France begins handing over military bases

France handed control of two military facilities to Senegal on Friday, beginning the formal process of withdrawing its military presence from the West African country amid its waning influence in the region. The handover follows the declaration by Senegal's President Bassirou Diomaye Faye late last year that all foreign troops would leave the country. "The French side handed over to the Senegalese side the facilities and housing in the Maréchal and Saint-Exupéry districts on Friday, March 7, 2025," the French Embassy in Senegal said in a statement Friday. "Located near the Hann Park, these districts were ready to be returned since the summer of 2024." France set up a joint commission with Senegal last month to organise the withdrawal, and the French army recently announced it had dismissed 162 Senegalese who worked on military bases in Dakar.

US private lunar lander ends mission

The mission of US company Intuitive Machines' lunar lander Athena has come to an early end because the lander tipped over while touching down on the Moon, and its battery quickly drained, the company said. According to NASA, the uncrewed lander landed at a region near the Moon's South Pole at about 11:30 am Eastern Time Thursday, more than 400 meters from its intended landing site, Xinhua news agency reported.

Trump to astronauts Sunita & Butch

US President Donald Trump said that he has authorised Elon Musk to bring back American astronauts Sunita Williams and Butch Wilmore who have been stranded at the International Space station since June last year. Speaking to media persons at the Oval Office about the two astronauts on Friday, Trump said, "We love you (astronauts), and we're coming up to get you, and you shouldn't have been up there so long. The most incompetent President in our history has allowed that to happen to you, but this President won't let that happen."

Trump's BTC reserve plan sparks debate

US President Donald Trump's decision to establish a Strategic Bitcoin Reserve has ignited debate among industry experts and policymakers. The executive order, signed on Thursday, creates two digital asset reserves: one exclusively for Bitcoin and another Digital Asset Stockpile for other cryptocurrencies.

The initiative aims to manage digital assets seized by the federal government in criminal or civil proceedings. White House AI and cryptocurrency advisor David Sacks described the move as a "digital Fort Knox," comparing it to the Kentucky military base storing America's gold reserves. However, the announcement has drawn mixed reactions from the crypto community. Some analysts argue that the administration's approach lacks transparency, while others criticize its limited scope.

TRUMP DILEMMA | Balancing Russia, Ukraine, & global stakes

'Ukraine more difficult to deal with than Russia'

US President Donald Trump has openly stated that he finds it "more difficult, frankly, to deal with Ukraine" than Russia as he navigates attempts to broker peace between the two nations. Speaking from the Oval Office on Friday, Trump expressed frustration with Kyiv, contrasting it with what he described as smoother negotiations with Moscow.

This statement comes amid growing tension following Trump's decision to pause all US military aid and intelligence-sharing with Ukraine. The move, which stunned NATO allies, was compounded by the US temporarily suspending Ukraine's access to high-quality satellite imagery provided by space technology firm Maxar. The decision, confirmed by the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency, was made "in accordance with the administration's directive on support to Ukraine."

Clash with Kyiv

Trump's stance on Ukraine took a sharp turn after a heated exchange with President Volodymyr Zelensky a week ago, where he accused the Ukrainian leader of being "disrespect-

ful" toward the US. This public rebuke was followed by growing pressure from the US for Ukraine to agree to a truce with Russia. Reports suggest that Trump's administration is pushing for a settlement that would grant the US a significant stake in Ukraine's mineral resources while also discussing security guarantees at a later stage.

Zelensky, however, remains firm in seeking strong security assurances before any deal is signed. Despite his recent fallout with Trump, the Ukrainian leader has attempted to repair relations,

even reportedly sending a letter expressing "apology" and "gratitude" to the US president.

Intensified assault

Meanwhile, Russia capitalized on the shifting dynamics by launching large-scale missile and drone attacks on Ukraine's energy infrastructure on Thursday night. Trump, in response, floated the idea of imposing additional tariffs and sanctions on Moscow, though he simultaneously noted that Putin's aggressive actions were predictable. "I think he's hitting them [Ukraine]

harder than he's been hitting them, and I think probably anyone in that position would be doing that right now," Trump remarked. While Trump has expressed belief that Putin wants the war to end, he remains skeptical about Ukraine's willingness to settle. "I want to know they [Ukraine] want to settle, and I don't know they want to settle," he stated.

Road ahead: The US administration is set to send senior officials to Saudi Arabia next week for high-level discussions with Zelensky's team. These negotiations come as European nations ramp up their military aid efforts, with a growing coalition of countries committing to bolstering Ukraine's defenses. Despite the turmoil, Zelensky has maintained that Ukraine is "ready for peace as soon as possible" and has proposed "concrete steps" to achieve a resolution.

However, the escalating battlefield situation and the complex geopolitical stakes suggest that a swift resolution remains elusive. As Trump walks the tightrope between diplomacy and strategic interests, the world watches to see whether his unconventional approach will lead to a resolution—or further deepen the crisis.

