

Cong govt top priority is welfare of Christian Minorities - Minister Laxman Kumar

Hyderabad, Sept. 12: Minister for SC, ST and minority welfare Adhuri Laxman Kumar here on Friday asserted that the Congress government is firmly committed to the development and welfare of Christian minorities and will address their long-pending concerns.

After laying the foundation stone for the "YMCA International Integrated Centre of Excellence and Multipurpose Programme Centre" along with a new auditorium, at the Secunderabad YMCA here on Friday, Laxman Kumar told the gathering that under the leadership of Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, the government has been ensuring rightful allocation of funds for welfare schemes, and giving priority for Christian minorities. Previous governments had neglected this community, but the Congress government is now working with renewed commitment to deliver justice, he claimed.

The Minister said that he has instructed the district



collectors to resolve pending disputes over minority burial grounds and lands earmarked for Christian communities. Orders have also been issued to secure such lands with fencing, create infrastructure, and prevent encroachments. Budgetary allocations would reflect the enhanced support for pastors, churches, service institutions, and scholarships for students, while poor Christian families would be extended loans and subsidies

through the Minority Finance Corporation, he noted. Recalling his personal bond with YMCA, Laxman Kumar shared that he grew up playing cricket and table tennis at the Narayanguda grounds and even stayed at a YMCA hostel during his student years. Describing the YMCA as a "symbol of unity", he called upon all the stakeholders to strengthen the institution further. He lauded YMCA President Jayakar Daniel for steering

its growth. Labour Minister Gaddam Vivek also took part in the ceremony. Former Minister Dr. Geetha Reddy, who earlier served as Chairperson of the YMCA, was felicitated. The programme was attended by MLA Muta Gopal, Christian Minority Corporation Director Deepak John, Public Prosecutor Palle Nageshwar Rao, Supreme Court Advocate Joyce, Bishop Singam Leonard, Corporator Kontham Deepika and several others.

RAHUL GANDHI SHOULD BE ASHAMED OF 'MLA CHORI' IN TELANGANA: KTR

Hyderabad, Sept. 12: BRS working president and MLA K.T. Rama Rao on Friday launched a scathing attack on Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, accusing him of maintaining a "conspiratorial silence" over the spate of defections of BRS legislators to the Congress. Rahul Gandhi, who often raises the issue of "vote chori" in national politics, has failed to speak against "MLA chori" in Telangana.

"Rahul Gandhi should be ashamed of this undemocratic and unconstitutional practice. This crime is worse than the so-called vote chori", KTR charged. The BRS leader, talking to newsmen, demanded that Rahul Gandhi respond to the statements made by defected MLAs who, despite winning on BRS tickets and later joining the Congress, are now denying any switch. "The Congress party's role in this shame-



less chori proves its double standards. Rahul Gandhi must answer," he asserted. KTR recalled that several of these defected MLAs were seen wearing Congress scarves and posing for photographs with Rahul Gandhi in Delhi - images proudly circulated by Congress leaders. "You draped them in the Congress scarf and now you say they never joined? Do you still stand by this denial?" KTR questioned. The BRS

leader further said: "If this is not MLA chori, then what is it? How is this any less serious than vote chori? Are you not ashamed of your complicity in such political hypocrisy?" Such defections undermine democracy and erode public trust, he warned and accused the Congress government for indulging in unconstitutional tactics to weaken the opposition instead of addressing people's issues.

Karnan directs town planning officials to expedite building permits and improve efficiency

Hyderabad, Sept. 12: Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) commissioner R.V. Karnan directed the Town planning officials to accelerate the clearance of building permission applications and to enhance overall efficiency. Holding a review meeting at the GHMC Head Office with Chief City Planner (CCP)

Srinivas and other officials concerned, the Commissioner assessed the performance of the Town Planning Wing across various zones and circles. He stressed the importance of accountability, timely services and a citizen-centric approach. He instructed the officials to ensure speedy disposal of building permission applications, occupancy certi-

ficates, court cases, public grievances, and also the Layout Regularisation Scheme (LRS) applications. He emphasized the urgent need to vacate the residents from dilapidated and unsafe houses to avoid accidents. Taking a stern view of unauthorized constructions, Karnan warned that strict action would be taken against the cellar excavations carried out

without prior approvals. While acknowledging the satisfactory performance of the Town Planning Wing so far, the Commissioner urged the officials to further improve transparency, efficiency, and public trust. Kukatpally Zonal Commissioner Apoorva Chauhan, Additional CCPs and ACPs were also present at the review meeting.

