# Cops gun down one suspect, another escapes; DGP says 'no bullet-for-bullet' policy

SSP says efforts on to nab the suspect at large

A SUSPECT in the grenade attack on a temple in Amritsar was killed in an exchange of fire with police Monday while another managed to flee, a senior officer said even as DGP Gaurav Yadav clarified that the police force was not following a bullet-for-bullet policy while targeting gangsters and other miscreants but retaliates only when fired upon.

A blast had occurred outside the Thakurdwara temple in Khandwala area of Amritsar shortly after midnight on March 15 when two persons hurled an explosive device towards it, damaging a portion of its wall and shattering window panes. Police identified the suspect, who was killed in the shootout as Gursidak Singh, alias Sidki, a resident of Bal village. The suspect who managed to flee was identified as Vishal alias Chui, a resident of Rajasansi.

Commissioner of Police Gurpreet Singh Bhullar said the suspects, who were on a motorcycle, were asked to stop by a police team but they opened fire. Head constable Gurpreet Singh sustained a bullet injury in his left arm while one bullet

hit the turban of Inspector Amolak Singh, said Bhullar. He said the accused fired five rounds at the police team, which retaliated in self-defence.

Gursidak Singh was injured and taken to Civil Hospital where he later succumbed to injuries while Vishal managed to flee, Bhullar said, adding efforts were underway to arrest him.

Gursidak Singh was involved in two cases of snatching at gunpoint and had been recently released from jail, while Vishal faces an attempt to murder case.

Earlier, Punjab Police chief Gaurav Yadav said acting on specific intelligence, Amritsar police tracked down the suspects in Rajasansi. Yadav, in a post on X, said the accused opened fire, injuring two police officers fol-

lowing which, "acting in self-defence, the police party fired back", injuring one accused.

Later, interacting with media in Chandigarh, Yadav said the police aim to work within the law, conduct probes and punish the accused through law.

"Our effort is to work within the parameters of law and carry out professional investigation and get the accused punished through the courts. When we face any firing, then we retaliate in self-defence. Bullet for bullet is not an aggressive policy. It is a policy of self-defence. If police is attacked, police will respond," he said, while replying to queries pertaining to Amritsar encounter.

Earlier, CCTV camera footage of the incident showed two unidentified people reaching the temple on a motorcycle. After waiting for a sometime, one of them was seen throwing the explosive device towards the temple. The blast occurred as they were fleeing the scene.

The priest of the temple, who was sleeping inside, escaped unhurt but the blast panic among residents in the Khandwala area.

The police had said that it suspects the role of Pakistan's spy agency Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI) in the attack. An FIR was registered at Chheharta police station under the Explosive Substances Act based on a complaint filed by the temple priest. A fresh FIR has been registered at Airport police station following the encounter, DGP Yadav said.

# SSPs, SHOs to get quantified targets, will be assessed based on performance: DGP Yadav

Munshis to be rotated every two years at police stations

IN A bid to hold police officers accountable, Senior Superintendents of Police (SSP) and Station House Officers (SHO) will be assigned targets in the ongoing drive against drugs on the basis of which their performance will be assessed.

Making this announcement Monday, DGP Gaurav Yadav told the media that the decision has been arrived at after a long brain storming meeting with senior officers held today. He also informed that following a directive of the CM Bhagwant Mann, the Munshi Head Constables (MHC) in police stations will be rotated from their posts every two years.

The DGP announced a host of measures to make anti-drugs drive launched on March 1 more effective. "All districts will be mapped regarding what kind of drugs are available there and strategy will be formed to combat them as per that. All SSPs and SHOs will be given quantified targets and based on that their performance will be assessed. It will be seen what performance they put up against the targets and parameters they have been assigned," Yadav said.

The DGP explained that the targets would include number of arrests, seizure of drugs, seizure of property under NDPS Act etc. "Performance of previous three years will be examined and a weighted average will be taken for comparison. These are not numerical targets per se but these are overall performance targets," he said.

He added that cohesive measures will be taken for reduction of demand for drugs under the cabinet sub committee formed for this purpose and all concerned departments will be a part of this effort. "Steps for awareness, prevention, de-addiction and rehabilitation steps will be taken. It was felt that de-addiction and rehabilitation have to be integrated. Our focus is on quality and not on numbers. We will target sellers

on streets. Victims are to not be harassed unnecessarily," he said. The DGP said the feedback on ground points towards success of the anti-drugs drive. "As per our intelligence inputs there has been a significant impact of the anti-drugs drive. Couriers are not picking up drug consignments (at the Indo-Pak border). This has greatly impacted the Pakistan-based drugs suppliers who push drugs into Punjab," he said.

The DGP appealed to public for support and cooperation in the ongoing drive. The DGP clarified that police were only performing a supporting role in the ongoing demolition drive being carried out on houses belonging to drug smugglers. He said these houses have been built by encroaching on government land and the civic authorities were removing the same. "There is no provision for demolition of houses under NDPS Act," he said.

When asked what were the parameters which suggest this the present drive against drugs would succeed as two previous drives—under SAD-BJP government and Congress regime—had also taken place, the DGP said it is difficult for him to comment on the earlier drives though good efforts had been made. "It is too early to suggest that a tipping point has come this time but there are indications because people are cooperating," he said.

He added that the Punjab Police arrested 2,575 drug smugglers after registering of 1,651 FIRs across the state since March 1. During this drive, Police teams recovered 95 kg heroin, 52 kg opium, 1129 kg poppy husk, 13.79 kg Ganja, he said.

## Amritsar case an example, will teach a lesson to ISI, says DGP

PUNJAB DGP Gaurav Yadav Monday said intelligence inputs indicate that Pakistan's intelligence agency ISI has planned a strategy to cause disturbance in Punjab so as to disrupt the drive against drugs. "You have seen what happened in the Amritsar incident where explosive was thrown on temple. We have zero tolerance policy in this regard.

We will teach a lesson to ISI masters of these people sitting in Pakistan. We have many clues in this particular case and very soon we will reveal more details," he said. He said exemplary action will be taken against those who try to disturb peace in Punjab and that peace and harmony of Punjab will be maintained at all costs. "We have technical inputs and human inputs. We know who there people are sitting on this side. We know how to hit back at Pakistan and ISI. We are on the job," he said.

He informed that drones from Pakistan have now started bringing in small payloads of drugs weighing 1.5 kg, one kg or even 500 grams after the anti-drugs drive was launched. "ISI desperation is being seen. They want to cause issues in Punjab. The war on drugs has caused panic in them," he said.
