Punjab govt clears sites of year-long farmer protest, detains top leaders

PUNJAB POLICE started clearing the Shambhu and Khanauri border sites where farmer protests have been on since February last year on Wednesday evening, with the two leaders spearheading the stir detained earlier in the day.

Kisan Mazdoor Morcha (KMM) leader Sarwan Singh Pandher and Samyukta Kisan Morcha (Non Political) leader Jagjit Singh Dallewal were detained while they were on their way back to Shambhu and Khanauri, respectively, after talks with the Centre. Sources said the discussions were inconclusive with Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal taking an assertive stand on their MSP demand.

Just hours earlier, amid swirling speculation about such an action being planned by the Punjab government, the state authorities had assured farmer leaders that no such crackdown was in the works.

By late Wednesday, all the farmers sitting at the Khanauri and Shambhu border sites had been detained. The authorities cut off electricity supply on both sides of the highways at the sites, and police used torches for the operation. Before his force moved in at the Khanauri border, Patiala DIG Mandeep Singh Sidhu told the farmers to get onto the buses ferrying the protesters away on their own. "We are over 3,000 in strength and you are only a few hundred. We will clear the site, come what may. Your leaders have already been detained at Chandigarh... We don't want to use force," he appealed.

Dallewal, who has been on a fast unto death since November last year, and Pandher were detained as soon as they entered the Punjab border from Chandigarh, where the talks with Union ministers Goyal, Shivraj Singh Chouhan (Agriculture) and Pralhad Joshi (Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution) were held. Dallewal's ambulance was reportedly taken over by police near Zirakpur, while Pandher was detained at Mohali.

Farmer leaders and others accompanying Dallewal and Pandher were also detained.

NIA chargesheets 3 men linked to Khalistani terrorist, in 2024 hotel firing case

THE NATIONAL Investigation Agency (NIA) on Wednesday chargesheeted three persons, linked to a Canada-based wanted Khalistani terrorist, for their alleged involvement in a firing incident outside a hotel in Rajasthan last year.

In its chargesheet filed before the National Investigation Agency special court in Jaipur, the agency has charged Sachin alias Praveen alias Dholia, Yogesh alias Monu, and Vijay alias Kale with conspiring with other accused to carry out the attack on Hotel Highway King in Neemrana, in December 2024.

"National Investigation Agency investigations had revealed that the trio were in touch with (Arsh) Dala, a Canada-based designated individual terrorist, as well as accused Dinesh Gandhi, Sorav Kataria, Kaushal Chaudhary and Manisha, to execute the firing at the hotel. Shooters Narender alias Lally and Puneet had been tasked with carrying out the attack as part of the conspiracy," the anti-terrorism agency said in a statement.

Sources said Dallewal was taken to a hospital and Pandher sent to the Commando Training Centre at Bahadurgarh in Patiala.

The AAP government had so far shown reluctance to take any harsh action against the protesting farmers, despite several rounds of failed talks. On Wednesday, the Union ministers reportedly told the farmers that the data provided by them to seek MSP for all crops was not satisfactory. May 4 was fixed as the date for the next round of talks.

Sources said the decision to act against the protest was finally taken after AAP supremo Arvind Kejriwal, who is in Punjab, received feedback from traders in Ludhiana that the party would not get their votes in the coming Ludhiana West Assembly by-elections if the blockade by the farmers, which was hitting business, was not ended.

The government reportedly devised an action plan in the last two days, and the two farmer leaders were trailed by police on Wednesday from the time they left the meeting venue in Chandigarh. The authorities didn't want to pick the two up from the protest sites as that could have led to trouble.

Punjab had been abuzz that such an action was afoot — especially since Tuesday night — after security was stepped up at the Shambhu and Khanauri border points, and water cannons, cranes and trolleys were deployed.

Saying they were all confused, a farmer at the Khanauri protest site told *The Indian Express* that around 500 of them were present when police came Wednesday evening. "The gathering was thin as a new batch of farmers was to come on March 21," he said, adding that Internet facilities had been curbed and they were unable to share photos and videos from the sites. Till late on Wednesday, police were pulling down the tents and removing the trolleys used by the farmers.

Gov't shield in crackdown: Rising trader anger, low public support

THE PUNJAB government's action against protesting farmers, more than a year after they began their sit-ins at Shambhu and Khanauri border points, comes amid growing signs that the stir was losing public support.

While appeals had been made earlier too by industry bodies about the blockade hurting their bottom lines, as well as the reputation of the state as an investment destination, the immediate trigger for the AAP government was the bypoll to be held for the Ludhiana West Assembly seat, which needs to be filled by July 11. The AAP has already named industrialist-turned-politician Sanjeev Arora, who is currently a Rajya Sabha MP, as its candidate for the seat.

Having lost the Delhi Assembly elections and feeling the heat from an Opposition that has smelled blood, the AAP is desperate for a win. AAP supremo Arvind Kejriwal, who recently visited Ludhiana, received feedback from Ludhiana's big industry hub that the party was set to lose the trader vote on account of the farmer blockade.

