Around one lakh fishing vessels in the country will be fitted with indigenously developed transponders for enhancing the safety of fishermen, Union Minister of State for Fisheries George Kurian said here on Wednesday.

Speaking at the launch of various projects aimed at the uplift of fishermen community under the Prime Minister Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) here, Mr. Kurian said the transponders would be given to the fishermen free of cost for installing the gadget on their boats. As many

as 3,023 fishing vessels in the Union Territory will be fitted with the transponders soon. The equipment with inbuilt real-time tracking mechanism of the vessels will help in enhancing the safety of fishermen. It will also help the fishermen get weather updates while

fishing in the sea, he said. Under the PMMSY programme, the Union Minister said the Centre has outlined projects worth ₹428 crore for Puducherry. The projects included development of harbours, distribution of deep-sea fishing vessels, promotion of seaweed

cultivation and other livelihood support programmes for the fishermen, he said.

Lieutenant Governor K. Kailashnathan in his address said several projects are being taken up by the Central and Union Territory governments for the welfare of fishermen.

"Efforts so far by the Central government has helped in increasing the fish production and marine exports in the country," he said.

Chief Minister N. Rangasamy in his address said the Puducherry government was planning to provide financial assistance to children of fishermen studying in schools and colleges. "Similar to the reimbur-

sement of fee for children belonging to socially backward communities in Puducherry, the government was planning to provide financial assistance to wards of fishermen," he said.

Minister for Public Works and Fisheries K. Lakshminarayanan said the government has increased the ban period financial assistance given to fishermen from ₹6,500 to ₹8,000. A notification regarding the ban period assistance will be issued soon. He also informed the government's decision to increase financial assistance given to fishermen during monsoon to ₹6,000.

Trial run held on new broad gauge railway line

Bringing to life a storyboard suffused with elements of physical theatre

Adishakti's play 'Urmila' brought to life a storyboard suffused with elements from physical theatre, movement-based storytelling and coaching complex themes of gender disparity, bodily autonomy and female agency, during a show at the 11th Remembering Veenapani Festival.

While the episode from *The Ramayana* is referenced to extol the spirit of sacrifice by Urmila in

sleeping through 14 years as a quid pro quo for facilitating her husband Lakshmana's wide-eyed vigil to guard Rama and Sita in exile, the play pushes back against what is normative in the mythological construct, and raises discomfiting questions about gender imbalance and exploitative choices.

Nimmy Raphael, writer and director, who also explored the sleep curse dynamic in the earlier produced 'Nidravathwam' (a study in contrast to the cir-

cadian rhythm of Kumbakarna and Lakshmana, brothers and trusted lieutenants of the two protagonists- Ravana and Rama), turns a probing mind to the predicament of Urmila in this play. The story begins in media res at Ayodhya where Urmila (Nimmy) is shown to be in mental turmoil: a tormented soul who faces up to the travesty of having lost 14 years of the most productive phase of her life to sleep. Her destiny was sealed with her husband's casual com-

mand: "Sleep my sleep." Vinay Kumar, Adishakti Artistic Director, who also composed a delightfully eclectic soundscape of music interspersed with voices, and Sooraj S. play the comical, argumentative pair of soldiers of 'Nidra', the goddess of sleep, constantly devising tricks to put Urmila to slumber.

'Urmila' is a peripheral character reimagined as a radical symbol of resistance against the erasure of female sovereignty. The mise-en-scene, re-

sembling a workout setting with a gym ball and rope-walk contraption, is perfectly set for Nimmy to showcase her prowess in physical theatre. Vinay, breaks the fourth wall, ad-libbing his way during portions of the play.

'Urmila', where a woman's body becomes the final battleground of subjugation when all other forms of agency are denied, propels to a poignant coda where the protagonist's inner battles to resist colonisation of her identity

and existence, are conveyed through a prism of spinning reflections from three mirrors in motion.

Like "Bali", that preceded this show or the upcoming 'Bhoomi' (on Thursday), the integration of music, dance, movement and emotional craft into one performance language, or what Adishakti's founder and experimental theatre pioneer Veenapani Chawla envisioned as a form of hybrid theatre with a modern, pluralist aesthetic.
