

Man commits suicide after killing his mother in Jaipur

JAIPUR, JULY 1 /--/ A 38-year-old man allegedly killed his mother before ending his own life by jumping in front of a train here, police said on Tuesday.

According to police, the son, Abhijeet, is suspected to have stabbed his mother, 68-year-old Pushpanjali, in the neck with a knife inside their rented flat in Parshwanath Colony under the Muhana police station area.

He then locked the room and left before committing suicide on the railway tracks, police said. The matter came to light on Monday when Jawahar Circle police received information about a man being hit by a train near Brain Tower Hospital, Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police (South) Lalit Kumar Sharma said. "Upon reaching the spot, they found documents and house keys in his pocket that helped us identify him as Abhijeet," Sharma said.

Police then traced the address to the colony. When the team reached the flat, they discovered the body of his mother in a decomposed state, Sharma said and added that a knife was also recovered from the scene.

"The condition of the body indicates she had been dead for at least a day before being found," police said. Police said Abhijeet had previously worked at a call centre but was unemployed at the time of the incident.

A case has been registered, and further investigation is underway to ascertain the motive behind the crime and other aspects related to the incident. (PTT)

TN oppn mounts pressure on ruling DMK over custodial death, CM says action initiated

CHENNAI, JULY 1 /--/ The Opposition in Tamil Nadu on Tuesday mounted pressure on the ruling DMK over the custodial death of a temple security guard in the state's Sivaganga district, demanding a CBI or SIT probe into the matter, even as the state government initiated action against policemen, including the district police chief.

The matter also came up before the Madras High Court bench in Madurai. The victim's counsel told reporters that a video purportedly showing policemen in plainclothes assaulting the victim, Ajithkumar, has been submitted before the court. The government made it clear that nobody involved in the incident would be spared, even as it pointed out that action has been already initiated in the matter. The principal Opposition party, AIADMK demanded a CBI probe into the custodial death, saying people have lost faith in the state police. AIADMK chief and Leader of Opposition, Edappadi K Palaniswami slammed Stalin over the incident and said "people and us" don't believe the "drama" enacted by the CM on the matter. Referring to reports, Palaniswami claimed that the post-mortem on the victim revealed a number of injuries on his body and called it a "murder that happened due to police atrocity."

In a social media post, he said: "Some media may believe in our drama like holding review meeting or transferring the case to the CB-CID. Whether the people or us-- we just don't believe in the drama." There was no safety for the public in the DMK rule, he charged. "People have no faith in the fake police FIR. Therefore this case should be transferred to the CBI," he added. The AIADMK leader also held the CM "responsible" for the incident and demanded answer. Party workers staged protests in different towns in the state, demanding justice for the victim. They held placards that said "Justice for Ajithkumar" Actor and Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam (TVK) leader Vijay sought the constitution of a special investigation team (SIT) to probe the matter. People had many questions over the death of Ajithkumar, he said in a post on X. BJP Tamil Nadu president Nainar Nagenthiran wrote to the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) seeking an inquiry into the custodial death of Ajithkumar and similar such incidents in Tamil Nadu.

Meanwhile, addressing a press meet here, CM Stalin said action has been taken in connection with the death of the security guard. "Action has been taken, arrests have been effected...action has been taken against higher officials also," he said referring

to the government placing the district police chief of Sivaganga under "compulsory wait" in connection with the incident. The state government on Tuesday placed the Superintendent of Police, Sivaganga under "compulsory wait", while five policemen have been arrested in connection with the incident. Ashish Rawat, IPS, has been "placed on Compulsory Wait at the O/o the Director General of Police/HoPF, Tamil Nadu, Chennai," a home department note said. G Chandeesh, IPS, SP, Ramanathapuram, will hold additional charge of Sivaganga, the note from Dheeraj Kumar, additional chief secretary, added. Ajithkumar of Tiruppannam in Sivaganga, was picked up by the local police, reportedly in connection with a theft case earlier. His death later had sparked an outrage, with political parties slamming the government

Himachal minister booked for assaulting NHA officials

SHIMLA, JULY 1 /--/ Himachal Pradesh minister Anirudh Singh was on Tuesday booked for wrongful restraint and voluntarily causing hurt, among other charges, for allegedly assaulting two NHA officials while inspecting a site where a five-storey building collapsed, police said.

The FIR against the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Minister was lodged on a complaint filed by National Highways Authority of India (NHA) employee Achal Jindal, posted as manager, four-lane project, who alleged that he and his site engineer Yogesh were called to a room by Singh and beaten up. The two NHA employees have been hospitalised. The minister was unavailable for comment. Police said the FIR against Singh has been registered at Dhalli police station under sections 132 (criminal force to deter public servant while performing his duty), 121 (1) (voluntarily causing hurt, 352 (intentional insult), 126 (2) (wrongful restraint) and 3 (5) (criminal act committed by several persons) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

The five-storey building collapsed in the Mathu colony, Bhattakufar, on the road leading to Chamiyana Super Speciality Hospital on Monday morning. There was no casualty. Bhattakufar came under Singh's Kasumpti constituency. Building owner Ranjana Verma has alleged that the four-lane work had made the building unsafe and that nothing was done to ensure its safety. According to the complaint lodged by Jindal, Singh, along with his support-

ers, arrived at the building collapse site on Monday and called NHA officers there. Jindal and his site engineer Yogesh reached the site and apprised the minister about the collapse, 30 metres from the National Highway right of way (ROW).

They informed the minister that according to the official agreement, damages outside NH-ROW would come under the jurisdiction of the Himachal Pradesh government, the complaint stated. Following this, Singh allegedly started using intemperate language. "The minister called me and my site engineer Yogesh to a room and physically assaulted me in front of the local residents. He even hit me in the head with a vessel

containing water, following which I started to bleed," Jindal said. He further alleged that when Yogesh tried to save him, the minister also beat him, leaving both of them with "serious injuries". The two are undergoing treatment at Indira Gandhi Medical College. Earlier in the day, NHA chairman Santosh Kumar Yadav wrote a letter to Himachal Pradesh chief secretary Prabodh Saxena, demanding a detailed inquiry into the incident and that action be taken against all those responsible. "The NHA is executing projects worth Rs 23,729 crore in Himachal and morale of NHA officers would be affected if action is not taken as per the law," he said. (PTI)