Sources said that even at Wednesday's meeting with the Centre held in Chandigarh, Punjab ministers appealed to farmer leaders to lift the block-

ades for the sake of the traders, who had to spend lakhs extra on transport of goods. However, the farmer leaders reportedly refused the appeal to provide passage.

The farmer leaders present at the talks who were detained soon after they left the venue and entered Punjab border included, apart from Kisan Mazdoor Morcha (KMM) leader Sarwan Singh Pandher and Samyukta Kisan Morcha (Non Political) leader Jagjit Singh Dallewal, 26 others. Woman farmer leader Sukhwinder Kaur was among the detainees.

The demands of the protesting farmers have centred around a legal guarantee on Minimum Support Price for crops.

Last month, while addressing the Punjab Assembly, New and Renewable Energy Sources Minister and AAP state president Aman Arora appealed to the farmers to end the blockade, even as he supported their rejection of a draft on the National Agriculture Marketing Policy. "I appeal to the farmers to clear the blockade. The traders and industrialists are suffering losses and investors are

turning away," he said.

The same day, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann met a delegation of industrialists from Jalandhar, who appealed to him to ensure lifting of the blockade.

A fortnight ago, Mann walked out of a meeting with SKM leaders in another sign of the growing frustration of the state government. The support for the agitation has also been dwindling among the general public, with the blockades affecting travel along the Punjab-Delhi highway.

Punjab Finance Minister Harpal Singh Cheema said highways are the lifelines of a state. "We have been losing out on investments. We had been telling the farmers that their fight was with the Centre but we were still supporting them. That is why I was at the meeting today with Union ministers along with two of my Cabinet colleagues."

Cheema said he also told farmers that Punjab's drug crisis could only be fought by giving youths jobs.

Rajasthan: SC directs review of mining leases granted before 2011

THE SUPREME Court Wednesday directed the Rajasthan government to review all the pre-2011 mining leases granted without following an auction process, resulting in "unjust" and "unethical" enrichment of affluent persons.

A bench of Justices Surya Kant and N Kottiswar Singh said it is shocking that mining leases in Rajasthan were given without following the appropriate process of auction.

The bench of Justices Surya Kant and N Kottiswar Singh upheld a decision of the Jodhpur bench of the Rajasthan High Court cancelling the lease of one Divya Darshana, who was granted the lease for excavation of masonry stones in Pali district, for non-compliance of environmental norms.

"We are shocked to see that mining leases are granted in Rajasthan without following the due process of auction. State largesse cannot be given in a non-transparent manner," the bench said.

The bench said ordinarily, the commercial properties of the state are to be auctioned and any other method must satisfy the test of reasonableness.

The counsel for the state government said since 2011, no mining lease was granted without following the process of auction.

The bench said, "If that is so, the earlier mining leases are to be reviewed so that the state largesse is not given for unjust, unethical enrichment of affluent persons."

The top court said an auction allows other parties to participate in the process and the state gets the best price for excavation of minerals.

The Supreme Court, however, clarified that environmental norms are to be mandatorily followed by the lessees.

Illegal mining near Sariska Tiger Reserve: SC tells Rajasthan to appoint nodal officer

THE SUPREME Court on Wednesday directed the Rajasthan government to appoint a nodal officer in Alwar district to deal with complaints of illegal mining within a kilometre of the Sariska Tiger Reserve.

A bench of Justices B R Gavi and Augustine George Masih passed the order while hearing pleas that claimed illegal mining activities within a kilometre of the tiger reserve despite the apex court's ban on such activity.

The Rajasthan government denied the allegations and said inspections were conducted by the authorities even at night on the highways to prevent any such unauthorised activity. Senior advocate K Parmeshwar, assisting the court as an amicus curiae, said the state appointing a nodal officer would be a better way to deal with the grievances.

"We, therefore, direct the state of Rajasthan to appoint a nodal officer in the office of the district mining officer, Alwar," the bench said. Upon the receipt of the complaint, the bench said, the nodal officer would take a decision within two weeks.

The court disposed of the ap-

plications and said if such a grievance was not entertained, the aggrieved person could approach the jurisdictional high court.

The counsel for the applicants said the apex court's directions for a ban on the mining activity within one kilometre of the reserve were being flouted.

"They can't do anything which will have an adverse effect on the critical tiger habitat without our permission," the bench said. The top court in May last year said the continuance of any mining activity within the one-kilometre radius from the boundaries of critical tiger habitat of the reserve would be in contempt of its April 2023 order.

The apex court in its April 26, 2023 verdict imposed a ban on mining within the national park and wildlife sanctuary aside from the one-kilometre area from its boundary.

"In our judgment dated April 26, 2023 further affirmed vide order dated April 28, 2023, we have prohibited mining activities within a radius of one kilometre from all protected areas. At the cost of repetition, the protected areas would not only mean the wildlife sanctuaries/national parks but also the critical tiger habitat," the court in its May 15, 2024 order said.

CM nod for prosecution of 7 officials

Jaipur: The Rajasthan government has approved prosecution of seven state officials in five Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act cases. Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma disposed of 13 cases that required his approval for prosecution and

disciplinary actions against state service officials.

Among them, the CM granted prosecution approval against seven officers in five PC Act cases, while in four other cases, he ended the pension of a retired officer. PTI
