

## Kasganj violence: 28 convicted by NIA court six years later, family demand death penalty for main accused

**KASGANJ** : As a special NIA court on Friday convicted 28 accused for the Kasganj violence. The family of deceased, Chandan Gupta, demanded that the main culprit be given the death penalty.

Chandan Gupta died of a bullet injury in the clashes that broke out during a "Tiranga bike rally" in Kasganj on Republic Day in 2018.

After the incident in 2018, more than 30 people were sent to jail on charges of murder and 51 others were detained by police, in connection with the violence that erupted in the vicinity.

The brother of Chandan Gupta, Vivek Gupta thanked the lawyers who helped them during the case, and mentioned that they hope that the main accused be given the



death penalty.

"My brother was murdered and the accused have been sentenced to life imprisonment and 10 years of rigorous imprisonment...I thank the lawyers. In the High Court, we will demand that the main culprit be hanged and the two who have been

acquitted should also be punished," he told ANI.

Meanwhile, the District Government Counsel Manoj Kumar Tripathi mentioned that they will also appeal the two people in the case.

"All the accused have been sentenced to life imprisonment. Two people have

been acquitted. We will appeal against their acquittal. Salim has been sentenced additional 7 years of rigorous imprisonment," the government counsel told ANI.

Sangeeta Gupta, the mother of the victim also welcomed the verdict but said that the demand for the death penalty is still not fulfilled. "The only thing left is that the one who fired the bullet should be given the death penalty and the ones who started the fight should also be hanged. Chandan had only gone to celebrate Bharat Mata, he was saying vande mataram. Young people have an excitement to them to celebrate republic day, as they are taught from a young age like other children," she told ANI. She further mentioned

that she would like to meet Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath again and requested that he listen to her pain. She added, "I request that the CM meet me, understand my pain and my son's pain. I hope he comes here to unveil the statue which has been closed off too." The father of the victim thanked the judiciary for the verdict, welcoming the rigorous imprisonment of all the accused.

"We are satisfied with whatever justice has been given and we thank the judiciary and whatever has happened with the case is good. I also thank the judges, lawyers and anyone else who stood with us shoulder to shoulder," said Sushil Gupta, the father of the deceased.

## NIA chargesheets 4 CPI (Maoist) members in Maharashtra's Dinesh Pusu Gawade murder case

**NEW DELHI** : The National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Thursday chargesheeted four members of the banned CPI (Maoist) terrorist organisation for the abduction and brutal killing of a youth in Maharashtra's Gadchiroli. According to NIA press release, the accused, identified as Doba Wadde, Ravi Pallo, Satru Mahaka and Komati Mahaka, have been charged with abduction and murder of Dinesh Pusu Gawade in November 2023.

"They had kidnapped and killed Gawade on suspicion of being a police informer and a member of RSS," NIA said. In its chargesheet filed before the NIA Special Court, Mumbai, Maharashtra, in case RC-03/2024/NIA/MUM, the agency has stated that the accused were active members of CPI (Maoist) and had committed the crime in furtherance of the outfit's conspiracy to spread terror in the minds of the local villagers. Their act was also aimed as a threat to the villagers against sharing any information about Naxal activities/movements with the security forces.

The case was initially registered at P.S Dhodraj by Gadchiroli Police, which arrested the accused.

## SC seeks data from UGC on complaints of caste discrimination in universities

**NEW DELHI** : The Supreme Court on Friday asked the University Grants Commission (UGC) to collate and furnish data regarding the total number of complaints of caste discrimination received under its 2012 regulations in universities and higher educational institutions in the country.

A bench of Justices Surya Kant and Ujjal Bhuyan asked UGC to submit data on how many Central, state, deemed and private universities and higher educational institutions have set up Equal Opportunity Cells and the total number of complaints received under the UGC (Promotion of Equity in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2012 alongwith action taken reports.

It took into consideration the submission of UGC that pursuant to certain recommendations a new set of regulations has been formulated. The top court directed the UGC to notify regulations and place the same on record.

The order was passed on a PIL filed by the mothers of Rohit Vemula and Payal

Tadvi assailing caste discrimination in higher educational institutions.

As the bench was informed that as many as 115 suicides have taken place in IITs alone between 2004 and 2024, it remarked that the court is "conscious of the sensitivity of the matter" and would begin hearing it periodically to find out a mechanism that would translate the 2012 Regulations into a reality.

During the hearing of the case, senior advocate Indira Jaising representing for petitioners contended that UGC failed to implement the 2012 regulations which were intended to put an end to discrimination based on caste in higher educational institutions. She requested the bench to seek data from the Central government and the National Assessment and Accreditation Council - regarding data about the number of suicides by students belonging to the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe category in higher educational institutions. The bench then asked Union and NAAC to file counter-affi-

davits within four weeks.

Rohit Vemula, a PhD scholar at Hyderabad Central University, died by suicide on January 17, 2016, reportedly due to caste discrimination.

