

Amit Shah directs authorities to crack down on networks assisting Bangladeshi, Rohingya intruders

NEW DELHI : Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday directed authorities to crack down the entire network assisting Bangladeshi and Rohingya intruders illegally entering the country, obtaining documents, and settling in India. Shah's direction came after a high-level meeting with newly elected Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta, Home Minister Ashish Sood, Delhi Commissioner of Police Sanjay Arora, and senior officials on law and order and coordination. This is the first meeting after a decade in the presence of the Delhi Chief Minister. Shah pointed out that the issue of "illegal intruders is also related to national security, and it should be dealt with strictly, and they should be identified and deported."

Shah said, "It should be the priority of Delhi Police to eliminate interstate gangs in Delhi with a ruthless approach." He also instructed that the "Delhi Police should identify the places where there is daily traffic jam and Delhi Police Commissioner and Chief Secretary should meet and find a quick solution to this, so that the public can get relief." The Home Minister also asked the Delhi government to "prepare a 'Monsoon Action Plan' to deal with water-logging by identifying the places where water-logging occurs."



Shah instructed that "the Delhi government should appoint special prosecutors so that these cases can be disposed of soon" to ensure the quick disposal of the 2020 Delhi riots cases. The Home Minister further directed the Delhi Police to start recruiting for additional posts soon, and the DCP-level officers should go to police stations, organize public hearing camps, and solve the problems of the public. Shah also suggested form-

ing "new security committees in JJ clusters for the safety of women and children." He also instructed that the "Delhi Police should identify the places where there is daily traffic jam and Delhi Police Commissioner and Chief Secretary should meet and find a quick solution to this, so that the public can get relief." The Home Minister also asked the Delhi government to "prepare a 'Monsoon Action Plan' to deal with water-logging by identifying the places where water-logging occurs."

Design is key to India's legacy and future development: Piyush Goyal



NEW DELHI : Design is not only about aesthetics, it is an innovation that has its impact on India's legacy and will play a role in the country's development. This was stated by Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal during his address at the 44th Convocation Ceremony of National Institute of Design (NID), Ministry of Commerce and Industry said. He further noted that the fresh graduates will act as a bridge between the legacy and the future of this country. President of India, Droupadi Murmu, Acharya Devvrat, Governor of Gujarat, Bhupendra Patel, Chief Minister of Gujarat, Minister of State Commerce and Industries Jitin Prasada and Governing Council Members also graced the event on Thursday. Highlighting Prime Minister Narendra Modi's call for 'Make in India' and 'Design in India' for the world, Minister Goyal noted that the fresh graduates will make it a reality. He stressed that these graduates as problem solvers, innovators and designers will be working for the world. "You will be the architect of the world, the world is waiting for you", he said. Emphasising on the growing importance of design across sectors from space to semiconductors, Goyal pointed out that the first stage of the Chandrayaan space mission was the satellite's design that led to its success. He asserted that India's design capabilities will be on display in audio-visual technologies to gaming, sustainability, toys and more. "Possibilities in design are endless. We have to create new ideas, innovation on a large scale catering to 140 crore people of the country. Inclusive growth and development is our country's will and strength. Create, disrupt and leave a mark in the world with your capabilities," the Minister said. The 44th Convocation Ceremony saw 430 students from various disciplines being awarded degrees from the National Institute of Design.

Maharashtra: Fishing boat catches fire off Raigad coast; all 18 crew members rescued
 RAIGAD : A fishing boat belonging to Rakesh Gan caught fire approximately 6-7 nautical miles off the coast of Akshi, Aliba, in the Raigad district during the early hours of Thursday, officials said. The incident occurred around 3-4 am. Upon receiving the distress call, the Indian Coast Guard and the Indian Navy launched a swift rescue operation. They successfully evacuated all 18 crew members from the boat, as confirmed by Raigad SP Indian Coast Guard Ships (ICGS) Savitribai Phule, on patrol off Mumbai, sighted IFB on fire in Position 190 Prongs Lt 21. The ship responded to the situation and confirmed that all fishermen from the boat had embarked on another IFB in the area.

Telangana: 200 personnel will be deployed in SLBC tunnel rescue operation as efforts intensify

NAGARKURNOOL : Rescue operations are ongoing in Nagarkurnool after a tunnel collapsed on February 22, trapping eight workers. Efforts to rescue them have been intensified, with a total of 200 personnel set to be deployed at the site. A joint effort involving mining experts from Singareni, the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), the Indian Army, and other agencies is in progress, officials said. An officer from the rescue team said, "Initially, we deployed 20 people and yesterday and today we are going to deploy 200 personnel... All our rescue team personnel from Singareni are experienced in working underground and in emergency situations. So, they are experts in rock cutting." Nagarkurnool SP Gaikwad Vaibhav Raghunath said, "All Singareni teams, NDRF team, SDRF team, Army and company officials are here. Sludge has been brought out since yesterday. Hopefully, we will get good results soon. The combined teams are working here. It is a combined operation." According to Congress MLA Dr. Chikkudu Vamsi, relief operations are continuing on the seventh day since the incident. He highlighted that 12 departments are collaborating to expedite the process, and experienced personnel from Singareni mines are playing a crucial role. "This is the 7th day since the incident occurred... Today, work is being done on war footing with the collaboration of 12 departments. Those who are the experts in India are working here... I hope that by this evening, most of the slush.

Organized by the Rumi Foundation, the festival, started by renowned filmmaker and artist Muzaffar Ali in 2001, celebrates its 25th anniversary this year. During the festival, the prime minister also visited the TEH Bazaar (TEH: The Exploration of the Handmade), which featured One District-One Product crafts and other various exquisite artefacts from across the country, short films on handicrafts and handlooms, among others. He also interacted with the shopkeepers during his visit to the Bazaar.

SC grants pre-arrest bail to former Chhattisgarh Advocate General in NAN scam case

NEW DELHI : The Supreme Court on Friday granted anticipatory bail to former Advocate General of Chhattisgarh Satish Chandra Verma, who was booked in connection with the Nagrik Apurti Nigam (NAN) scam case. While granting the pre-arrest bail, a bench of Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta directed the former Chhattisgarh Advocate General Verma to cooperate with the investigation. The case against Verma pertained to certain incriminating WhatsApp chats that took place between him and bureaucrats Anil Tuteja and Alok Shukla-- who are the prime accused in the Nagrik Apurti Nigam (NAN) scam case. As per allegations by the Enforcement Directorate, the former law officer aided the prime accused in the case in securing their bail. The Nagrik Apurti Nigam (NAN) scam involves the supply of alleged substandard rice, grams, salt, and other essentials, which has led to the arrest of several high-profile individuals, including bureaucrats. In November last year, a sessions court in Chhattisgarh had rejected Verma's bail, stating that the allegations against him were serious and required to be investigated. Later, the Chhattisgarh High Court also rejected Verma's pre-arrest bail plea. During an earlier hearing in the case on February 21, the Chhattisgarh government had informed the Supreme Court it would not take any coercive steps against Verma in relation to the Nagrik Apurti Nigam (NAN) scam case.
