Locals appeal for relief and rehab

Several buildings and vehicles were damaged in Jammu and Kashmir's Ramban after a landslide hit parts of the district following heavy rains and hailstorms in the area. Locals urged the government for help and rehabilitation as they claimed that they had lost their shops and livelihood.

Ravi Kumar, a local shopkeeper, said, "I had two shops in the market, and even he had two shops. When we got to know at 4 am that the whole market had been washed away, we rushed here to find that there was nothing left. We didn't know who to approach for help or what to do now; we were clueless. These shops were our only source of livelihood. I request the governments to come and help us."

Several vehicles and locals were feared trapped under debris after a landslide hit the Shan Palace area in Ward No 2 of Ramban district, Jammu and Kashmir, following heavy rains. Local police and hotel staff rushed to the spot and rescued those who were trapped. Visuals from the area showed several vehicles completely buried under mud, stones, and debris. The entrances of shops and a restaurant were also damaged.

Ex-K'taka DGP found dead

Former Karnataka Director General of Police Om Prakash was found dead under mysterious circumstances at his HSR Layout residence in Bengaluru on Sunday, police said. His body was found with injuries, raising suspicion that he may have been murdered, they added. The 68-year-old IPS officer from the 1981 batch was a native of Champaran in Bihar and held an MSc in Geology. He was appointed as the Director General of Police on March 1, 2015. Senior police officials rushed to the spot upon receiving the information.

6 soldiers hurt in accident

Six Army personnel were injured after their vehicle skidded off the road and plunged into a roadside ditch in Jammu and Kashmir's Udhampur district on Sunday, officials said. The accident occurred near Chopra market in the town, 65 km away from Jammu, when a bus carrying the soldiers was on its way to a nearby camp, the officials said.

25 injured as winds bring down mandap at religious event

Twenty-five devotees were injured on Sunday afternoon after a 'mandap' erected for a religious event in Maharashtra's Jalna district collapsed due to strong winds, an official said.

Thirteen persons have sustained serious wounds and are being treated at Jalna district hospital, while the remaining twelve are admitted to the rural health centre in Hasnabad, the official informed.

The incident took place in Wazirkheda village in Bhojwade taluk at 1pm when a large crowd of devotees had gathered to listen to a 'Shiv Mahapuram' discourse by Santosh Maharaj Adhavne, he said.

"The temporary mandap, erected with the help of iron rods, collapsed due to strong winds. Its covering fell on the devotees gathered below," the official said.

Former Zilla Parishad member Ganesh Phuke said the event continued after the injured were sent to hospital and the mandap was re-erected.

The discourse, which began on April 18, will continue till April 25, and more than 5000 devotees had gathered this afternoon, Phuke added.

16 militants held in Manipur, arms recovered

A total of 16 members of several proscribed outfits have been arrested in the last 48 hours in Manipur, police said on Sunday.

Two cadres of the banned United National Liberation Front (Pambei) were apprehended from Napetpalli Andro road near Nongdam village in Imphal East district on Saturday.

They were allegedly involved in extortion, a senior officer said.

Security forces arrested one member of the outlawed Kangleipak Communist Party (Taibanganba) from Ningthoukhong Ward No 13 in Bishnupur district on Friday, he said.

Two cadres of the proscribed KCP (MFL) were apprehended on the same day from Salam Mamang Leikai Ketuki Lampak in Imphal West district, the officer said, adding that they were also allegedly involved in extortion.

The state police arrested one cadre of the proscribed Prepak (PRO) from Kyamgei Heibong Makhong area in Imphal East district on Friday, he said. One cadre of the banned Kanglei Yawol Kanna Lup (KYKL) was taken into custody from the Imphal East district.

A United Peoples' Party of Kangleipak (UPPK) member was also arrested on Friday from Imphal East district.

Another active cadre of the banned Prepak was apprehended from Sanjenbam Shangshabi village in Imphal East district on the same day.

The Manipur Police on Sunday afternoon said seven militants of the proscribed Kangleipak Communist Party (People's War Group) were arrested during a midnight operation.