China imposes retaliatory tariff on Canada

China has announced a new set of retaliatory tariffs on Canadian agricultural and seafood products in response to Canada's recent import duties on Chinese-made electric vehicles and metal products. According to a statement from China's Customs Tariff Commission of the State Council, the tariffs will take effect on March 20. The measures include a 100% tariff on Canadian rapeseed oil, oil cakes, and peas, along with a 25% tariff on aquatic products and pork imported from Canada.

This move escalates trade tensions between Beijing and Ottawa, which intensified after Canada imposed a 100% tariff on Chinese electric vehicles starting October 1, 2024, following similar actions by the United States and the European Union. Additionally, Canada implemented a 25% tariff on Chinese steel and aluminum imports on October 15, 2024. China's customs authorities condemned Canada's trade policies, calling them "a typical protectionist practice" that violate World Trade Organization rules. The statement further accused Canada of enforcing "discriminatory measures" that harm bilateral economic relations and infringe on China's legitimate trade interests.

This latest round of tariffs adds to a growing series of trade restrictions imposed by the United States, Canada, and Mexico in recent months. Analysts warn that prolonged economic retaliation could disrupt global supply chains and negatively impact industries dependent on international trade.

The Canadian government has yet to issue a formal response to China's announcement.

Yoon released from detention

Impeached South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol was released from jail on Saturday, a day after a court's ruling that allowed him to stand trial without physical detention over his failed bid to impose martial law in December.

Waving to his supporters, Yoon walked out of the Seoul Detention Centre, 52 days after he was detained on charges of inciting an insurrection. However, impeachment and criminal trials against Yoon will continue.

Yoon's release came shortly after Prosecutor General Shim Woo-jung decided not to appeal the court's ruling to release the suspended president. Bowing deeply to his supporters, Yoon arrived at his official residence in central Seoul on Saturday evening. "I appreciate the court's courage and determination in correcting the illegality," Yoon said in a statement. With his release, Yoon will be able to stand trial without physical detention.

On Friday, the court said it approved Yoon's request after determining that his January 26 indictment on insurrection charges, which allowed his detention to be extended, had come hours after the initial detention period had already expired. The 10-day initial detention period excludes the time documents were sent to a court for a review of whether to issue an arrest warrant, pushing back the deadline of Yoon's detention to around 9 a.m. January 26, whereas the prosecution indicted him shortly before 7 pm that day, according to the court. Yoon's legal team accused the prosecution of delaying Yoon's release, which came 27 hours after

The president's release is "not just about addressing an individual's injustice, but the beginning of a difficult journey to restore the collapsed rule of law in this country," the ruling People Power Party welcomed Yoon's release and urged the Constitutional Court to take the court's decision into consideration in the impeachment trial.

"It is a just decision and the party hopes it serves as an opportunity to correct the distorted rule of law," party spokesperson Shin Dongwook said in a statement. Yonhap news agency reported. In contrast, the main opposition Democratic Party strongly criticised the prosecution for exacerbating the nation's crisis with Yoon's release and called for the Constitutional Court to formally impeach him. The top court is expected to decide whether to remove Yoon from office or reinstate him later this month after wrapping up hearings on February 25.

Myanmar gears up for general elections

Bangkok: Four years after seizing power from the elected administration, the head of the military government declared Myanmar will hold a general election within 10 months, state-run media reported Saturday. Senior Gen. Min Aung Hlaing said Friday the election will take place either in December or January 2026 at the latest, according to the Global New Light of Myanmar newspaper.

He announced the dates in a press conference while on an official visit to Belarus, one of the few allies of Myanmar's military government, saying that 53 political parties have already submitted their lists to participate in the election. However, Min Aung did not mention exact election dates. The announcement comes as Myanmar is roiled by a civil

war in which the army has been forced onto the defensive against pro-democracy militants as well as ethnic militias seeking autonomy in much of the country.

The army takeover from Aung San Suu Kyi's elected government in February 2021 has been met with widespread popular opposition, triggering armed resistances, and large parts of the country are

embroiled in conflict. The ruling military has since said an election was the primary goal but has repeatedly pushed back the date.

Pakistan asks Afghans to leave by Mar 31

The Pakistan government has set March 31 as the deadline for Afghan Citizen Card (ACCs) holders to leave Pakistan voluntarily as part of a plan to repatriate all illegal foreigners, according to an official document.

The document, purportedly leaked to the media on Friday night, indicated that the ACC holders staying in Islamabad and Rawalpindi would be moved out and sent back to Afghanistan as part of a multiphase relocation plan for Afghan migrants, including those awaiting resettlement in third countries.

The decision comes amidst deteriorating ties between Islamabad and Kabul over the issue of terrorism and it may impact over 800,000 documented Afghan refugees holding Afghan Citizen Cards and are included in the category of documented refugees.

It stated that the Illegal Foreigners Repatriation Programme (IFRP) has been implemented since November 1, 2023.
