of the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut Namu Bharat corridor. It is also the first foray of the RRTS link into Delhi

"Those who brought aapda to Delhi, allege that the Centre does not let them work and does not give them money. Their Sheesh Mahal proves their lies. Today, a big newspaper has written about the expenditure on Sheesh Mahal based on a CAG report... They made a hefty budget for it. The newspaper has shown how three times that budget was spent," Modi said, adding that when people across the country were fighting the Covid-19 pandemic, the AAP

was building the house.

On Saturday, it has reported how the CAG is learnt to have showed that starting from preliminary estimates of ₹7.91 crore, work of the premises of 6, Flag Staff Road was awarded at ₹8.62 crore in 2020 and when it was completed by the Public Works Department (PWD) in 2022, the total cost stood at ₹33.66 crore.

"You will be pained to know that when people were fighting Covid, running around to get medicines and oxygen, their (AAP's) entire focus was on making Sheesh Mahal. They prepared a hefty budget for Sheesh Mahal. The report has

shown how three times that budget was spent on Sheesh Mahal," Modi stated. Intensifying his attacks, Modi also criticised the AAP government for the alleged lack of development and poor infrastructure in the city over the last 10 years.

"The BJP government has introduced over 1,000 electric buses in Delhi and is advancing e-mobility rapidly. In contrast, the AAP government has done little to support public transport in the city. They are neglecting bus maintenance, leading to potholes on every road, frequent traffic jams, and garbage strewn around the city," he said.

"jabse maine aapda ka kacha chitta khola hai, tabse ye aapda wale tilmila gaye hain ye log (since I started exposing these people, they have been in a panic)... These people have kept Delhi in a poor state for 10 years, and today, people call them AAPda. They attack me. But see what they have turned Delhi into. In the summers, there is a struggle to get drinking water; in the rain, there is waterlogging; in winters, breathing in the polluted air is tough. Each season is AAPda kaal," he said.

Calling for a "double-engine government" in the state, he said, "Delhi will develop only when the AAPda government is removed... Development will be seen when the double-engine government and good governance reach here... It is also important for the people of Delhi to know how AAPda stops facilities for the poor and the middle class. AAPda sarkaar is not implementing the PM Awaz Yojana properly; it is creating hurdles in the construction of houses for the poor. The 30,000 houses constructed for the poor are lying vacant. The BJP regularised hundreds of unauthorised colonies but the AAPda government is not making arrangements for water and sewer lines there," said Modi.

He also said that by stopping the implementation of the Ayushman Bharat Scheme, AAP is insulting the 'senior and elderly people of Delhi'.

Further, PM Modi urged the people to vote for the BJP to make Delhi the number one modern city in the world. "I have come here after inaugurating several projects and laying the foundation stone for more... The coming 25 years are very important for the country's future and Delhi's future. In these 25 years, India will turn into a developed country," he said.

Projects unveiled by PM are joint ventures with state: Kejriwal

AS PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi inaugurated key infrastructure projects in Delhi on Sunday, Aam Aadmi Party chief and former chief minister Arvind Kejriwal called them 'joint ventures' with the Centre and said it was proof that the government in the city works only for its citizens.

At a press conference after the inauguration and Modi's address at Japanese Park in Rohini, where the PM accused the AAP government of corruption, Kejriwal said, "This is an answer to the people who say AAP fights a lot. It shows that the AAP government works only for the people of Delhi. I, Manish Sisodia, Satyendar Jain, Sanjay Singh — the top leadership of AAP — were put in jail. We were troubled and tortured. We did not make this an issue. If we took that to heart, the Delhi metro line would not have been inaugurated today. If we did

that, the RRTS line would not have been built. Over the past 10 years, our tenure has shown how we kept work above everything else," he said.

PM Modi inaugurated a 13-kilometre stretch of the Delhi-Meerut Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridor from Sahibabad in Ghaziabad to New Ashok Nagar and the Janakpuri West-Krishna Park Extension section of the Delhi Metro's

Phase IV. Kejriwal also hit out at Modi, alleging that the PM spent most of his speech "abusing" the AAP government.

"The PM spoke for 38 minutes today. Of these, he spent around 29 minutes abusing the people of Delhi and the elected government. I felt very bad. People expect that a PM will give a vision for Delhi, but he just abused us. But I don't want to get into that. I want to remind the

PM of the promises made in the 2020 sankalp patra. The people of rural Delhi are still waiting for them to be fulfilled," he said.

Kejriwal was referring to the promises made by the BJP in its manifesto ahead of the 2020 Delhi Assembly polls, including that the party would give land ownership rights to the people of rural Delhi, relevant amendments to the Delhi Land Reforms Act and alternative land plots to farmers whose land has been acquired.

Pointing to the delay in notifying the 2041 Delhi Master Plan, Kejriwal said, "The 2041 Master Plan is still not finalised. Delhi's development has been stalled because of it. Why has it not been notified yet? The Land Pooling Policy, notified in 2018, has still not been implemented. If this was done, many sub-cities like Dwarka would have been created. How dare they (BJP) come and seek votes despite not doing any of these things? They only want votes for abusing Kejriwal."

Four Maoists, jawan killed in first Bastar encounter this year

FOUR MAOISTS WERE gunned down on Saturday afternoon in the first encounter this year between Naxals and security forces in Chhattisgarh's Bastar region. In a subsequent gunfight in the evening, a District Reserve Guard (DRG) jawan was killed.

The encounter took place in Abujhmad, a vast unsurveyed area that is larger than the state of Goa, and is spread across the districts of Narayanpur, Bijapur, Dantewada, and Kanker in Bastar region, and a small part of Gadchiroli in Maharashtra. Police said the encounter broke out in the trijunction area of Narayanpur, Bijapur and Dantewada districts, but did not specify the exact location.

The killed jawan was identified as Head Constable Sannu Karam (34), who joined the DRG — a specialised police unit formed to fight Left-wing extremism in Chhattisgarh — in 2018 after leaving Naxalism and surrendering.

Giving details of the encounter, Bastar Inspector General of Police Sundarraj P said, "Acting on the presence of around 40-50 Maoists from Abujhmad (also known as Maad) division, a joint operation was undertaken by DRG teams from Narayanpur, Dantewada, Jagdalpur, and Kondagaon as well as the Special Task Force."

The encounter broke out on Saturday afternoon and intermittent firing continued for hours, police said. After the firing stopped, search operations were conducted and the bodies of four Maoists dressed in People's Liberation Guerrilla Army (PLGA) uniforms were recovered, police said.

On Saturday evening, another round of fire was DRG jawan, 4 Maoists killed in first Bastar encounter this year exchanged in which DRG jawan Sannu Karam suffered a bullet wound to the head and died.

3 killed as Coast Guard chopper crashes at Porbandar airport

A COAST GUARD chopper crashed at Porbandar airport in Gujarat on Sunday as it was landing after a routine training sortie, killing two pilots and a diver who were on board.

The Coast Guard said in a statement that a Board of Inquiry is looking into the crash that killed Commandant (Junior Grade) Saurabh, Deputy Commandant S K Yadav and Pradhan Navik Manoj. It said the mishap happened at around 12.15 pm when the Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH) was on a routine training sortie.

"Immediately post incident, the crew were recovered and shifted to Government Hospital, Porbandar, where they were declared brought dead. The reasons leading to

the incident are being investigated by a Board of Inquiry," the statement said.

"The Mortal remains of the crew viz. Commandant (JG) Saurabh, TM, Deputy Commandant SK Yadav and Manoj Pradhan Navik will be cremated as per service traditions and honour," the Coast Guard