Murder accused held after 600-km chase by cops

A proclaimed offender who was on the run for over four years in a murder case was arrested after a 600-kilometre chase across multiple states, Delhi Police said on Sunday.

The accused, Sonu alias Manoj, was arrested from Panipat in Haryana on Saturday, police said in a statement.

Sonu abducted, shot dead and beheaded a youth, Anil, in outer Delhi's Kanjhawala area on February 4, 2016, as the latter had earlier beaten him over a dispute. Anil's decapitated and naked body was found in Kanjhawala, it said.

"The accused abducted the victim in a Scorpio, shot him in the chest and then decapitated the body to conceal his identity. The severed head was dumped separately in a nearby drain," said Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime Branch) Vikram Singh.

Ram Lalla is now adorned in lightweight, finely crafted silk garments — chosen for their softness and breathability to suit the rising temperatures. These vibrant yellow robes, combined with cooling fabrics like khadi and natural silk, are designed not only for

aesthetic appeal but to ensure the comfort of the deity during the sweltering months.

GARLANDS & DRAPES
Heavier gold ornaments, typical of winter, have made way for silver and gem-studded accessories. From the intricately designed mukut (crown) and kundal (earrings) to the kanthahar (garlands) and angavastra (drape), every element of the divine adornment has been selected to reflect both elegance and seasonal sensitivity.

"This seasonal shift is deeply rooted in scripture," said a senior member of the Shringar Samiti (decoration committee), which oversees the deity's daily presentation. "Our rituals evolve with the climate, and the goal is to create an environment of spiritual and physical comfort for the Lord, in accordance with Vedic principles."

Techie kills self, accuses wife, in-laws of harassment

A 33-year-old engineer allegedly committed suicide in a hotel room near Etawah railway station after accusing his wife and in-laws of harassment.

According to his brother Taran Pratap, Mohit was employed at a private company in Noida, where he met a woman named Priya. After a long live-in relationship, the couple married on November 27, 2023, with the consent of both the families and without any dowry. After marriage, Mohit and his wife lived separately from their families.

According to Taran, Mohit often complained that his in-laws pressured him to transfer ownership of his house and land in his wife's name. He also alleged that his wife

frequently quarrelled with him over the property. Mohit had informed his brother that Priya's father Anuj Kumar had lodged a false police complaint against him, and her brother had threatened to kill him if he did not comply with their property demands. Also, Mohit's mother-in-law allegedly forced Priya to abort a three-month-old pregnancy.

LAST MESSAGE

Before taking the extreme step, he sent a video message to his family, stating, "If only there was a law for men too. If I don't get justice, immerse my ashes in a drain." The deceased, Mohit Yadav, hailed from Nagla Raspadpur village in Auraiya district of Uttar Pradesh.

J&K CM Abdullah, L-G grieve deaths

Sinha said in his message, "Deeply anguished by the tragic loss of precious lives due to the flash floods triggered by incessant rain in Ramban. My heartfelt condolences to the bereaved families in this hour of grief."

Dalit youth in Raj sexually assaulted, urinated upon

A 19-year-old Dalit youth from Sikar district of Rajasthan has alleged that he was beaten, urinated on and sexually assaulted by two men, police said on Sunday.

They said the incident took place in Sikar's Fatehpur area on April 8 but an FIR was lodged in the matter on April 16 after the teenager's family lodged a police complaint.

"We have registered an FIR in the matter. Medical examination of the victim has been done and his statement has been recorded. The matter is being investigated," Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Arvind Kumar said.

A case has been registered under relevant sections of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, he said.

ABOUT THE INCIDENT

According to the complaint, the youth stepped out to watch a wedding procession in his village on April 8 when the two accused called him to a bus stand on the pretext of some work. The two then took him to a secluded location and hit him, including on his private parts, forced him to remove his clothes and performed unnatural sex on him, the complaint stated. "They were drunk. They hit me with a bottle, urinated on me and used casteist slurs," the victim alleged, adding that the accused also recorded a video of their acts and "threatened" to share it on social media if he told anyone about the incident.