SENIOR CITIZEN DUPED OF Rs 21 LAKH IN 'DIGITAL ARREST' SCAM

Hyderabad, Sept. 12: A 75-year-old man from Yakutpura was cheated of Rs.21 lakh in a "digital arrest" scam where the fraudsters impersonated police officers and misused Aadhaar details. On August 14 this year, the victim received

a call from a conman who claimed his Aadhaar was linked to a money laundering case. Over WhatsApp video calls, one of the fraudsters posed as an IPS officer, has shown fake documents and warned him to keep the matter secret. Fearing the threat of

arrest and imprisonment, the victim transferred money for 'verification' in five instalments between August 19 and September 2. The gang also sent forged letters with government seals to gain his trust. When they demanded additional

money without returning the earlier transfers, the senior citizen realized the fraud and filed a complaint. Police have launched an investigation and cautioned the public against such scams involving fake officials and Aadhaar misuse.

CYBER FRAUD THROUGH WHATSAPP & TELEGRAM

Hyderabad, Sept. 12: Two city residents recently fell victim to job-related investment frauds propagated through WhatsApp and Telegram. These incidents underline a growing cybercrime pattern where the fraudsters exploit fake job offers and prepaid online tasks to defraud unsuspecting victims of substantial sums.

In the first case, a 35-year-old woman from Abids was approached on September 1 by a fraudster posing as "Chandrika" from *Qube Research & Technologies Ltd.*. She was initially assigned simple online tasks like posting Google reviews, with small payments credited to her. Later, she was lured into "prepaid jobs" requiring repeated deposits. Between September 1 and 5, she transferred a total of Rs.10,25,550. A fake online balance of Rs.15,57,900 was displayed, but withdrawals were blocked, and further deposits were demanded. Realizing she had been cheated, she reported the fraud to the police.

In the second case, a 44-year-old man from Asifnagar was contacted on August 28 by a woman identifying herself as "Veena Khatri" from *Michael Page IT*. He was initially given tasks like branded keyword searches and rewarded with small amounts. Later, he was directed to a fraudulent portal, where he invested repeatedly. A false frozen balance of Rs.3,49,200 was shown, with an additional Rs.3,50,000

demanded for release. Before discovering the fraud, he had already lost Rs.1,61,720.

CRYSTUDY SHOWS MOST ADOLESCENT GIRLS UNAWARE OF 'STEM'

Bengaluru, Sept. 12: A new study by 'CRY' - Child Rights and You has revealed a significant awareness gap in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) among the adolescents in South India. The survey, conducted with 942 students (471 girls, 471 boys) from classes 9–12, found that 52% of girls and 51% of boys had never heard of STEM. Despite this gap, 54% girls have expressed interest in pursuing science streams after class 10 or 12, compared to 43% boys. Similarly, 51% of girls aspired to STEM-related careers, surpassing boys at 45%. The study highlights both potential and barriers. While adolescents see STEM education as a pathway to empowerment and independence, challenges persist: Resource gaps: Only 20% of girls and 18% of boys had regular access to science labs. Tutoring support reached just 13% of girls and 12% of boys, while the career counselling covered 35% of girls and 32% of boys. Barriers for girls: Financial constraints (25%), lack of family support (15%), cultural and societal norms (36% combined), and teacher discouragement (13%) limit girls' participation in STEM.

Key correlations showed that the students aware of STEM were 64% more likely to choose science streams. Regular lab access nearly doubled the science choices, while career counselling and exposure to female role models boosted aspirations significantly. "Girls are no less ambitious than boys—their enthusiasm for STEM is evident. But systemic barriers must be addressed," said John Roberts, Regional Director, CRY – South. To spark action, CRY will host the "Walk to EmpowHER" in Bengaluru on Sunday (September 14), themed "Girls in STEM – Empowering Generations". The event will unite communities, educators, and advocates to promote equitable access to STEM education.

IBM's Executive Partner A Anuradha, in her speech, stressed that AI should be seen as a collaborator, but not as a competitor. She urged women to embrace AI as an amplifier of human potential. The workshop featured hands-on sessions by experts, including Mohan Silaparasetty covering Generative AI and real-world applications.
