## Mann calls all-party meet as water row with Haryana deepens

THE AAP government in Punjab Thursday decided to convene a special session of the Vidhan Sabha to bring in a resolution on May 5 on "protecting" the state's water resources amid escalation of a row over sharing of water with Haryana.

It has also called an all-party meeting on Friday morning at Punjab Bhawan — the decisions being taken in a meeting of Cabinet ministers and MLAs from state and attended by AAP national convener Arvind Kejriwal, party's state in-charge, Manish Sisodia and Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann.

The meeting came soon after Mann rushed to Bhakra Nangal Dam in Rupnagar where Cabinet Minister Harjot Singh Bains had staged a dharna with AAP workers and locked a room from where water supply is regulated following the Bhakra Beas Management Board (BBMB)'s announcement to release 8,500 cusecs of water to Haryana.

The developments came even as Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini accused the AAP of

playing "dirty politics", claiming that this was the first time when the supply of drinking water had been halted. "Water is a lifeline, not a political weapon. As our elder brother, Punjab should set an example, not block what is rightfully and ethically shared," said Saini.

The BBMB regulates water distribution from Bhakra, Pong and Ranjit Sagar dams. Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan are the partnering states that meet their requirement for different purposes, including irrigation, from Bhakra and Pong dams. The BBMB had Wednesday evening decided to release 8,500 cusecs of water to Haryana, a move that sparked a flurry of political activities and protests in Punjab.

Mann said the all party meeting was being convened to reflect the unity of the political parties in the state over the sensitive issue. "It is high time that all the political parties should rise above the parochial considerations and fight this war vehemently," Mann said, adding the state government "will not compromise" and will "safeguard" the river waters by all means.

Speaking to reporters after the meeting, cabinet minister and

AAP's Punjab unit chief Aman Arora accused Centre of "continuous betrayal and exploitation of Punjab's natural resources", the latest being the "conspiracy involving looting Punjab's waters to benefit Haryana, even when Haryana is already receiving more than its share". He said Kejriwal is actively leading the party's efforts on the ground to safeguard Punjab's water rights.

Earlier in the day, addressing the media at the Nangal dam, Mann claimed that the water level in Bhakra, Pong and Ranjit Sagar dams was at present less than what it was during the corresponding period of last year. Bhakra

dam's water level is 1,555 feet as against 1,566.48 feet on the corresponding day last year. Similarly, water level in Pong dam is 1,293 feet as against 1,325.29 feet last year on this day, he said, adding that the water level in Ranjit Sagar dam is 502 metres as against 506.13 metres last year.

Referring to the BBMB technical committee meeting held Wednesday, he accused Haryana and Rajasthan — both ruled by the BJP — of indulging in 'gundagardi' (thuggery) and 'tanashahi' (dictatorship) and of trying to "rob" Punjab of its water.

"How could they bypass Punjab and take away water? We did not sign (that decision)," Mann said, adding that Punjab has 60% share in BBMB and the technical committee's decision to release water to Haryana is "arbitrary, dictatorial and undemocratic".

During the BBMB committee

meeting attended by the three member states Wednesday, the Punjab government had issued a dissent note, stating that it did not have a drop to share.

After the meeting, the BBMB transferred Akashdeep Singh of the Punjab cadre from the position of Director (Water Regulation) at Nangal. He has been replaced by Sanjeev Kumar, a Haryana cadre officer. Akashdeep, in the Wednesday meeting, had insisted that more water to Haryana could be released only if an indent in this regard is received from Punjab as per the regulations manual.

Meanwhile, Mann warned Centre and governments of Haryana and Rajasthan along with the BBMB that this "policy of repression" will not work for Punjab. "Water is our lifeline. We will oppose any move to divert us of water. If the Centre does not stop from hatching such conspiracies then it should forget that Punjab will give paddy to the country for the public distribution system".

Mann said that as the Haryana government had urged Punjab that they do not have water to cater to the drinking needs of people, we generously allotted 4000 cusecs of water daily to Haryana from April 6 onwards as humanitarian gesture. Now they want more. The Punjab government also ordered stepping up of security at the regulator end of Nangal dam, anticipating a law and order

situation. DIG (Ropar Range) Harcharan Singh Bhullar and other police officers reached the Nangal dam to review security arrangements. "Police have been deputed to review security arrangements at the vulnerable points. Nangal is the biggest dam here. We came here to review security," Bhullar said.

Officials privy to the developments said Punjab may approach court against the BBMB order to release water to Haryana. Punjab Advocate General Maninderjit Singh Bedi, Secretary (Water Resource) Krishan Kumar, and Director General of Police Gaurav Yadav remained huddled up during the day to work out a solution.

The AAP, meanwhile, held protests and demonstrations outside BJP offices in Punjab even as BJP's state unit chief, Sunil Jakhar, said they "stand firmly with the interests of Punjab and our stand is clear that the state does not have excess water to give to any state".

Like BJP, other parties in too extended support to the AAP government on the issue. Senior Congress leader Partap Singh Bajwa said, "We will fight for every drop of water" while Shiromani Akali Dal chief Sukhbir Singh Badal said, "BJP ruled states of Haryana, Rajasthan and Delhi have ganged up against Punjab" and his party "would safeguard the rights of the state's farmers, who are already reeling under water shortage for irrigation needs".