Payal Tadvi, a tribal student at Tamil Nadu Topiwala National Medical College in Mumbai also died by suicide on May 22, 2019, as she was allegedly subjected to caste-based discrimination by her upper-caste peers.

In 2019, their mothers filed a PIL in the top court seeking a mechanism to end caste-based discrimination on campuses.

They claimed that there is a rampant prevalence of caste discrimination against members of the SC/ST community. They also sought a direction to all Universities and higher educational institutions to establish Equal Opportunity Cells on the lines of such other existing anti-discrimination internal complaints mechanisms and to include members from the SC/ST communities and independent representatives from NGOs or social activists to ensure objectivity and impartiality in the process.

## GRAP-3 curbs back in Delhi-NCR amid rise in air pollution levels

**NEW DELHI** : The Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM) on Friday invoked stage 3 curbs under the Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) across the Delhi-NCR region amid another surge in air pollution levels.

The Centre's panel on Delhi-National Capital Region's (NCR) air quality directed the authorities in the region to immediately implement curbs prescribed under stage 3 to prevent further worsening of the situation, an official order stated.

GRAP Stage 3, which was lifted last Friday, entails a ban on nonessential construction work.

Classes up to grade V are required to shift to hybrid mode under Stage 3. Parents and students have the option to choose online education wherever available.

Under Stage 3, the use of BS-III petrol and BS-IV diesel cars (4-wheelers) is restricted in Delhi and nearby NCR districts. Stage 3 also bans nonessential diesel-operated

medium goods vehicles with BS-IV or older standards in Delhi. "In an effort to prevent further deterioration of the air quality

## SC notice to Dera chief Ram Rahim on CBI's plea challenging his acquittal in 2002 murder case

**NEW DELHI** : The Supreme Court on Friday issued notice to the self-styled Godman and Dera Sacha Sauda chief Gurmeet Ram Rahim Singh and four others on a plea of CBI challenging the judgment of the Punjab and Haryana High Court acquitting them in the 2002 murder of sect's former manager Ranjit Singh.


A bench of Chief Justice of India Sanjeev Khanna and Sanjay Kumar sought a

response from Ram Rahim and others and tagged the matter with another pending appeal filed by the complainant who had also challenged the acquittal.

The bench posted the matter for hearing before a bench headed by Justice Bela Trivedi which had issued a notice in the appeal filed by the complainant- the father of the deceased.

"Our attention has been drawn to the office report dated September 9, 2024, of the order passed by the bench of Justice Bela Trivedi, issue notice and tag with... the SLP be listed before the bench of Justice Bela Trivedi," the bench ordered.

The other convicts who were sentenced to life imprisonment by the trial court on October 18, 2021, along with Ram Rahim were Avtar Singh, Krishan



Lal, Jasbir Singh, and Sabil Singh. One of the accused, Inder Sain, had died during the trial in 2020. The Dera manager, Ranjit Singh, was shot dead when he was working in his fields in his native village in Kurukshetra district of Haryana on July 10, 2002. On November 10, 2003, the High Court ordered a

CBI investigation into the case, earlier registered at Police Station Sadar, Thanesar, Kurukshetra.

When the matter reached the High Court against the trial court order, it found that the CBI failed to establish the motive of the crime and rather, the prosecution case was "shrouded in doubts".

Ram Rahim is lodged in Sunaria jail in Rohtak, Haryana, and serving a 20-year jail term for raping two of his disciples.

According to the CBI chargesheet, Ram Rahim suspected Ranjit Singh of circulating an anonymous letter among the dera followers accusing Ram Rahim of sexually exploiting female disciples at the dera. It was based on this letter that a rape case was registered against Ram Rahim in 2002.

## EAM Jaishankar meets Iran Deputy FM Takht Ravanchi, discusses bilateral ties, Chabahar Port

**NEW DELHI** : External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar met with Iran's Deputy Foreign Minister Takht Ravanchi in New Delhi on Friday and discussed the wide expanse of India-Iran ties.

In a post on X, the EAM said that the two leaders held discussions on the bilateral ties of India and Iran, the progress on the Chabahar port along with regional developments.

"Received Deputy FM @TakhtRavanchiof Iran this evening. Discussed our bilateral ties, progress in Chabahar port and regional developments. Confident that the Foreign Office Consultations will give a momentum to our partnership."

Iran's Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs, Dr Takht Ravanchi is visiting India to discuss key issues between the two countries such as trade volumes. Other items on the agenda are increasing bilateral trade in both energy and non-energy sectors, improving connectivity and tourism, regional and international security, and the completion of Chabahar Port.

India and Iran share a millennia-long history of interactions. India and Iran signed a friendship treaty on March 15, 1950. The visit of then Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee to Iran and the signing of the Tehran Declaration in April 2001, followed by the visit of then President Seyyed Mohammad Khatami and the signing of the New Delhi Declaration in 2003 deepened the India-Iran cooperation.
