Despite the protests and public concern over potential environmental pollution, including fears of air and water contamination, the High Court clarified that it had never instructed the government to load the waste into trucks but only directed its safe disposal.

Rachna Dhingra, convener of the Bhopal Gas Information and Action (BGIA), suggested that Dow Chemical executives, who were present during the hearing but did not comment, should be held accountable and asked to take the waste back to their country.

The protests over the waste incineration at Pithampur have intensified in recent weeks, with local residents raising concern over potential health risks. The state government is working to address these fears by implementing safety protocols and engaging with the public to provide clear information on the waste disposal process.

With the High Court's decision to grant six weeks, the state now has an opportunity to dispel myths and reassure the people of Pithampur about the safety of the operation.

Cheap system for...

The researchers have developed specialized inks using metal oxide and carbide materials to overcome challenges like hydrophobicity in conventional carbon-based photo thermal materials. These inks absorb solar radiation effectively and convert it into heat, producing steam directly from salt water at the air-water interface without requiring external energy sources.

IIT Indore director Prof Suhas Joshi said, "Unlike traditional desalination processes such as reverse osmosis, which are energy-intensive and infrastructure-heavy, ISSG is a simple and low-energy alternative. When exposed to sunlight, the photo thermal material rapidly gets heated, causing the water to evaporate while leaving salt and contaminants behind. The resulting steam is condensed into purified water, making the process efficient and environmentally friendly."

Devan said, "Our goal was to develop a scalable and cost-effective water purification method. By utilizing metal oxide-based inks, we achieved high evaporation rates, essential for practical applications. The technology is particularly suitable for remote and coastal areas where seawater is abundant and conventional energy resources are scarce. We are refining the inks for broader use, including integrating them into ISSG-based desalination systems for deployment in real-world scenarios."

The team is also exploring other applications, such as treating wastewater from the dye and textile industries. Moreover, the researchers are working on multi-functional systems that combine desalination with energy generation. These systems aim to produce clean water, generate electricity and harvest residual salts for reuse, making the technology more economically viable and environmentally sustainable.

Waqf land used for Maha Kumbh, claims cleric

Islamic cleric and President of the All India Muslim Jamat, Maulana Shahabuddin Razvi Bareilly fired a fresh salvo by claiming that the upcoming Prayagraj's Maha Kumbh event is being held on land owned by the Waqf Board.

In a video message, Bareilly said that 55 bighas of waqf land are being used for the Hindu religious event. He further said that the Muslims of Prayagraj have shown a large heart by not grudging the use of waqf land for the Maha Kumbh.

However, the cleric said that instead of reciprocating the secular sense, there were repeated calls being made for Muslims to keep away from the Maha Kumbh.

"Such calls have indeed been made. The All-India Akhara Parishad has asked

not only for a ban on the entry of Muslims but also asked that no non-Sanatanis be given permission to set up stalls in the mela area. They have also asked devotees and attendees not to give any business to Muslims," he said in the video message.

VHP, Hindu Seers React However, Hindu leaders have rejected the Maulana's claims. Hindu Mahasabha President

Swami Chakrapani Maharaj said that Bareilly must be sponsored by Pakistan and 'people with a terrorist mindset'.

He said that the cleric is making a malicious attempt to disturb the Maha Kumbh, and his statements should be investigated.

BJP lawmaker Vijay Bahadur Pathak refuted the cleric's claims, saying that the Kumbh Mela has been held at the

Leaked CAG report fuels BJP's Sheeshmahal jibe against AAP

The Bharatiya Janata Party on Monday criticised the Aam Aadmi Party convener and former Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal for allegedly splurging Rs 75-80 crore on renovation of his official bungalow in Civil Lines, which the party refers to as "Sheeshmahal" and for engaging in various other malpractices which led to the report of the Comptroller and Auditor General for the year 2022 raising 139 questions.

Address a press conference at the BJP headquarters, party spokesperson and MP Sambit Patra said the audit report, which was signed by CAG Girish Chandra Murmu

on November 20, "exposed the black deeds" of Kejriwal. Patra said as far as the "Sheeshmahal" went, the report has pointed to an expenditure of Rs 33.86 crore though the final cost was much higher since the expenses incurred in 2023 and 2024 were not included in it.

Patra claimed that as per the information available with the BJP, "the real cost was Rs 75-80 crore if the inventory of the items in the bungalow was included". And inventory conducted by the Public Works Department in October 2024, when Kejriwal had vacated the premises after resigning as CM had revealed Rs 56 crore worth of expenditure, fittings and items in the building.

The BJP has made "Sheeshmahal" one of its primary issue for the upcoming Delhi Assembly elections. Recently, on January 3, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had also criticised Kejriwal, without naming him, for the indulgence saying, "Modi never built a home for himself. But, in the past 10 years, 4 crore citizens have been given houses. I could have built a 'Sheeshmahal' for myself, but my dream was to provide 'pakka' (permanent) homes to all the people in my country."

A day later, Home minister Amit Shah also raised the issue saying Kejriwal will have to give an account to the people of Delhi for the Rs 45 crore spent on the "Sheeshmahal".

Woman, daughter escape attack by rhino during safari

A woman and her daughter had a close shave from being attacked by a rhino during a vehicle safari in Assam's Kaziranga National Park (KNP), an official said on Monday. The girl fell from the open vehicle while they were taking a safari inside the Bagori range of the KNP and her mother jumped out to pick her up on Sunday.

A rhino waiting nearby was seen moving towards them in a video that has gone viral on social media. The driver, however, stopped the vehicle and the two climbed into it again.

"It was a moment of terror I will never forget," a witness said. "It could have ended so much worse."

The two were not injured but were taken for medical aid as they were in a state of shock for a while. The official pointed out that tourists should be care-

ful while taking a safari inside the KNP. He urged all tourists to follow the rules strictly. The KNP is a UNESCO World Heritage site which is home to the greater one-horn rhinoceros. This season alone, the park recorded its highest tourist footfall in two decades, with over 164,000 visitors. The park administration has since launched an investigation into the incident and urged tourists to stay vigilant during safaris.

PK granted unconditional bail

In a dramatic turn of events, Jan Suraj founder Prashant Kishor, who was arrested for illegally staging fast-unto-death protest at Gandhi Mai-

dan in the state capital in the early hours on Monday, was granted unconditional bail, only a few hours after he was sent to 14-day judicial custody.

Earlier, the court had granted him bail on a personal bond of Rs 25,000 and also put

a condition with the bail bond that he could not participate in such protests that disrupted law and order. Kishor, however, refused to fill the bail bond and accept the bail condition, after which he was sent to 14-day judicial custody.
